Sub: Depression over North Chhattisgarh and adjoining northeast Madhya Pradesh

The depression over Northeast Chhattisgarh and adjoining Jharkhand moved westwards with a speed of 25 kmph during past 6 hours and lay centered at 1130 hours IST of today, the 17th September 2024, over **North Chhattisgarh and adjoining northeast Madhya Pradesh** near latitude 23.7° N and longitude 82.7° E, around 80 km northwest of Ambikapur (Chhattisgarh), 120 km southeast of Sidhi (Madhya Pradesh), 130 km northeast of Pendra Road (Chhattisgarh), 140 km west-southwest of Daltonganj (Jharkhand) and 190 km east of Umaria (Madhya Pradesh).

It is likely to move nearly west-northwestwards across northwest Chhattisgarh, south Uttar Pradesh and adjoining northeast Madhya Pradesh and weaken into a Well-Marked Low Pressure Area during next 12 hours.

Warnings:

(i) Rainfall warning

Madhya Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places is likely over North Madhya Pradesh on 17th September and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 18th September over Northwest Madhya Pradesh.

Uttar Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Southeast Uttar Pradesh on 17th September. Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Southwest Uttar Pradesh on 17th and 18th September.

Jharkhand: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Jharkhand on 17th September.

Bihar: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy rainfall** at isolated places is very likely over South Bihar on 17th September.

Chhattisgarh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over North Chhattisgarh on 17th September.

East Rajasthan: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 17th September.

(ii) Flash Flood Guidance: (Graphics Attached)

24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 18-09-2024:

Low to Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of following Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.

East Uttar Pradesh – Banda district

West Uttar Pradesh - Hamirpur, Jhansi, Lalitpur and Mahoba districts.

East Madhya Pradesh - Chhatarpur, Damoh, Jabalpur, Katni, Mandla, Narshimpura, Panna, Sagar and Seoni districts.

West Madhya Pradesh - Ashoknagar, Bhind, Datia, Gwalior, Shivpuri and Videsha districts.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils and low-lying areas over Area of Concern due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.

(iii) Wind warning:

Squally wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph over North Chhattisgarh and adjoining Southeast Uttar Pradesh, Northeast Madhya Pradesh & Jharkhand till 17th September evening and decrease thereafter.

Impact Expected (North Madhya Pradesh, south Uttar Pradesh, Jharkhand, North Chhattisgarh and South Bihar due to heavy rainfall and strong winds)

- ✓ Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- ✓ Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- ✓ Disruption of traffic in major cities and roadways due to water logging in roads and poor visibility due to heavy rain leading to increased travel time and incidents
- ✓ Likely disruption of inland water transportation like small boats and trawlers.
- ✓ Minor damage to kutchha roads.
- ✓ Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- ✓ Localized Landslides/Mudslides/landslips/mud slips/land sinks/mud sinks.
- ✓ Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation and wind.
- ✓ It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC)

Action Suggested (North Madhya Pradesh, southeast Uttar Pradesh, Jharkhand, North Chhattisgarh

- ✓ Judicious regulation of surface transports including railways.
- ✓ Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- ✓ Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- ✓ Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- ✓ Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.

