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# Sub: Very Severe Cyclonic storm "Mocha" (pronounced as "Mokha") over Central Bay of Bengal

The Very Severe Cyclonic Storm "Mocha" (pronounced as "Mokha") over Central and adjoining Southeast Bay of Bengal moved nearly north-northeastwards with a speed of 15 kmph during past 06 hours and lay centered at 1130 hours IST of today, the 12th May 2023 over Central Bay of Bengal near latitude 14.0°N and longitude 88.3°E, about 540 km west-northwest of Port Blair, 900 km south-southwest of Cox's Bazar (Bangladesh) and 830 km south-southwest of Sittwe (Myanmar).

It is very likely to move north-northeastwards and intensify further into an Extremely Severe Cyclonic Storm over Eastcentral Bay of Bengal during night of today, the 12<sup>th</sup> May 2023. It is likely to cross southeast Bangladesh and north Myanmar coasts between Cox's Bazar (Bangladesh) and Kyaukpyu (Myanmar), close to Sittwe (Myanmar) around noon of 14th May, 2023 as a *Very Severe Cyclonic Storm with maximum sustained wind speed of 150-160 kmph gusting to 175 kmph.* 

Forecast track and intensity are given below:

## <u>Warnings:</u>

#### (i) Rainfall (warning graphics enclosed)

- Andaman & Nicobar Islands: Rainfall at most places with Heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely on 12<sup>th</sup> May.
- Tripura & Mizoram: Rainfall at most places with Heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely on 13<sup>th</sup> May and heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places on 14<sup>th</sup> May.
- Nagaland, Manipur & south Assam: Rainfall at many places with Heavy rainfall at isolated places is on 14<sup>th</sup> May.

### (ii) Wind warning:

Andaman Islands:

Squally wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph is likely to prevail on  $12^{th}$  May.

Tripura, Mizoram & south Manipur:

Squally wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph is very likely to prevail on 14<sup>th</sup> May.

North Andaman Sea:

Squally wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph is likely to prevail over North Andaman Sea on 12<sup>th</sup> May and 45-55 kmph gusting 65 kmph on 13<sup>th</sup> May.

# Southeast Bay of Bengal: Cole wind encodered reaching 115 125 kmph gw

Gale wind speed reaching 115-125 kmph gusting to 145 kmph is prevailing and likely to continue till evening and decrease thereafter becoming squally wind speed reaching 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph on 13<sup>th</sup> May.

# Adjoining areas of southwest Bay of Bengal:

Squally wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph is likely to prevail till 13<sup>th</sup> May morning.

### Eastcentral Bay of Bengal:

Gale wind speed reaching 130-140 kmph gusting to 155 kmph is prevailing over the region. It is very likely to increase becoming Gale wind speed reaching 160-170 kmph gusting to 185 kmph during 12<sup>th</sup> May evening and 180-190 kmph gusting to 210 kmph till 13<sup>th</sup> May evening and gradually decrease thereafter.

### Westcentral Bay of Bengal:

Gale wind speed reaching 130-140 kmph gusting to 155 kmph is likely to prevail on 12<sup>th</sup> May and becoming 150-160 kmph gusting to 185 kmph over southeastern sector of the region till 13<sup>th</sup> May morning. It will decrease gradually becoming 90-100 kmph gusting to 110 kmph by 13<sup>th</sup> May evening and significantly decrease thereafter.

### Northeast Bay of Bengal:

Squally wind speed reaching 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph is likely from evening of 12<sup>th</sup> May becoming gale wind speed reaching 70-80 gusting to 90 kmph from 13<sup>th</sup> May morning and would gradually increase becoming 180-190 kmph gusting 210 kmph from 13<sup>th</sup> evening till 14<sup>th</sup> May morning. It is likely to decrease thereafter to 150-16 kmph gusting to 175 kmph at the time of landfall. It is likely to decrease rapidly after the landfall.

### **Adjoining areas of Northwest Bay of Bengal:**

Gale wind speed reaching 60-70 kmph gusting to 80 kmph is likely to prevail over southeast sector of the region and 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph over the remaining areas of northwest Bay of Bengal from 13<sup>th</sup> May to 14th May forenoon and decrease gradually thereafter.

### (iii) Sea condition

Andaman Sea:

Very rough to rough over north Andaman Sea during 12<sup>th-</sup>13<sup>th</sup> May.

Southeast Bay of Bengal:

Very high to phenomenal sea condition is likely to prevail on 12<sup>th</sup> May. Very rough to rough on 13<sup>th</sup> May.

- Eastcentral Bay of Bengal: Very High to phenomenal sea condition is prevailing and would continue to be phenomenal till 14<sup>th</sup> May morning. It will improve gradually thereafter.
- Adjoining areas of Westcentral Bay of Bengal: Very high to phenomenal sea condition is prevailing and would continue to be phenomenal till 13<sup>th</sup> May morning. It will gradually improve thereafter.
- Northeast Bay of Bengal:

Rough to very rough on 12<sup>th</sup> May. It would become very rough to high till 13<sup>th</sup> May evening and very high to phenomenal till 14<sup>th</sup> May afternoon.

Adjoining areas of Northwest Bay of Bengal: Rough to very rough during 13<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup> May.

### (iv) Fishermen Warning (warning graphics enclosed)

- Fishermen, ships, boats and trawlers are advised not to venture into southeast Bay of Bengal till 12<sup>th</sup> May, central Bay of Bengal and north Andaman Sea till 14<sup>th</sup> May and into northeast Bay of Bengal during 12<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup> May.
- Those over central & northeast Bay of Bengal and north Andaman Sea are advised to return to coast.

### (v) Damage expected & Action suggested: Mizoram, Tripura, and South Manipur

- Minor Damage to loose/unsecured structures
- Some breaches in kutcha road due to heavy rain with the possibility of landslide, in vulnerable areas
- Uprooting of small trees and breaking of tree branches.
- Damage to small trees like Banana, Drum stick and Papaya etc.
- Damage to standing crops

#### Action Suggested

- Immediately harvest mature fruits and crops.
- Provide staking and cover to vegetables nurseries, fruit orchards.
- Avoid application of fertilizers and pesticides.
- Keep livestock inside sheds


(vi) Damage expected & Action suggested: Marine community (shipping, offshore industries, Tourism etc. over Bay of Bengal, Andaman Sea & Andaman & Nicobar Islands)

- Very rough to phenomenal sea could effect marine operation and offshore activities.
- Regulation of tourism and offshore activities and shipping near Andaman & Nicobar Islands till 13<sup>th</sup> May.
- Regulation of shipping activity over the sea areas of southeast Bay of Bengal and Andaman Sea till 12<sup>th</sup> May, eastcentral Bay of Bengal till 14<sup>th</sup> May, and westcentral Bay of Bengal till 13<sup>th</sup> May.
- Regulation of shipping activity over the sea areas of northeast Bay of Bengal during 12<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup> May.

The system is under continuous surveillance and the next message will be issued at 1730 hours IST of today, the 12<sup>th</sup> May 2023.


