

## Heavy Rainfall warning based on 0600 UTC of 8<sup>th</sup> September, 2024


- Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam: Light to moderate rainfall at most places is very likely with heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places and extremely heavy rainfall at isolated places on 08<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> and heavy rainfall on 10<sup>th</sup> September.
- Odisha: Light to moderate rainfall at most places is very likely with heavy to very heavy rainfall at a isolated places on 08<sup>th</sup>, heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places and extremely heavy rainfall at isolated places over south Odisha on 9<sup>th</sup>; heavy to very heavy rainfall on 10<sup>th</sup> and heavy rainfall on 11<sup>th</sup> September.
- Chhattisgarh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places is likely with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places over south Chhattisgarh on 8<sup>th</sup>, over north Chhattisgarh on 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> and heavy rainfall over north Chhattisgarh on 11<sup>th</sup> September.
- Telangana: Light to moderate rainfall at many places is likely with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places very likely on 08<sup>th</sup>& 9<sup>th</sup>; heavy rainfall on 10<sup>th</sup> September.
- Gangetic West Bengal: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places very likely during 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> and heavy rainfall at isolated places 12<sup>th</sup> September.
- Jharkhand: Light to moderate rainfall at most places is very likely with heavy rainfall at isolated places on 9<sup>th</sup>; heavy to very heavy rainfall south Jharkhand during 10<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> and heavy rainfall on 12<sup>th</sup> September.
- Vidarbha: Light to moderate rainfall at most places is very likely with heavy rainfall at isolated places on 8<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> and heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places on 9<sup>th</sup> September.




- Action may be taken based on ORANGE AND RED COLOUR warnings.

- As the lead period increases forecast accuracy decreases.








#### 24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 09-09-2024 :

Low to Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of following Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.

Coastal AP & Yanam - East Godavari, Vishakhapatnam, Krishna, Srikakulam, Vizianagaram and West Godavari districts. district. Telangana Khammam \_ Chhattisgarh - Bastar, Bijapur, Dantewara, Gariaband, Mahasamund and Sukma districts. Odisha - Anugul, Baragarh, Bauda, Cuttack, Dhenkanal, Gajapathi, Ganjam, Kalahandi, Khordha, Malkangiri, Nayagarh, Nuaparha, Puri, Rayagarha and Subarnapur districts. Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.
