**Subject: Well-marked low pressure over northwest and adjoining central Bay of Bengal**

An upper air cyclonic circulation formed over coastal areas of central Myanmar and adjoining eastcentral Bay of Bengal in the forenoon (0830 hours IST) of 24th September. It moved nearly westwards and lay over eastcentral & adjoining northeast Bay of Bengal in the early morning (0530 hrs IST) of 25th September. It moved nearly westwards and lay over eastcentral and adjoining northeast Bay of Bengal in the forenoon (0830 hrs IST) of 25th September. Under its influence, a low pressure area formed over central parts of north and adjoining central Bay of Bengal in the evening (1730 hours IST) of 25th September. Subsequently, it moved westwards and lay as a well-

marked low pressure area over northwest and adjoining central Bay of Bengal in the morning (0530 hrs IST) and persisted over the same region at 0830 hrs IST of today, the 26th September, 2025.

Moving further westwards, it is very likely to concentrate into a depression over northwest and adjoining westcentral Bay of Bengal off South Odisha- North Andhra Pradesh coasts during next 24 hours. It is very likely to cross South Odisha-North Andhra Pradesh coasts around 27th September morning.

### **Warnings:**

#### **(i) Rainfall Warning:**

**Odisha:** Light to moderate rainfall at most places and heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places with extremely heavy rainfall at isolated places is very likely over South Odisha on 26<sup>th</sup> and very heavy rainfall at isolated places on 27<sup>th</sup> September.

**Gangetic West Bengal:** Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy rainfall at isolated places is very likely on 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> September.

**Andhra Pradesh:** Light to moderate rainfall at many places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely over coastal Andhra Pradesh on 26<sup>th</sup> and heavy rainfall at isolated places on 27<sup>th</sup> September.

**Jharkhand & Chhattisgarh:** Light to moderate rainfall at many places with heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely over during 26<sup>th</sup> September.

**Telangana:** Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at a few places is likely on 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> with extremely heavy rainfall at isolated places on 26<sup>th</sup> September and heavy rainfall at isolated places 28<sup>th</sup> September.

**Rayalaseema:** Light to moderate rainfall at many places with heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely over on 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> September.

**East Madhya Pradesh:** Light to moderate rainfall at many places with heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely over on 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> September.

**West Madhya Pradesh:** Light to moderate rainfall at many places with heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely during 27<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> September

**Madhya Maharashtra and Konkan & Goa:** Light to moderate rainfall at many places with heavy rainfall at isolated places on 26<sup>th</sup>; heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely during 27<sup>th</sup>- 29<sup>th</sup> September with extremely heavy rainfall at isolated places on 28<sup>th</sup> September.

**Vidarbha:** Light to moderate rainfall at many places with heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely over on 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> September.

**Marathwada:** Light to moderate rainfall at many places with heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely during 26<sup>th</sup>- 29<sup>th</sup> September with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places on 27<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup> September.

**Gujarat State:** Light to moderate rainfall at many places with heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely during 27<sup>th</sup>- 30<sup>th</sup> September with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places on 29<sup>th</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup> September.

**(ii) Wind warning:**

- ❖ Squally weather with wind speed reaching 35-45 gusting to 55 kmph is very likely to prevail over Northwest and Central Bay of Bengal and along & off Andhra Pradesh- Odisha- West Bengal-Bangladesh coasts till evening of 26th September. It would gradually increase becoming squally wind speed reaching 40-50 gusting to 60 kmph over the same region from 26th evening till 27th September afternoon.

**(iii) Sea condition:**

- ❖ Sea condition is very likely to be moderate to rough over Northwest and Central Bay of Bengal and along & off Andhra Pradesh- Odisha- West Bengal-Bangladesh coasts till evening of 26th September. It would become rough to very rough over the same region from 26th evening till 27th September afternoon.

**(iv) Fishermen warnings:**

Fishermen are advised not to venture into North and Central Bay of Bengal and along & off Andhra Pradesh-Odisha-West Bengal coasts on 26th & 27th September.

**(v) Impact Expected and Action Suggested due to heavy rain and strong winds**

**Impact expected:**

- ❖ Breaking of tree branches. Strong wind and rain may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- ❖ Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls, huts and roads due to strong winds and heavy rain.
- ❖ Road and rail traffic may be affected due to heavy rain.
- ❖ There could be localised landslides, mudslides, landslips, water logging, inundation and flooding over low lying areas.
- ❖ Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- ❖ Surface transport and helicopter services may get affected.

