



As the system is expected to move away from the Indian coast, no adverse weather would occur along and off west coast of India due to this system.





As the system is expected to move away from the Indian coast, no adverse weather would occur along and off west coast of India due to this system.







The **Cyclonic Storm 'MEGH'** moved west-southwestwards at a speed of 10 kmph in past six hours and lay centred at 0830 hrs IST of today the 6th November 2015 over westcentral Arabian sea near latitude **13.5**°N and longitude **62.4**°E, about 920 km east-northeast of Socotra Island (Yemen), **1270** km southwest of Mumbai (43003), and 970 km southeast of Salalah (Oman). It would move west-southwestwards and intensify into a Severe Cyclonic Storm during next 24 hrs. Thereafter it would move west-southwestwards towards Gulf of Aden and weaken gradually from 8th November morning.

As the system is moving away from the Indian coast, no adverse weather would occur along and off west coast of India due to this system.







Sub: Cyclonic Storm 'MEGH' over westcentral Arabian Sea.

The Cyclonic Storm 'Megh' moved west-southwestwards at a speed of 17 kmph during past six hours and lay centred at 1730 hrs IST of today the 6th November 2015 over westcentral Arabian Sea near Latitude 13.0°N and Longitude 61.0°E, about 770 km east-northeast of Socotra Island (Yemen), 1430 km west-southwest of Mumbai and 860 km east-southeast of Salalah (Oman). It would continue to move west-southwestwards towards Gulf of Aden, reaching close to northern tip of Somalia around noon of 9th November. The system would weaken gradually from noon of 7th November mainly due to cold and dry air intrusion from the Arabian Peninsula.

No adverse weather would occur along and off west coast of India due to this system.







It would move west-southwestwards towards Gulf of Aden, reaching close to northern tip of Somalia around noon of 9th November. The system would intensify further into a severe cyclonic storm during next 12 hours. It would maintain its intensity till the morning of 8th November and weaken gradually thereafter.

No adverse weather would occur along and off west coast of India due to this system.







The Cyclonic Storm 'Megh' moved west-southwestwards with a speed of 15 kmph during past six hours intensified into **Severe Cyclonic Storm** at 1430 hrs IST of today, the 7th November 2015 and now lay centred at 1730 hrs IST of today the 7th November 2015 over westcentral Arabian Sea near Latitude 12.6°N and Longitude 58.3°E, about 470 km east of Socotra Island (Yemen), 1710 km west-southwest of Mumbai and 660 km east-southeast of Salalah (Oman). It would move west-southwestwards passing along southern coast of Socotra Island around evening of 8th November 2015. It would then move west-northwestwards towards Gulf of Aden, reaching close to northern tip of Somalia around noon of 9th November and would cross Yemen coast between latitude 13 - 14 degree North during afternoon/evening of 10th November. The system would intensify further into a **very severe cyclonic storm** during next 6 hours. It would maintain its intensity till evening of 8th November and weaken gradually thereafter.

No adverse weather would occur along and off west coast of India due to this system.



It would move west-northwestwards and cross Yemen coast near latitude 13.2 degree north (northeast of Aden) around noon of 10th November and then weaken gradually.



B: Cyclonic storm 'MEGH' over Gulf of Aden

The Cyclonic Storm 'MEGH' moved west-northwestwards with a speed of 5 kmph during past six hours, rapidly weakened into a **Deep Depression** and lay centred at **1130** hours IST of today, the 10th November 2015 over Gulf of Aden near latitude **13.1°N** and longitude **45.6°E**, about **70** km east-northeast of Aden. It would move northwestwards, weaken further and cross Yemen coast near latitude 13.3 degree North (northeast of Aden) around evening of 10th November. Due to rapid weakening of the system, there is also possibility of the dissipation of the deep depression over Gulf of Aden close to Yemen coast.

This is the last bulletin for the depression over north Tamil Nadu and deep depression over Gulf of Aden. However, regular bulletins will continue from National Weather Forecasting Centre, New Delhi, Regional Meteorological and Meteorological Centres.
