Sub: Well Marked Low Pressure Area over Northwest Thailand and adjoining Myanmar

The Depression over South Coastal Myanmar and adjoining Northwest Thailand moved north-northeastwards during past 06 hours, weakened into a Well Marked Low Pressure Area and and lay over Northwest Thailand and adjoining Myanmar at 0530 hours IST of today, the 21st May, 2022.

Warnings:

(i) Rainfall (warning graphics enclosed)

Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy rainfall at isolated places very likely over Andaman Islands during next 24 hours.

(ii) Wind warning

Squally wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is very likely to prevail over Gulf of Martaban and adjoining North Andaman Sea and along & off South Myanmar coast during next 12 hours.

(iii) Sea condition

Rough Sea conditions very likely to prevail over Gulf of Martaban and adjoining North Andaman Sea and along & off South Myanmar coast during next 12 hours.

(iv) Fishermen Warning (warning graphics enclosed)

• Fishermen are advised not to venture into Gulf of Martaban, adjoining North Andaman Sea and along & off South Myanmar coast during next 12 hours.