Agromet advisories for Heavy Rainfall likely over various parts of the country

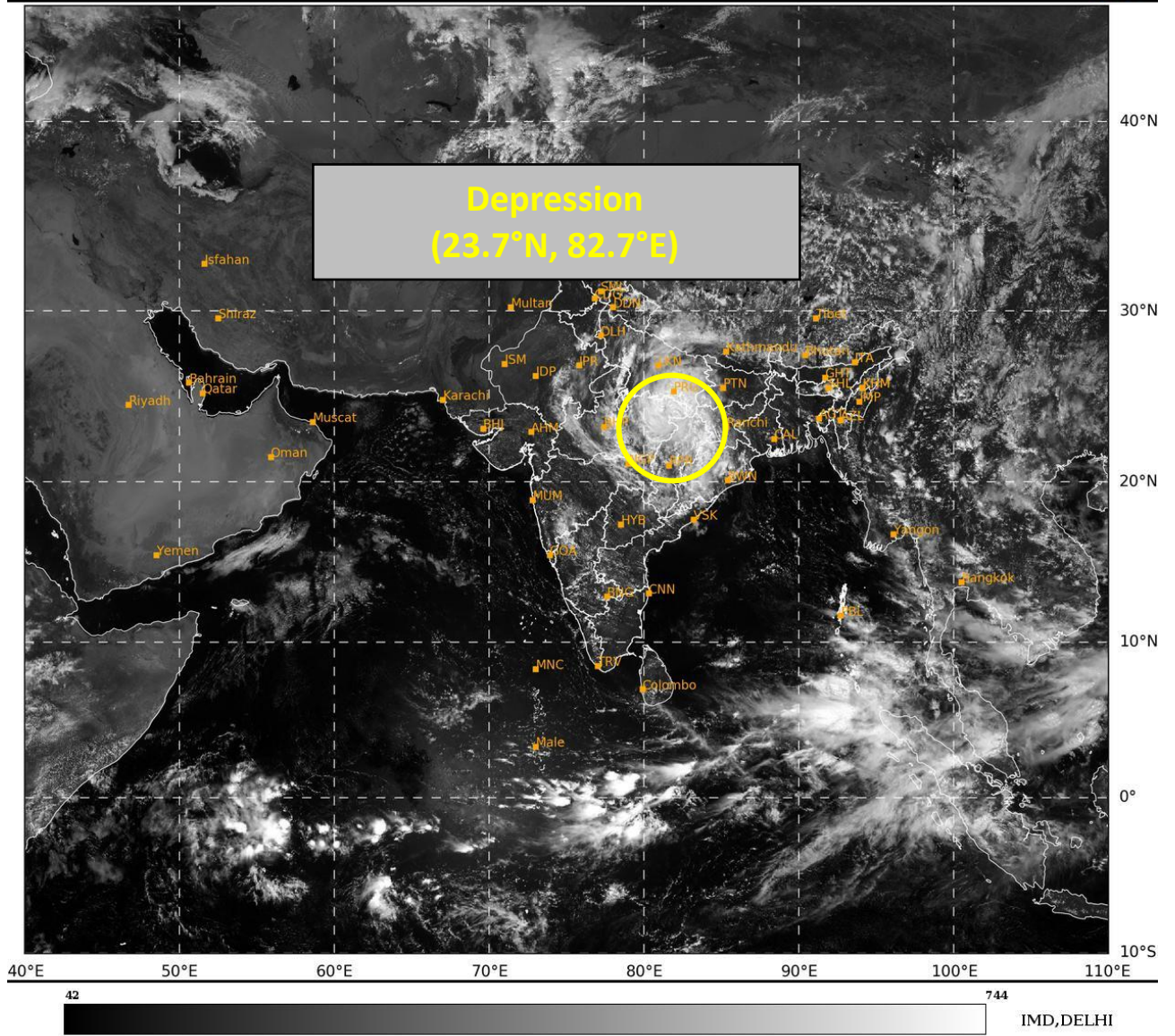
- ✓ Provide mechanical support to horticultural crops & staking to vegetables.
- ✓ Keep the harvested produce at safer places.

