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**Sub: Depression weakened into a well marked low pressure area over north Andaman Sea & adjoining south Myanmar coast**

The depression over north Andaman Sea & neighbourhood moved north-northeastwards and weakened into a well marked low pressure area over north Andaman Sea and adjoining south Myanmar coast at 1130 hrs IST of today, the 03<sup>rd</sup> April, 2021. It is likely to weaken further into a Low Pressure Area over the same region during next 12 hours.

**Warnings:**

**(i) Rainfall**

Light to moderate rainfall at few places (upto 6 cm) very likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands during next 24 hours.

**(ii) Wind warning**

Squally winds speed reaching 25-35 kmph gusting to 45 kmph very likely over north Andaman Sea during next 06 hours and decrease thereafter.

**(iii) Sea condition**

Sea condition will be rough over north Andaman Sea during next 12 hours and improve thereafter.

**(iv) Fishermen Warning**

The fishermen are advised not to venture into north Andaman Sea owing to the likely prevalence of occasional squally weather over the region during next 12 hours.

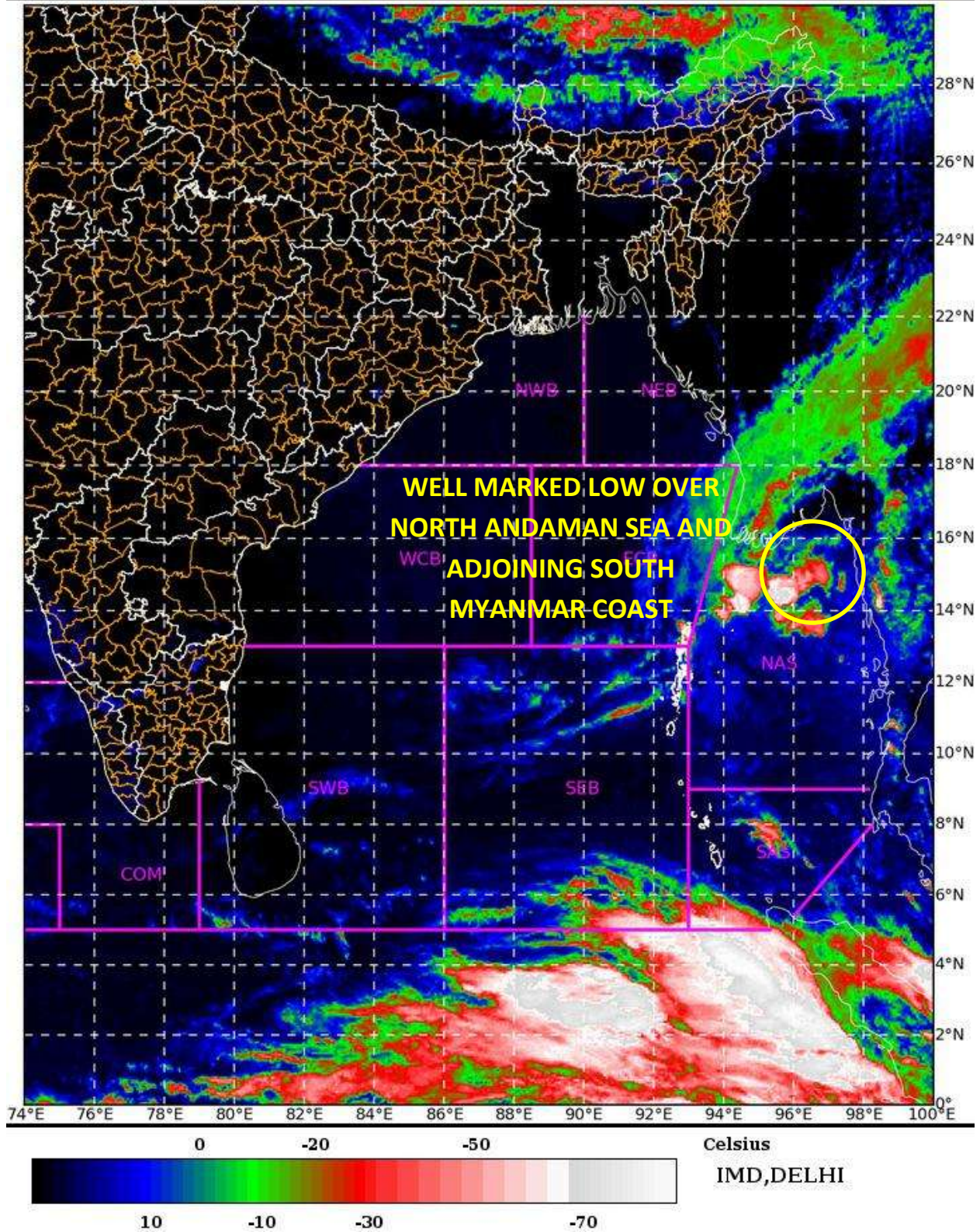
