It would move northnorthwestwards and intensify further into a deep depression during next 24 hrs.

Strong winds speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph would prevail along and off Maharashtra, Konkan and Goa coasts during next 48 hrs. Sea condition would be rough along and off Maharashtra, Konkan and Goa coasts during the same period.

Fishermen along and off Maharashtra, Konkan and Goa coasts are advised not to venture into the sea during next 48 hours.