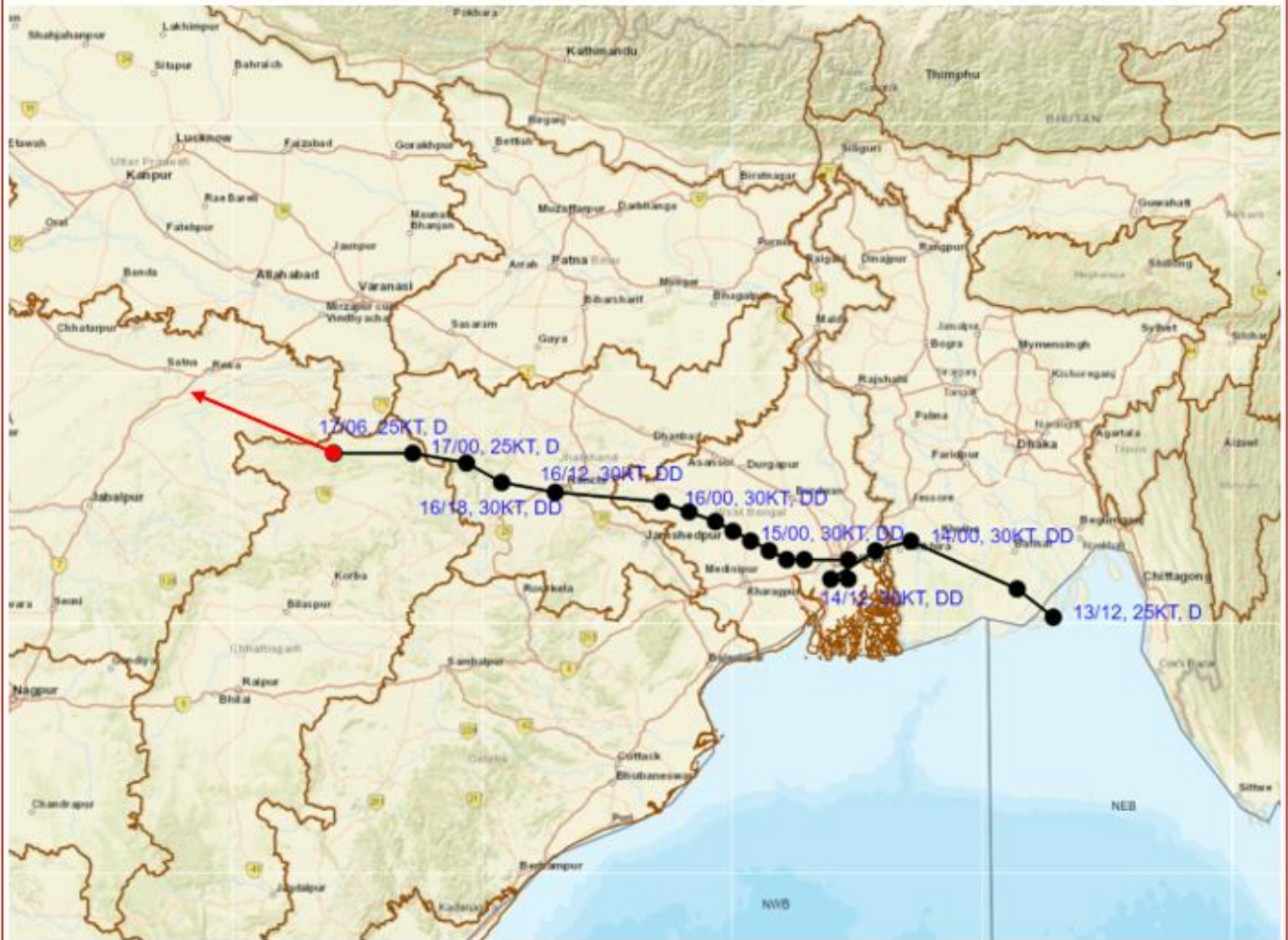

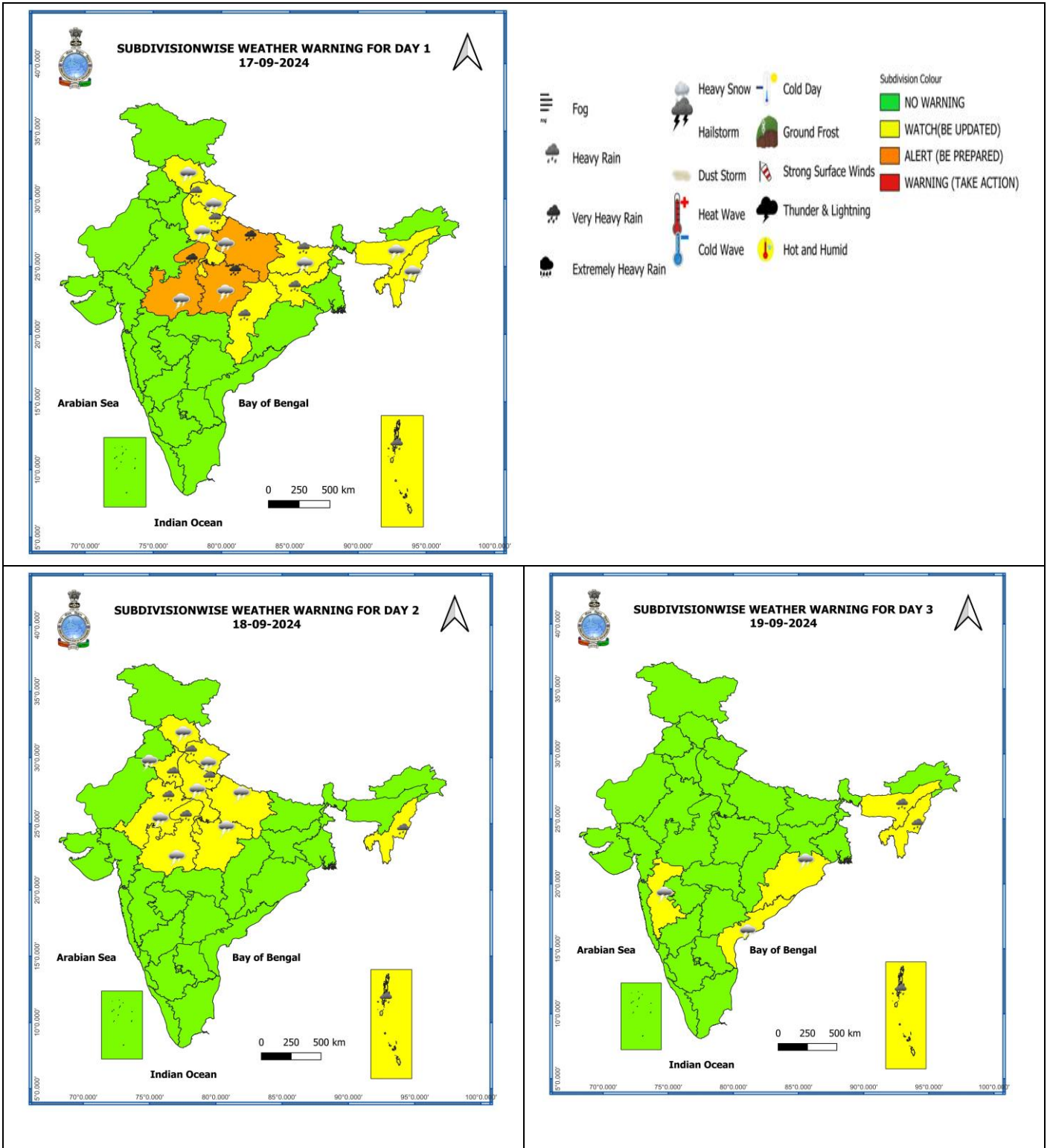