**Action suggested:**

- ❖ People are advised to keep a watch on the weather for worsening conditions and be ready to move to safer places accordingly.
- ❖ Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees, as there could be lightning.
- ❖ In case of expected lightning, unplug electrical/ electronic appliances, immediately, get out of water bodies and keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.
- ❖ Tourism and recreational activities to be regulated.
- ❖ Surface transport and helicopter services to be regulated.

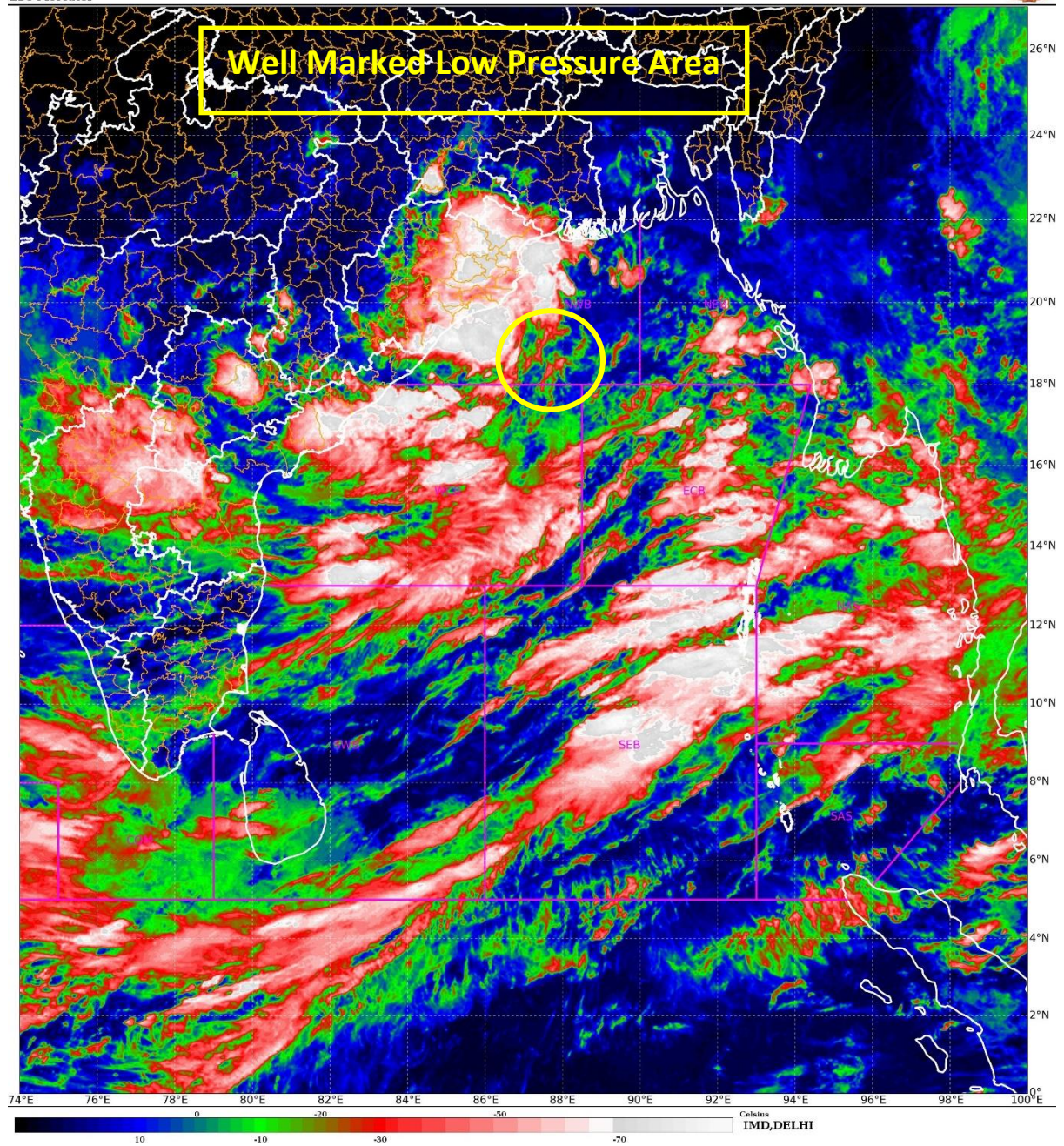
