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# Sub: Depression over North Chhattisgarh and neighbourhood

The depression over North Interior Odisha and adjoining North Chhattisgarh and South Jharkhand moved west-northwestwards with a speed of 21 kmph during last 6 hours and lay centered at 0530 hours IST of 15<sup>th</sup> August over North Chhattisgarh and neighbourhood near latitude 22.4<sup>0</sup>N and longitude 82.8<sup>0</sup>E, close to Korba (Chhattisgarh) and 100 km east-southeast of Pendra Road (Chhattisgarh).

It is very likely to continue to move west-northwestwards and maintain the intensity of depression during next 12 hours.

# Warnings:

# (i) Rainfall:

**Chattisgarh:** Rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places very likely on 15<sup>th</sup> August.

**East Madhya Pradesh:** Rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places very likely on 15<sup>th</sup> August.

**West Madhya Pradesh:** Rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall with isolated extremely heavy falls on 15<sup>th</sup> and heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places on 16<sup>th</sup> August.

**Jharkhand:** Rainfall at many places with heavy rainfall at isolated places very likely on 15<sup>th</sup> August.

**Odisha:** Rainfall at many places with heavy rainfall at isolated places very likely over western Odisha on 15<sup>th</sup> August.

Gangetic West Bengal: Light to moderate rainfall at many places likely on 15<sup>th</sup> August.

# (ii) Wind:

Squally wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is very likely over north and adjoining central Bay of Bengal and along & off Bangladesh, West Bengal, Odisha and adjoining North Andhra Pradesh coasts during next 12 hours and gradually decrease thereafter

#### (iii) Sea condition

Sea condition is likely to be rough to very rough over north and adjoining central Bay of Bengal and along & off Bangladesh, West Bengal, Odisha and adjoining North Andhra Pradesh coasts during next 12 hours and gradually improve thereafter.

### (iii) Fishermen Warning

Fishermen are advised not to venture into north and adjoining central Bay of Bengal and along & off Bangladesh, West Bengal, Odisha and adjoining North Andhra Pradesh coasts on 15<sup>th</sup> August.

System is under continuous surveillance and the next message will be issued at 1130 hours IST of 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2022.
