# Subject: Well Marked Low Pressure Area over West Vidarbha and adjoining North Madhya Maharashtra

The depression over west Vidarbha and neighbourhood moved nearly westwards and weakened into a well-marked low-pressure area over West Vidarbha and adjoining North Madhya Maharashtra at 0830 hours IST of today, the 28th September 2025. It is likely to weaken further into a low-pressure area during next 24 hours. It is likely to continue to move nearly westwards across North Madhya Maharashtra, south Gujarat and Saurashtra during 28th to 30th September and emerge as a low-pressure area over Northeast Arabian Sea off Gujarat coast by 1st October.

### Warnings:

#### (i) Rainfall Warning:

**West Madhya Pradesh:** Light to moderate rainfall at most places is very likely with heavy rainfall at isolated places on 28<sup>th</sup> September.

**Madhya Maharashtra and Konkan & Goa:** Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places and extremely heavy rainfall at isolated places over North Konkan (including Mumbai) & North Madhya Maharashtra and isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall over South Konkan, South Madhya Maharashtra & Goa is very likely during 28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup> September.

**West Vidarbha:** Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy rainfall at isolated likely on 28<sup>th</sup> September.

**Marathwada:** Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely on 28<sup>th</sup> September.

**Coastal Karnataka:** Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy rainfall at isolated places is very likely on 28<sup>th</sup> September.

**Gujarat region:** Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to extremely heavy rainfall at isolated places over south Gujarat region and isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall over north Gujarat region is very likely during 28<sup>th</sup>- 29<sup>th</sup> September and heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely over Gujarat region on 30<sup>th</sup> September.

**Saurashtra & Kutch:** Light to moderate rainfall at many places with heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely on 28<sup>th</sup> September. It is very likely to increase becoming light to moderate rainfall at most places with isolated heavy to extremely heavy rainfall on 29<sup>th</sup>, heavy to very heavy rainfall on 30<sup>th</sup> September and isolated heavy rainfall on 1<sup>st</sup> October.

**Southeast Rajasthan:** Light to moderate rainfall at many places with heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely on 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> September.

### (ii) Wind warning:

Squally wind speed reaching 40-50 gusting to 60 kmph is very likely to prevail over Eastcentral & adjoining Northeast Arabian Sea and along & off Maharashtra and South Gujarat coasts during 28<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> September.

Squally wind speed reaching 40-50 gusting to 60 kmph is very likely to prevail over Northeast Arabian Sea and along & off North Gujarat coast during 29<sup>th</sup> September to 1<sup>st</sup> October.

Strong surface wind speed reaching 30-40 gusting to 50 kmph is very likely over West Vidarbha, North Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada and adjoining areas of South Gujarat & South Madhya Pradesh on 28<sup>th</sup> September.

Strong surface wind speed reaching 30-40 gusting to 50 kmph is very likely over Gujarat, North Maharashtra and Southwest Madhya Pradesh on 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> September.

#### (iii) Sea condition:

Sea condition is very likely to be rough to very rough over Eastcentral & adjoining Northeast Arabian Sea and along & off Maharashtra and South Gujarat coasts during 28<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> September and off North Gujarat coast during 29<sup>th</sup> September- 1<sup>st</sup> October.

#### (iv) Fishermen warnings:

Fishermen are advised not to venture into Eastcentral & Northeast Arabian Sea and along & off Maharashtra and Gujarat coasts till 1st October.

# (v) Impact Expected and Action Suggested due to heavy rain and strong winds over West Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra and Gujarat State.

### Impact expected:

- Breaking of tree branches. Strong wind and rain may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls, huts and roads due to strong winds and heavy rain.
- ❖ Road and rail traffic may be affected due to heavy rain.
- There could be localised landslides, mudslides, landslips, water logging, inundation and flooding over low lying areas.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Surface transport and helicopter services may get affected.

### **Action suggested:**

People are advised to keep a watch on the weather for worsening conditions and be ready to move to safer places accordingly.

- ❖ Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees, as there could be lightning.
- ❖ In case of expected lightning, unplug electrical/ electronic appliances, immediately, get out of water bodies and keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.
- Tourism and recreational activities to be regulated.
- Surface transport and helicopter services to be regulated.

### Agromet advisories for likely impact:

- ➤ Maharashtra: Make arrangements to drain out excess water from rice, groundnut, vegetables and orchard in North Konkan. Keep the harvested produce of black gram, soybean and kidney beans (rajma) at safer places and ensure proper drainage in the fields of rice, pigeon pea, soybean, maize, cotton, sugarcane, vegetables and orchards in North Madhya Maharashtra. Drain out excess water from soybean, cotton, pigeon pea, vegetables and orchards.
- **West Madhya Pradesh:** Ensure proper drainage in the fields of soybean, maize, cotton, black gram and vegetables. Keep the harvested produce of soybean and other field crops at safer places.
- ➤ **Gujarat:** Keep the harvested produce at safer places. Make necessary arrangements to drainout excess water from the fields of rice, sugarcane, vegetables and fruit orchards in **Gujarat region**; and cotton, pigeon pea, pearl millet and vegetables in **Saurashtra & Kutch**.

### **Livestock / Fishery**


- ➤ Keep the animals inside the shed during heavy rainfall and provide them balanced feed.
- > Store feed and fodder in a safe place to prevent spoilage.
- > Construct an outlet with proper netting around the ponds to drain out excess water, thereby preventing fish from escaping in case of overflow.

24 hours accumulated realised heavy rainfall (≥7 cm) ending at 0830 hours IST of today, the 28<sup>th</sup> September is placed at Annexure-1.

This is last bulletin in association with this system. However, regular bulletins shall continue from National Weather Forecasting Centre, New Delhi, Regional Meteorological Centre Mumbai, Meteorological Centres Ahmedabad, Jaipur, Bengaluru and Bhopal in association with the remnant of this depression.







FORECAST TRACK CONE OF UNCERTAINTY



### 24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 0530 IST of 29-09-2025 :


Low to Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of following Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.

**Gujarat Region** - Dadar & Nagar Haveli, Daman, Bharuch, Narmada, Navsari, Surat, Tapi and Valsad districts.

**Konkan & Goa** - Mumbai City, Palghar, Raigarh, Ratnagiri, Suburban Mumbai and Thane districts.

**Madhya Maharashtra** - Ahmadnagar, Dhule, Kolhapur, Nandurbar, Nasik, Pune, Satara and Solapur districts.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over Area of Concern (AoC) as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.
