Sub: Low Pressure Area over central parts of Andaman Sea

Yesterday's low pressure area over southeast Bay of Bengal and adjoining south Andaman Sea moved northeastwards and lay centered over **central parts of Andaman Sea** at 0830 hrs IST of today, the 1st April, 2021. It is likely to become a well marked Low pressure area over the same region during next 12 hours. There is a low probability that it may concentrate into a Depression over north Andaman Sea & neighbourhood during subsequent 24 hours. It is likely to move northeastwards towards Myanmar coast.

Rainfall warning:

Heavy rainfall very likely at isolated places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands on 1st April, 2021.

Wind warning:

1st April, 2021: Squally winds (speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph) very likely over south Andaman Sea & adjoining Southeast Bay of Bengal

2nd April 2021: Squally winds (speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph) very likely over Andaman Sea

3rd April 2021: Strong winds (speed reaching 30-40 kmph) very likely over north Andaman Sea.

State of Sea:

Sea condition will be rough to very rough over south Andaman Sea & adjoining Southeast Bay of Bengal on 1st April & over Andaman Sea on 2nd April and moderate to rough over north Andaman Sea on 3rd April, 2021.

Fishermen warnings:

Fishermen are advised not to venture into Andaman Sea & adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal on 1st April and into Andaman Sea on 2nd April, 2021.
