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Sub: Well Marked Low Pressure Area over Westcentral and adjoining Southwest Bay of Bengal off South Andhra Pradesh-North Tamil Nadu coasts

The Depression over Westcentral and adjoining Southwest Bay of Bengal moved westnorthwestwards and weakened into a well marked low pressure area over Westcentral and adjoining Southwest Bay of Bengal off South Andhra Pradesh-North Tamil Nadu coasts at 0830 hours IST of today, the 22nd November, 2022.

It is likely to move slowly west-northwestwards and weaken further during next 24 hours.

Warnings:

(i) Rainfall (warning graphics enclosed)

- Light to moderate rainfall at many places with isolated heavy rainfall is very likely over south coastal Andhra Pradesh on 22nd November and light to moderate rainfall at a few places over north Tamil Nadu-Puducherry during the same period.
- ❖ Light to moderate rainfall at few places is likely over North Tamil Nadu-Puducherry, South Coastal Andhra Pradesh and Rayalaseema on 23rd November.

(ii) Wind warning:

Squally weather wind speed reaching 40-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is likely to prevail over Westcentral and adjoining Southwest Bay of Bengal and along & off South Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry, Gulf of Mannar and adjoining North Sri Lanka coasts till

evening of today and decrease gradually thereafter becoming 30-40 kmph gusting 50 kmph by 23rd November morning.

(iii) Sea condition

Sea condition will be rough over Southwest and adjoining Westcentral Bay of Bengal and along & off south Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry, Gulf of Mannar and North Sri Lanka coasts till evening of today and improve gradually thereafter becoming rough to moderate by 23rd November morning.

(iv) Fishermen Warning

Fishermen are advised not to venture into Southwest and adjoining Westcentral Bay of Bengal and along & off south Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry, Gulf of Mannar and North Sri Lanka coasts on 22nd November.


