Subject: Well-marked low-pressure area over Eastcentral Arabian Sea off south Konkan coast

The low-pressure area over Eastcentral Arabian Sea off south Konkan-Goa coasts became a Well-marked low-pressure area over Eastcentral Arabian Sea off south Konkan coast at 0530 hrs IST of today, the 23rd May 2025. It persisted over the same region at 0830 hrs IST of today, the 23rd May 2025. It is likely to move nearly northwards and intensify further into a depression during next 24 hours.

Warnings:

- (i) Rainfall Warning:
- Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at few places is likely over Konkan Goa, Karnataka and Madhya Maharashtra during 23rd -28th May with Isolated extremely heavy rainfall over Konkan Goa during 23rd - 25th May; Madhya Maharashtra on 25th May; coastal Karnataka during 24th-27th May; North Interior Karnataka on 25th May and South Interior Karnataka during 24th-27th May.
- Light to moderate rainfall at most places with isolated heavy rainfall is very likely over south Gujarat during 23rd – 27th May.

(ii) Wind Warning:

Squally wind with speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is prevailing over Eastcentral Arabian Sea and adjoining Northeast Arabian Sea, along and off Konkan-Goa coast. It would increase becoming 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph on 24th and 25th May over Eastcentral Arabian Sea and along & off Konkan, Goa and adjoining south Gujarat coasts. Squally windspeed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph very likely to prevail along and off Kerala and Karnataka coasts, south east Arabian sea and Lakshadweep area during 23rd – 27th May.

(iii) Sea Condition:

Sea condition is likely to be Rough to very rough during 23rd to 27th May over Southeast & Eastcentral Arabian Sea, Lakshadweep area and along & off Kerala, Karnataka, Goa, Maharashtra and adjoining south Gujarat coasts.

(iv) Warning:

Fishermen are advised not to venture into

- (A) Eastcentral & southeast Arabian Sea and along & off Kerala, Karnataka, Konkan, Goa, south Gujarat, Daman & Diu, Dadar & Nagar Haveli coasts and Lakshadweep area till 27th May 2025.
- (B) Fishermen out at sea are advised to return to coasts by 23rd May afternoon.
- (C) Small ships/shipping activities are to be monitored and regulated during 25th to 27th May 2025.
- (D) Judicious regulation of tourism and recreational activities.
