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Sub: Depression over Northeast Arabian Sea weakened into a Well Marked Low Pressure Area over central parts of north Arabian Sea

The Depression over Northeast Arabian Sea moved nearly westwards during last 06 hours, weakened into a Well Marked Low Pressure Area at 0530 hours IST of today the 18th July, 2022 over central parts of north Arabian Sea.

It is very likely to weaken gradually into a Low Pressure Area and move nearly westwards towards Oman across northwest Arabian Sea during next 24 hours.

Warnings:

(i) Wind warning

- Squally weather with wind speed reaching 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph very likely to prevail over central parts of north Arabian Sea during next 24 hours.
- Strong wind with speed reaching 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph very likely to prevail over westcentral and adjoining southwest Arabian Sea during next 24 hours.

(ii) Sea condition

Sea condition very likely to be rough over central parts of north Arabian Sea during next 24 hours.

(iii) Fishermen Warning

Fishermen are advised not to venture into central parts of north Arabian Sea and westcentral & adjoining southwest Arabian Sea during next 24 hours.
