#### **Sub: Depression over southwest Bay of Bengal**

The depression over southwest Bay of Bengal moved west-northwestwards with a speed of 12 kmph during past 6 hours and lay centered at 0530 hours IST of today, the 16th October 2024 over the same region near latitude 12.1° N and longitude 83.4° E, about 360 km east-southeast of Chennai (Tamil Nadu), 390 km east of Puducherry and 450 km southeast of Nellore (Andhra Pradesh).

It is likely to move west-northwestwards and cross north Tamil Nadu - South Andhra Pradesh coasts between Puducherry and Nellore, close to Chennai during early morning of 17th October.

Forecast track and intensity are given in the following table:

#### Warnings:

#### (i) Rainfall Warning:

**Tamil Nadu & Puducherry:** Light to moderate rainfall over most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places with extremely heavy rainfall at isolated places is very likely over north Tamil Nadu & Puducherry on 16<sup>th</sup> October and isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall over north interior Tamil Nadu on 17<sup>th</sup> October.

Light to moderate rainfall over most places with heavy rainfall at isolated places is very likely over south Tamil Nadu during 16<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> October.

**South Andhra Pradesh & Rayalaseema:** Light to moderate rainfall over most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places with extremely heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely on 16<sup>th</sup> October and heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely on 17<sup>th</sup> October.

**Kerala & south Interior Karnataka:** Light to moderate rainfall over most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely over Kerala and south Interior Karnataka during 16<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> October.

#### (ii) Wind Warning:

Squally wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting 60 kmph is likely to prevail over southwest and adjoining westcentral Bay of Bengal and along & off Tamil Nadu, Puducherry and south Andhra Pradesh coasts till noon of 17<sup>th</sup> October and decrease gradually thereafter.

#### (iii) Sea Condition:

Rough to very Rough Sea condition is likely to prevail over southwest & adjoining westcentral Bay of Bengal and along & off Tamil Nadu, Puducherry and south Andhra Pradesh coasts till noon of 17<sup>th</sup> October and improve gradually thereafter.

#### (iv) Fishermen Warning:

Fishermen are advised not to venture into

- Southwest and adjoining westcentral Bay of Bengal till 17th October.
- Fishermen out at sea are advised to return to coasts.

#### (v) Flash Flood Guidance:

#### 24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 0530 IST of 17-10-2024:

Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of following Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours

Coastal Andra Pradesh & Yanam - Guntur, Prakasam and Nellore districts.

**Ravalaseema -** Chittoor and Kadapa districts.

**Tamil Nadu -** Cuddalore, Dharampuri, Krishnagiri, Perambalur, Salem, Tiruchirappalli, Tiruvallur and Vellore districts.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over area of concern as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.

#### ❖ Impact Expected [Tamil Nadu (including Chennai) and Andhra Pradesh due to heavy rainfall]

- Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities and roadways due to water logging in roads and poor visibility due to heavy rain leading to increased travel time and incidents
- o Likely disruption of marine and inland water transportation like small boats and trawlers.
- o Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- o Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- o Localized Landslides/Mudslides/landslips/mud slips/land sinks/mud sinks.
- o Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation and wind.
- It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Webpage of Central Water Commission)

#### **❖** Action Suggested [Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh due to heavy rainfall]

- o Fishermen are advised not to venture into
  - -Southwest and adjoining westcentral Bay of Bengal till 17th October.
  - -Fishermen out at sea are advised to return to coasts.
- Judicious regulation of surface transports including railways and roadways and onshore/offshore activities.
- o Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- o Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- o Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- o Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.

#### **Agromet advisories for Heavy Rainfall**


- o Provide mechanical support to horticultural crops & staking to vegetables.
- o Keep the harvested produce at safer place.












AREA OF MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WIND SPEED:








- Action may be taken based on **ORANGE** AND **RED** COLOUR warnings.
