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Sub: Depression over southeast Bay of Bengal and adjoining south Andaman Sea: Pre cyclone watch for Andaman Islands and adjoining sea areas (Yellow Message)

The Depression over southeast Bay of Bengal and adjoining south Andaman Sea, moved north-northeastwards at a speed of 12 kmph and lay centered at 1130 hours IST of today, the 20th March, over the same region, near latitude 10.4°N and longitude 92.8°E, about 140 km north of Car Nicobar (Nicobar Islands), 140 km south of Port Blair (Andaman Islands) and 800 km south-southwest of Yangon (Myanmar). It is likely to move nearly northwards along & off Andaman & Nicobar Islands, intensify into a deep depression during next 24 hours and into a cyclonic storm during subsequent 12 hours.

Forecast track and intensity are given in the following table:

<u>Warnings:</u>

(i) Rainfall (warning graphics enclosed)

20th March: Light to moderate rainfall/thundershower at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places and isolated extremely heavy rainfall are very likely over Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

21st March: Light to moderate rainfall/thundershower at most places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places and isolated extremely heavy rainfall** are very likely over north Andaman Islands. Light to moderate rainfall at a few places is likely over Nicobar Islands.

(ii) Wind warning

- 20th March: Squally winds speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph are very likely to prevail over Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Andaman Sea and adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal which would gradually increase to 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph from afternoon of 20th March.
- 21st March: Squally winds speed reaching 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph are very likely to prevail over Andaman and Nicobar Islands, eastcentral Bay of Bengal and adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal from 21st early morning. It would gradually increase becoming Gale winds speed reaching 65-75 kmph gusting to 85 kmph over the region from evening of 21st March.
- 22nd March: Gale winds speed reaching 60-70 kmph gusting to 80 kmph very likely to prevail over eastcentral Bay of Bengal and along & off Myanmar coast and gradually reduce and becoming squally winds speed reaching 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph over the same region from 22nd evening. Squally wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail over north Andaman Islands, north Andaman Sea and adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal, northeast Bay of Bengal and along & off southeast Bangladesh coast.

(iii) Sea condition

- **20th March**: Sea condition is very likely to be rough to very rough over Andaman Sea and adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal on
- **21st March**: Sea condition is very likely to become very rough to high over Andaman Sea, southeast and adjoining eastcentral Bay of Bengal and
- **22nd March**: Sea condition is very likely to become very rough to high over eastcentral and adjoining southeast & northeast Bay of Bengal and north Andaman Sea and along & off Myanmar coast. It would be rough to very rough over northeast Bay of Bengal and along & off southeast Bangladesh coast during the same period.

(iv) Fishermen Warning (Graphics enclosed)

Fishermen are advised not to venture

- Into southeast Bay of Bengal during $20^{th} 21^{st}$ March.
- Into Andaman Sea and along & off Andaman and Nicobar Islands during 20th to 22nd March.
- Into eastcentral Bay of Bengal during 21st to 22nd March and into northeast Bay of Bengal on 22nd March.

(v) EXPECTED IMPACT & ACTION SUGGESTED for Andaman and Nicobar Islands

A. Impact Expected

- Breaking of tree branches and uprooting of small trees.
- Partial disruption of power and communication lines.
- Localized Flooding of roads, inundation and water logging in low lying areas.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Adverse impact on marine and tourist activities along the coasts.
- Damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to squally wind and inundation.

B. Action Suggested


- > Total suspension of fishing and tourism activities during 20th to 22nd March.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- People are advised to be in safe areas and avoid staying in vulnerable structure.
- Regulate and suspend off-shore activities during 20th to 22nd March.
- > Regulate air-traffic on 20th and 21st March, 2022.
- > Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.






