#### Sub: Depression over north Chhattisgarh & neighbourhood

The Depression over north Chhattisgarh and neighbourhood remained practically stationary during past three hours and lay centred at 1130 hours IST of 03<sup>rd</sup> August, 2023 over the same region near latitude 23.5°N and longitude 83.1°E, about 40 km north-northwest of Ambikapur (Chhattisgarh) and 160 km south-southeast of Sidhi (East Madhya Pradesh).

It is likely to move slowly west-northwestwards towards northeast Madhya Pradesh and adjoining southeast Uttar Pradesh and weaken into a Well Marked Low Pressure Area during next 06 hours.

## Realized Rainfall on 2<sup>nd</sup> August, 2023:

24 hours accumulated heavy rainfall (≥7 cm) during 0830 hrs IST of 2<sup>nd</sup> to 0830 hrs IST of 3<sup>rd</sup> August is placed at Annexure-I

#### Warnings:

(i) Rainfall warning:

**East Madhya Pradesh**: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places on 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> and isolated extremely heavy rainfall on 3<sup>rd</sup> August. Heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely on 5<sup>th</sup> August.

**West Madhya Pradesh**: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to extremely heavy rainfall at isolated places on 3<sup>rd</sup> August. Heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely on 4<sup>th</sup> August.

**Chattisgarh:** Light to moderate rainfall at most places with isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall over north Chhattisgarh on 3<sup>rd</sup> and heavy rainfall at isolated places on 4<sup>th</sup> August.

**South Uttar Pradesh**: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with isolated heavy rainfall during 3<sup>rd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> August.

Vidharbha: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with isolated heavy rainfall on 3<sup>rd</sup> August.

### (v) Damage Expected over north Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha and south Uttar Pradesh

- Minor damage to loose / unsecured structures.
- Some breaches in Kutcha road due to flooding.
- Damage to standing agriculture & horticulture crops.
- Minor damage to Kutcha embankments.









# **Flash Flood Guidance**

#### 24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 0530 IST of 04-08-2023 :

Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of Chhattisgarh, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, West Madhya Pradesh and Odisha Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.
