DEMS-RSMC SPECIAL TROPICAL CYCLONES NEW DELHI DATED 29.04.2022

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL AND ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR NEXT 120 HOURS ISSUED AT 0600 UTC OF 29.04.2022 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 29.04.2022.

BAY OF BENGAL:

A CYCLONIC CIRCULATION IS LIKELY TO FORM OVER SOUTH ANDAMAN SEA AND NEIGHBO RHOOD AROUND 04TH MAY. UNDER ITS INFLUENCE, A LOW PRESSURE AREA IS LIKELY TO FORM OVER THE SAME REGION DURING NEXT 24 HOURS. IT IS LIKELY TO BECOME MORE MARKED DURING SUBSEQUENT 24 HOURS.

SCATTERED LOW AND MEDIUM CLOUDS WITH EMBEDDED INTENSE TO VERY INTENSE CONVECTION LAY OVER SOUTH BAY OF BENGAL, ANDAMAN SEA, TENASSERIM COAST AND GULF OF MARTABAN. SCATTERED LOW AND MEDIUM CLOUDS OVER REST OF BAY OF BENGAL.

ARABIAN SEA:

SCATTERED LOW AND MEDIUM CLOUDS WITH EMBEDDED INTENSE TO VERY INTENSE CONVECTION LAY OVER SOUTH ARABIAN SEA. SCATTERED LOW AND MEDIUM CLOUDS WITH EMBEDDED MODERATE TO INTENSE CONVECTION LAY OVER LAKSHADWEEP ISLANDS AND COMORIN AREA. SCATTERED LOW AND MEDIUM CLOUDS WITH EMBEDDED WEAK CONVECTION OVER CENTRAL ARABIAN SEA.
