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#### Sub: Depression over south Sri Lanka

The Depression over south Sri Lanka moved southwestwards with a speed of 18 kmph and lay centered at 1130 hours IST of today, the 2<sup>nd</sup> February over the same region near latitude 6.8°N and longitude 80.8°E, about 140 km southwest of Batticaloa (Sri Lanka), 80 km north-northwest of Hambantota (Sri Lanka).

It is very likely to continue to move southwestwards across south Sri Lanka, weaken gradually and emerge into Comorin and adjoining Gulf of Mannar off west coast of Sri Lanka as a well marked low pressure area by midnight of today/early morning hours of tomorrow, the 03<sup>rd</sup> February 2023.

#### (i) Rainfall (warning graphics enclosed)

❖ Light/moderate rainfall is very likely at many places over Tamil Nadu & Puducherry and Kerala with isolated heavy rainfall over south Tamil Nadu and Kerala on 2<sup>nd</sup> February.

## (ii) Wind warning:

#### Southwest Bay of Bengal:

o Squally wind with speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph on 2<sup>nd</sup> February.

### ❖ Along & off Sri Lanka coast:

o Squally wind with speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph on 2<sup>nd</sup> February becoming squally weather with wind speed reaching 30-40 kmph gusting to 50 kmph on 3<sup>rd</sup> February.

#### ❖ Comorin area and Gulf of Mannar along & off south Tamil Nadu & Karaikal coasts:

 Squally wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph on 2<sup>nd</sup> February becoming squally weather with wind speed reaching 30-40 kmph gusting to 50 kmph on 3<sup>rd</sup> February.

## ❖ Along & off north Tamil Nadu & Puducherry coasts:

o Strong wind speed reaching 30-40 kmph gusting to 50 kmph on 2<sup>nd</sup> February.

#### (iii) Sea condition

#### Sea condition is likely to be rough to very rough

- Southwest Bay of Bengal and along & off Sri Lanka coast on 2<sup>nd</sup> February.
- o Comorin area and Gulf of Mannar along & off south Tamil Nadu coast on 2<sup>nd</sup> February

#### Sea condition is likely to be moderate to rough

- Along and off north Tamil Nadu & Puducherry coasts on 2<sup>nd</sup> February.
- Comorin area and adjoining southwest Bay of Bengal along & off south Sri Lanka coast on 3<sup>rd</sup> February

#### (iv) Fishermen Warning (warning graphics enclosed)

Fishermen are advised not to venture into:

- Comorin Area and adjoining Gulf of Mannar and Southwest Bay of Bengal along & off Sri Lanka and south Tamil Nadu & Karaikal coasts on 2<sup>nd</sup> February.
- ❖ Comorin Area and adjoining Southwest Bay of Bengal and along & off Sri Lanka coast upto 3<sup>rd</sup> February.

The system is under continuous surveillance and the next message will be issued at 2030 hours IST of today, the 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2023.
