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## Subject: Depression over northwest Arabian Sea and adjoining southwest Pakistan weakened into a well marked low pressure area

The depression over northwest Arabian Sea and adjoining Pakistan moved nearly westwards and weakened into a well marked low pressure area over northwest Arabian Sea and adjoining southwest Pakistan at 0530 hours IST of today, the 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2025.

It is very likely to continue to move nearly westwards and weaken gradually into a low pressure area during next 12 hours.

#### Warnings:

#### (i) Rainfall Warning: NIL

### (ii) Wind Warnings:

Squally weather with wind speed reaching 35-45 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail over central parts of northwest Arabian Sea and along & off southwest Pakistan coast during next 12 hours and would gradually decrease thereafter.

#### (iii) Sea condition:

Sea condition is likely to be moderate to rough over northwest Arabian Sea and along & off southwest Pakistan coast during next 12 hours and would gradually improve thereafter.

#### (iv) Fishermen Warning:


• Fishermen are advised not to venture into northwest Arabian Sea and along & off southwest Pakistan coast during next 12 hours.
