Sub: Well marked Low Pressure Area over eastcentral and adjoining southeast Arabian Sea

Yesterday's Low Pressure Area over Eastcentral and adjoining Southeast Arabian Sea off north Kerala-Karnataka coasts moved northwestwards and became a well marked low pressure area over the same region at 1730 hrs IST of 13th December 2022. It moved further northwestwards and lay as a well marked low pressure area over Eastcentral and Southeast Arabian Sea at 0830 hrs IST of today, the 14th December 2022.

It is very likely to move northwestwards away from India coast and concentrate into a depression over Eastcentral Arabian Sea by 15th December morning.

Warnings:

- (i) Heavy Rainfall warning: NIL as the well marked low pressure area is expected to move away from India coast.
- (ii) Wind warning (warning graphics enclosed):
- Along & off North Kerala, Karnataka & Goa Coasts:Squally weather with wind speed reaching 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is likely to prevail till 14th December afternoon.

- Lakshadweep Area: Squally weather with wind speed reaching 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is likely to prevail till 14th morning, becoming 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph till 15th morning and decrease gradually thereafter.
- Southeast Arabian Sea: Squally weather with wind speed reaching 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is likely to prevail till 14th afternoon becoming 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph till 15th evening and decrease gradually thereafter.
- Eastcentral Arabian Sea: Squally weather with wind speed reaching 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is likely till 14th morning becoming 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph till 15th morning and 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph till 17th morning.
- Westcentral Arabian Sea: Squally weather with wind speed reaching 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is likely from 15th morning becoming 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph during 16th to 18th December, 2022.
- Southwest Arabian Sea: Squally weather with wind speed reaching 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is likely from 15th morning becoming 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph during 16th to 18th December, 2022.

(iii) Sea Condition

- ❖ Along & off North Kerala, Karnataka & Goa Coasts: Sea Condition is likely to be rough till 14th December afternoon.
- ❖ Lakshadweep Area: Sea Condition is likely to be rough till 14th morning becoming rough to very rough till 15th morning and improve thereafter
- Southeast Arabian Sea: Sea Condition is likely to be rough till 14th afternoon becoming rough to very rough till 15th evening and improve thereafter.
- **Eastcentral Arabian Sea: Sea Condition** is likely to be rough till 14th morning becoming rough to very rough from 15th morning to 17th morning.
- ❖ Westcentral Arabian Sea: Sea Condition is likely to be rough from 15th morning becoming rough to very rough during 16th to 18th December 2022.
- Southwest Arabian Sea: Sea Condition is likely to be rough from 15th morning becoming rough to very rough during16th to 18th December 2022.

- ❖ Along & off North Kerala, Karnataka & Goa Coasts till 14th December afternoon.
- Lakshadweep Area till 15th morning.
- ❖ Southeast Arabian Sea till 15th evening.

- ❖ Westcentral Arabian Sea from 15th morning to 18th December.
- Southwest Arabian Sea from 15th morning to 18th December.


The system is under continuous surveillance and the next message will be issued at 1330 hours IST of tomorrow, the 15th December, 2022.


