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Sub: Low Pressure Area over central parts of Andaman Sea

Yesterday's Low Pressure Area over south Andaman Sea & adjoining Thailand coast moved slightly west-northwestwards and lay over central parts of Andaman Sea at 0530 hrs IST of today the 14th November 2021. It persisted over the same region at 0830 hrs IST. It is likely to move west-northwestwards and become well marked over north Andaman Sea & adjoining Southeast Bay of Bengal by 15th November. Thereafter it is likely to continue to move west-northwestwards across east-central & adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal, concentrate into a Depression over west-central Bay of Bengal by 17th November and reach near south Andhra Pradesh coast around 18th November 2021.

Warnings in association with the system:

(i) Rainfall (warning graphics enclosed)

14th Nov.: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places very likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

15th Nov.: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places very likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

16th Nov.: No heavy rainfall warning.

17th **Nov.:** Light to moderate rainfall at most places **with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places** very likely over coastal Andhra Pradesh and heavy falls at isolated places over south coastal Odisha.

18th Nov.: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places very likely over coastal Andhra Pradesh and heavy falls at isolated places over south coastal Odisha.

(ii) Wind warning

Squally wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely to prevail over Andaman Sea & adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal on 14th, increase becoming 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph over the same region on 15th and over west-central & adjoining east-central Bay of Bengal during 16th – 18th November 2021. Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph likely to prevail along & off Andhra Pradesh and adjoining south Odisha & north Tamil Nadu coasts on 17th and 18th November 2021.

(iii) Sea condition

 Sea condition will be rough to very rough over Andaman Sea & adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal during 14th - 15th November, over west-central & adjoining east-central Bay of Bengal during 16th - 18th and along & off Andhra Pradesh and adjoining south Odisha & north Tamil Nadu coasts on 17th and 18th November 2021.

(iv) Fishermen Warning

- Fishermen are advised not to venture into Andaman Sea & adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal on 14th & 15th November, over west-central & adjoining east-central Bay of Bengal during 16th – 18th November and along & off Andhra Pradesh and south Odisha and north Tamil Nadu coasts on 17th & 18th November 2021. - Fishermen out at Sea are advised to return to coast by 15th November 2021.

(v) EXPECTED IMPACT (over Andaman & Nicobar Islands on 14th & 15th Nov. 2021) & ACTION SUGGESTED

A. Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, inundation and water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides
- > Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.

B. Action Suggested

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.