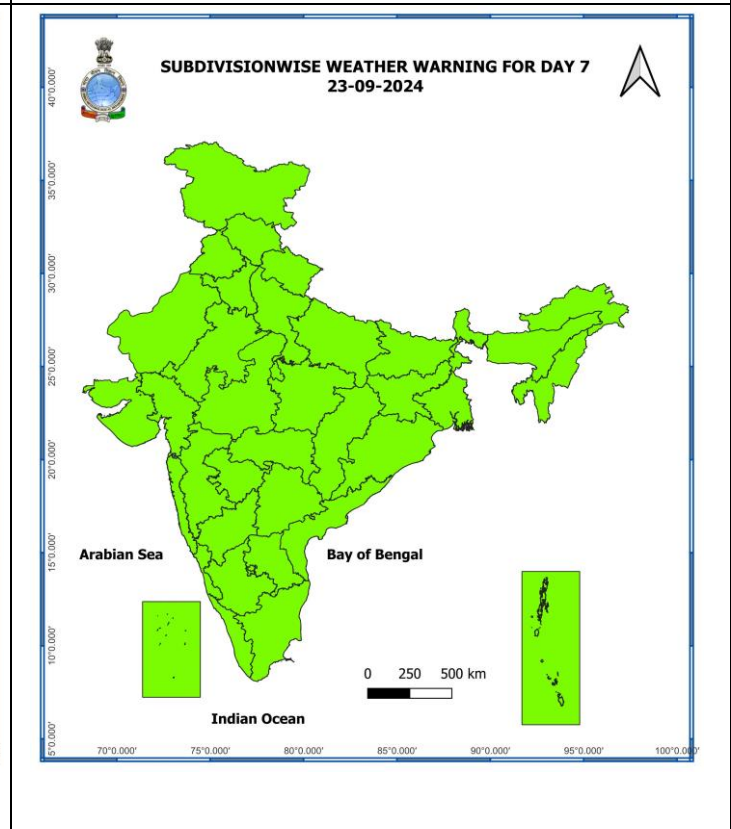

