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Sub: a) Well marked low pressure area over north interior Tamil Nadu and adjoining Karnataka and Rayalaseema weakened

b) Well marked low pressure area over East Central Arabian Sea

a) The well marked low pressure area over north interior Tamil Nadu and adjoining Karnataka and Rayalaseema became less marked

The well marked low pressure area over north interior Tamil Nadu and adjoining Karnataka and Rayalaseema weakened and lay as an upper air cyclonic circulation over south interior Karnataka extending upto mid-tropospheric levels at 0830 hrs IST of today, the 20th November 2021.

Under its influence, isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall likely over south interior Karnataka and coastal Karnataka and isolated heavy rainfall also likely over coastal Andhra Pradesh, Rayalaseema, TamilNadu, Kerala, north Interior Karnataka, South Konkan and Goa during next 24 hours.

24-hour accumulated realized rainfall during the period 18-20 Nov 2021 is placed at Annexure 1

b) Well marked low pressure area over Eastcentral Arabian Sea

The well marked low pressure area over Eastcentral Arabian Sea persisted over the same region at 0830 hours IST of today, the 20th November. It is likely to move west-southwestwards during next 2-3 days and weaken gradually. **As the system will move away from Indian coast, no adverse weather is likely over Indian landmass.**

(i) Wind warning

• Squally wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph very likely over Eastcentral Arabian Sea on 20th and 21st and then decrease gradually thereafter.

(ii)Sea condition

 Sea condition will be rough to very rough over Eastcentral Arabian Sea on 20th and 21st and then improve gradually thereafter.

(iii) Fishermen Warning

Fishermen are advised not to venture into Eastcentral Arabian Sea on 20th and 21st. (Graphics at Annexure 3).






