Sub: Cyclonic Storm 'Shaheen' over north Oman and adjoining United Arab Emirates

The **Severe Cyclonic Storm 'Shaheen'** over north coastal Oman continued to move west-southwestwards with a speed of about 09 kmph during past 6 hours, weakened into a **Cyclonic Storm** and lay centred at 0530 hrs IST of today, the 4th October, 2021 over north Oman and adjoining United Arab Emirates (UAE), near latitude 23.7°N and longitude 56.8°E, about 160 km nearly west of Muscat (Oman).

It is very likely to move west-southwestwards and weaken into a Deep Depression during next 06 hours and further weaken into a Depression during subsequent 06 hours.

Forecast track and intensity are given in the following table:

Warnings:

(i) Wind warning

 Gale wind speed reaching 70-80 kmph gusting to 90 kmph over north Oman and adjoining United Arab Emirates during next 06 hours and gradually reduce becoming 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph for subsequent 06 hours and reduce substantially thereafter.

(ii)Sea condition

 Sea condition will be high over Gulf of Oman and along & off north Oman coast during next 03 hours. It would be rough to very rough over north Oman coast and adjoining Gulf of Oman for subsequent 06 hours and improve substantially thereafter.

(iii) Fishermen Warning

• Fishermen are advised not to venture into Gulf of Oman and along & off north Oman coast during next 12 hours.

(iv) EXPECTED IMPACT & ACTION SUGGESTED

• Fishermen as well as Mariners are advised to avoid the Sea areas comprising Gulf of Oman and along & off north Oman coast during next 12 hours.