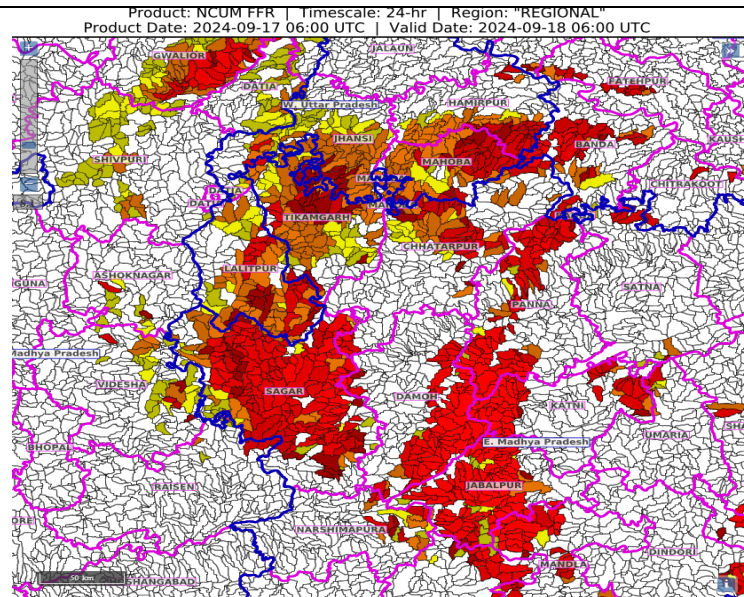

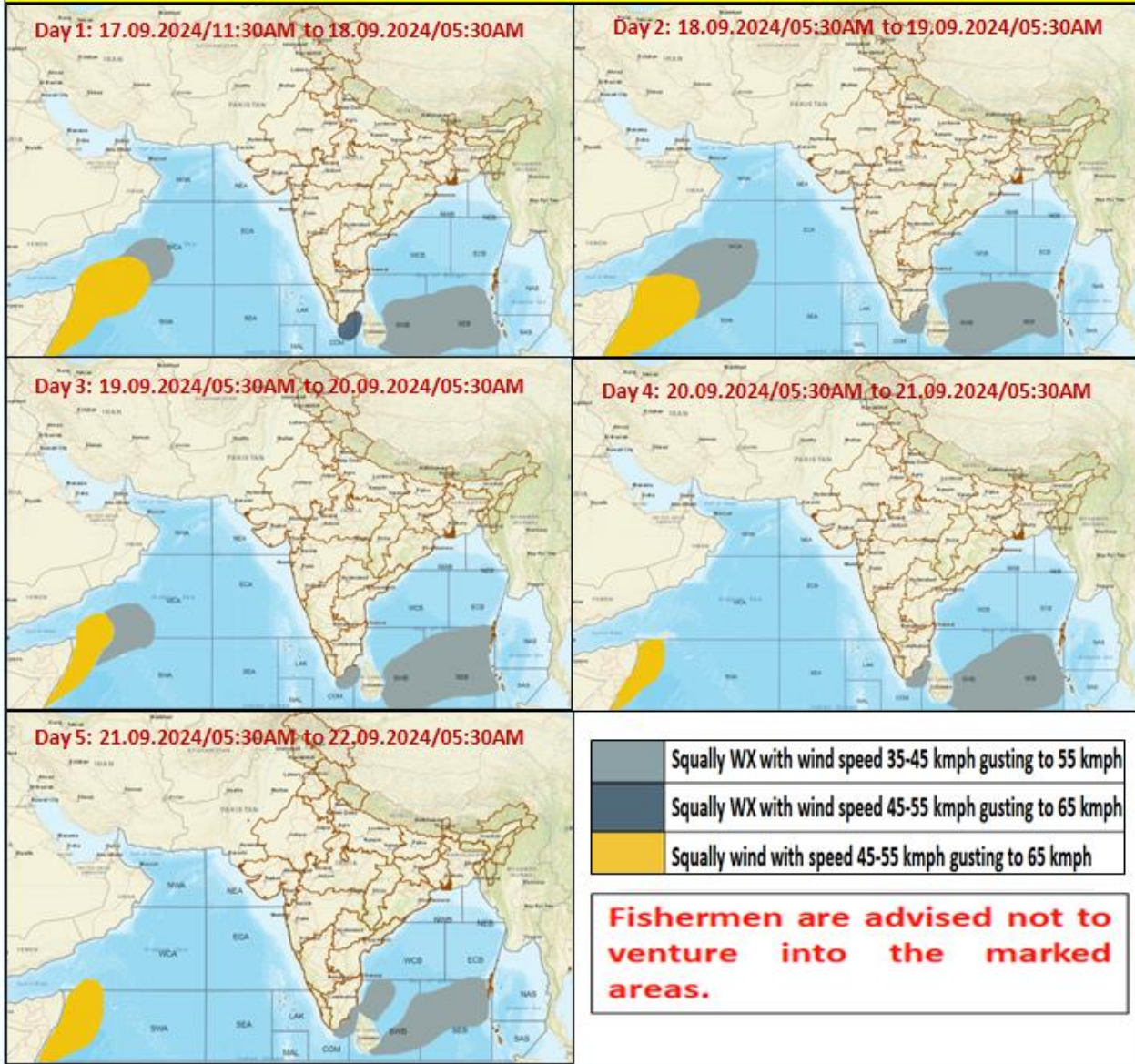
