# Sub: Low Pressure Area formed over south Andaman Sea & adjoining Thailand coast.

A Low Pressure Area has formed over south Andaman Sea & adjoining Thailand coast at 0830 hrs IST of today the 13<sup>th</sup> November 2021. It is likely to move west-northwestwards and concentrate into a Depression over north Andaman Sea & adjoining Southeast Bay of Bengal by 15<sup>th</sup> November. Then it is likely to continue to move west–northwestwards, intensify further and reach near Andhra Pradesh coast around 18<sup>th</sup> November 2021.

# Warnings in association with the system:

#### (i) Rainfall (warning graphics enclosed)

**13<sup>th</sup> Nov.:** Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy rainfall at isolated places** very likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

14<sup>th</sup> Nov.: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places very likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

15<sup>th</sup> Nov.: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places very likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
16<sup>th</sup> Nov.: No heavy rainfall warning.

**17<sup>th</sup> Nov.:** Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at **isolated places** very likely over coastal Andhra Pradesh and heavy falls at isolated places over south coastal Odisha.

# (ii) Wind warning

Squally wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely to prevail over Andaman Sea & adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal on 13<sup>th</sup>, increase becoming 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph over the same region on 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup>, 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph over west-central & adjoining east-central Bay of Bengal during 16<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup> November 2021. Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph likely to commence and along & off Andhra Pradesh & south Odisha coasts from 17<sup>th</sup> November 2021.

# (iii) Sea condition

 Sea condition will be rough to very rough over Andaman Sea & adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal during 13<sup>th</sup> - 15<sup>th</sup> November, over west-central & adjoining east-central Bay of Bengal during 16<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup> and along & off Andhra Pradesh & south Odisha coasts on 17<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> November 2021.

# (iv) Fishermen Warning

- Fishermen are advised not to venture into Andaman Sea & adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal during 13<sup>th</sup> - 15<sup>th</sup> November, over west-central & adjoining east-central Bay of Bengal during 16<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup> November and along & off Andhra Pradesh & south Odisha coasts on 17<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> November 2021. - Fishermen out at Sea are advised to return to coast by 15<sup>th</sup> November 2021.

# (v) EXPECTED IMPACT (over Andaman & Nicobar Islands on $14^{th}$ & $15^{th}$ Nov. 2021) & ACTION SUGGESTED

# A. Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, inundation and water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- > Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides
- > Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.

# B. Action Suggested


- > Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- > Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- > Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.








