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# Sub: Well Marked Low Pressure Area over northwest Bay of Bengal and adjoining areas of coastal Odisha, north coastal Andhra Pradesh & westcentral Bay of Bengal

Yesterday's well-marked low pressure area over northwest Bay of Bengal & adjoining westcentral Bay of Bengal off south Odisha & adjoining north Andhra Pradesh coasts now lies over northwest Bay of Bengal and adjoining areas of coastal Odisha, north coastal Andhra Pradesh & westcentral Bay of Bengal at 0830 hours IST of today, the 8<sup>th</sup> August, 2022.

It is likely to intensify into a depression over the same region during next 24 hours and move gradually west-northwestwards across Odisha and Chattisgarh.

#### Warnings:

#### (i) Rainfall (warning graphics enclosed)

8<sup>th</sup> August: Heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places with extremely heavy rainfall at isolated places is very likely over Odisha, Telangana and Madhya Maharashtra; heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places is very likely over Chhattisgarh, Vidarbha, East Madhya Pradesh and Marathwada and heavy rainfall at isolated places is very likely over coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and Rayalaseema.

9th August: Heavy to very heavy rainfall with extremely heavy falls at isolated places is very likely over Odisha and Madhya Maharashtra; heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places is very likely over Chattisgarh, Telangana, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha and Marathwada and

**heavy rainfall at isolated places** is very likely over Gangetic West Bengal, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, west Madhya Pradesh and East Rajasthan.

- 10<sup>th</sup> August: Heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places with extremely heavy falls at isolated places is likely over Madhya Maharashtra and Gujarat state; heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely over Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh and Odisha; and heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely over Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal, Marathawada and East Rajasthan.
- **11**<sup>th</sup> August: Heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely over Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Maharashtra and Gujarat State; and heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely over East Rajasthan, Jharkhand, Odisha and Gangetic West Bengal.
- **12<sup>th</sup> August: Heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places** is likely over East Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh and **heavy Rainfall at isolated places** is likely over Madhya Maharashtra, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh and Odisha.

### (ii) Wind warning:

- **8**<sup>th</sup> **August:** Squally wind speed reaching 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph is very likely over parts of central Bay of Bengal. Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is very likely over north Bay of Bengal along & off Odisha & West Bengal coasts, central & adjoining south Bay of Bengal and along & off Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, and Comorin area & east Sri Lanka coasts. Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is very likely over Andaman Sea and parts of south Bay of Bengal.
- **9<sup>th</sup> August:** Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is very likely over north Bay of Bengal along & off Odisha & West Bengal coasts, central & adjoining south Bay of Bengal and along & off Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, and Comorin area & east Sri Lanka coasts. Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is very likely over Andaman Sea and parts of south Bay of Bengal.
- 10<sup>th</sup> August: Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is very likely over northwest Bay of Bengal along & off Odisha & West Bengal coasts, central & adjoining south Bay of Bengal and along & off North Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, and Comorin area & east Sri Lanka coasts. Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is very likely over northeast Bay of Bengal and Andaman Sea.
- 11<sup>th</sup> August: Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is very likely over north Bay of Bengal along & off Odisha & West Bengal coasts, central & adjoining south Bay of Bengal and along & off south Tamil Nadu coast, Comorin area & southeast Sri Lanka coasts. Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is very likely over northeast Bay of Bengal.
- **12<sup>th</sup> August:** Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph over central Bay of Bengal and adjoining north Bay of Bengal & parts of south Bay of Bengal. Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is very likely over northeast Bay of Bengal and Andaman Sea.

#### (iii) Sea condition

**8**<sup>th</sup> **August:** Sea condition is likely to be very rough to high over parts of central Bay of Bengal, rough to very rough over north Bay of Bengal along & off Odisha & West Bengal coasts, central & adjoining south Bay of Bengal and along & off Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, and Comorin area & east Sri Lanka coasts and Andaman Sea.

- **9**<sup>th</sup> **August:** Sea condition is likely to be rough to very rough over north Bay of Bengal along & off Odisha & West Bengal coasts, central & adjoining south Bay of Bengal and along & off Andhra Pradesh. Tamil Nadu, and Comorin area & east Sri Lanka coasts and Andaman Sea.
- **10**<sup>th</sup> **August:** Sea condition is likely to be rough to very rough over north Bay of Bengal along & off Odisha & West Bengal coasts, central & adjoining south Bay of Bengal along & off Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Comorin area & east Sri Lanka coasts and Andaman Sea.
- **11<sup>th</sup> August:** Sea condition is likely to be rough to very rough over north Bay of Bengal along & off Odisha & West Bengal coasts, central & adjoining south Bay of Bengal and along & off South Tamil Nadu coast, Comorin area & east Sri Lanka coasts.
- **12<sup>th</sup> August:** Sea condition is likely to be rough to very rough over central Bay of Bengal & adjoining north Bay of Bengal & parts of south Bay of Bengal. Sea condition is likely to be rough over Andaman Sea.

#### (iv) Fishermen Warning

- **8**<sup>th</sup> **August:** Fishermen are advised not to venture into north Bay of Bengal along & off Odisha & West Bengal coasts, central & adjoining south Bay of Bengal, along & off Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, and Comorin area & east Sri Lanka coasts and Andaman Sea.
- **9<sup>th</sup> August:** Fishermen are advised not to venture into north Bay of Bengal along & off Odisha & West Bengal coasts, central & adjoining south Bay of Bengal and along & off Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, and Comorin area & east Sri Lanka coasts and Andaman Sea.
- **10**<sup>th</sup> **August:** Fishermen are advised not to venture into north Bay of Bengal, along & off Odisha & West Bengal coasts, central & adjoining south Bay of Bengal, along & off north Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Comorin area & east Sri Lanka coasts and Andaman Sea.
- **11<sup>th</sup> August:** Fishermen are advised not to venture into north Bay of Bengal along & off Odisha & West Bengal coasts, central & adjoining south Bay of Bengal and along & off South Tamil Nadu coast, Comorin area & south east Sri Lanka coasts and Andaman Sea.
- 12<sup>th</sup> August: Fishermen are advised not to venture into central & adjoining north Bay of Bengal & parts of south Bay of Bengal and Andaman Sea.


The system is under continuous surveillance and the next message will be issued at 1130 hours IST of tomorrow, the 9<sup>th</sup> August, 2022.


