Sub: Depression over north Chhattisgarh & neighbourhood

The Depression over north Chhattisgarh and neighbourhood moved westnorthwestwards with a speed of 17 kmph during past 6 hours and lay centred at 0830 hours IST of 03rd August, 2023 over the same region near latitude 23.5°N and longitude 83.1°E, about 40 km north-northwest of Ambikapur (Chhattisgarh) and 160 km south-southeast of Sidhi (East Madhya Pradesh).

It is likely to move west-northwestwards towards northeast Madhya Pradesh and adjoining southeast Uttar Pradesh and weaken into a Well Marked Low Pressure Area during next 12 hours.

Realized Rainfall on 2nd August, 2023:

24 hours accumulated heavy rainfall (≥7 cm) during 0830 hrs IST of 2nd to 0830 hrs IST of 3rd August is placed at Annexure-I

Warnings:

(i) Rainfall warning:

East Madhya Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places on 3rd & 4th and isolated extremely heavy rainfall on 3rd August. Heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely on 5th August.

West Madhya Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to extremely heavy rainfall at isolated places on 3rd August. Heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely on 4th August.

Chattisgarh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall over north Chhattisgarh on 3rd and heavy rainfall at isolated places on 4th August.

South Uttar Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with isolated heavy rainfall during 3rd to 6th August.

Vidharbha: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with isolated heavy rainfall on 3rd August.

(v) Damage Expected over north Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha and south Uttar Pradesh

- Minor damage to loose / unsecured structures.
- Some breaches in Kutcha road due to flooding.
- Damage to standing agriculture & horticulture crops.
- Minor damage to Kutcha embankments.









Flash Flood Guidance

24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 0530 IST of 04-08-2023 :

Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of Chhattisgarh, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, West Madhya Pradesh and Odisha Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.
