

India Meteorological Department (Ministry of Earth Sciences)

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Sub: Depression [Remnant of the Very Severe Cyclonic Storm "Hamoon" (pronounced as Hamoon)] weakened into a Well Marked Low Pressure Area over north Mizoram and adjoining Manipur & Myanmar

The Depression [Remnant of the Very Severe Cyclonic Storm "Hamoon"] over Mizoram moved nearly north-northeastwards during past 6 hours, weakened into a Well Marked Low pressure area and lay centered at 1730 hours IST of today, the 25th October over north Mizoram and adjoining Manipur & Myanmar.

It is very likely to move north-northeastwards and weaken further during next 12 hours.


