HOURLY UPDATE ON EXTREMELY SEVERE CYCLONIC STORM '**TAUKTAE**' OVER NORTHEAST ARABIAN SEA



LOCATION LATITUDE/LONGITUDE	THE VERY SEVERE CYCLONIC STORM 'TAUKTAE' LAY CENTRED AT 0030 HRS IST OF 18 TH MAY 2021 OVER SAURASHTRA, NEAR LAT. 21.0°N AND LONG. 71.15°E, ABOUT 30 KM NORTHEAST OF DIU. REAR EYE WALL IS CROSSING THE COAST.
CURRENT INTENSITY NEAR CENTRE	140-150 KMPH GUSTING TO 165 KMPH
PAST MOVEMENT	VERY SEVERE CYCLONIC STORM ' TAUKTAE ' MOVED NORTH- NORTHWESTWARDS WITH A SPEED OF 15 KMPH DURING PAST 06 HOURS.
FORECAST MOVEMENT AND INTENSITY	IT WOULD MOVE NORTH-NORTEAST WARDS AND WEAKEN GRADUALLY INTO A SEVRE CYCLONIC STORM BY TODAY MORNING.
FORECAST RAINFALL	LIGHT TO MODERATE RAINFALL AT MOST PLACES WITH HEAVY TO VERY HEAVY FALLS AT A FEW PLACES AND EXTREMELY HEAVY FALLS AT ISOLATED PLACES VERY LIKELY OVER GUJARAT REGION AND HEAVY TO VERY HEAVY FALLS & EXTREMELY HEAVY FALLS AT ISOLATED PLACES VERY LIKELY OVER SAURASHTRA ON 18 TH MAY. 


