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Sub: Deep Depression (Remnant of Cyclonic Storm "FENGAL") weakened into a Depression over north coastal Tamil Nadu & Puducherry

Deep Depression (Remnant of Cyclonic Storm "FENGAL") over north coastal Tamil Nadu & Puducherry moved slowly west-northwestwards during past 06 hours, weakened into a depression and lay centered at 1730 hours IST of today, the 1st December 2024 over the same region near latitude 12.1°N and longitude 79.6°E, about 20 km northeast of Villupuram, 30 km west-northwest of Puducherry, about 40 km north-northwest of Cuddalore and 120 km south-southwest of Chennai.

It is likely to continue to move west-northwestwards and weaken gradually into a Well Marked Low pressure area over north interior Tamil Nadu during the next 12 hours.

The system is being continuously monitored by the Doppler Weather Radar at Karaikal.

Forecast track and intensity are given in the following table:

Warnings:

(i) Rainfall Warning:

Tamil Nadu & Puducherry: Light to moderate rainfall at few places with **heavy to very rainfall at** isolated places is very likely over North Tamil Nadu & Puducherry on 1st & 2nd December and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over the interior districts of Tamil Nadu adjoining to Kerala on 03rd December.

Rayalaseema: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **heavy rainfall** at isolated places is very likely on 01st and 2nd December.

South Interior Karnataka: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **heavy rainfall** at isolated places is very likely on 01st & 3rd December and heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places is very likely on 2nd December.

Coastal Karnataka: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **heavy rainfall** at isolated places is very likely on 2nd and 3rd December.

Kerala: Light to moderate rainfall at a few places with isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall is likely on 1st December. Rainfall activity will increase with light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at a few places & **extremely heavy** at isolated places on 2nd and heavy rainfall at isolated places on 3rd December.

(ii) Wind warning:

- Southwest Bay of Bengal and along & off North Tamil Nadu Puducherry coasts: Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is prevailing. It is likely to decrease becoming squally wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph from morning of 2nd December and decrease gradually thereafter.
- Adjoining areas of westcentral Bay of Bengal and along & off South Andhra Pradesh coast: Squally wind speed reaching 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is likely to prevail over adjoining areas of westcentral Bay of Bengal till morning of 2nd December. It is likely to decrease thereafter.
- Along & off South Tamil Nadu coast and Gulf of Mannar: Squally wind speed reaching 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is likely to prevail till 1st December and gradually decrease thereafter.

(iii) Sea condition:

Rough Sea conditions is likely to prevail over southwest Bay of Bengal adjoining areas of westcentral Bay of Bengal, and along & off North Tamil Nadu-Puducherry coasts, Gulf of Mannar, along & off South Andhra Pradesh and north Sri Lanka coasts till morning of 2nd December. It will gradually improve thereafter.

(iv) Fisherman warning (Graphics Attached):

- Total suspension of fishing operations till 1st December over southwest and adjoining westcentral Bay of Bengal.
- Fishermen are advised not venture into southwest Bay of Bengal adjoining areas of westcentral Bay of Bengal, Gulf of Mannar and along & off Tamil Nadu-Puducherry, South Andhra Pradesh and North Sri Lanka coasts till 1st December.

(v) Flash Flood Guidance (Graphics Attached): Persistent Flash Flood Threat (PFFT) till 2330 IST of 01-12-2024 :

Moderate flash flood threat likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of following Met Subdivisions during next 6 hours. Rayalaseema - Chittoor district. Tamil Nadu - Puducherry & Karaikal -Dharampuri, Krishnagiri, Tiruvannamalai, Vellore and Villupuram districts. Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over Area of Concern (AoC) as shown in map (Annexure) due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 6 hours

(vi) Impact Expected:

- Major damage to Kutcha and minor damage to Pucca roads.
- Some damage to paddy crops, banana, papaya, drum sticks (moringa) trees and orchards.
- Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops including vegetable crops in some areas due to inundation.

(vii) Action Suggested:

- Total suspension of fishing operations till 1st December.
- Fishermen are advised not to venture into southwest Bay of Bengal adjoining areas of westcentral Bay of Bengal, Gulf of Mannar and along & off Tamil Nadu-Puducherry, South Andhra Pradesh and North Sri Lanka coasts till 1st December.
- The ships plying over the area need to regulated.
- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Special care may be taken for fishing ponds and poultries over coastal areas.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.

(viii) Agromet advisories:

Provide adequate drainage facilities for the removal of excess water from rice, cotton, sugarcane, turmeric, tobacco and vegetable fields, coconut and banana orchards. Provide mechanical support to banana plants to prevent lodging.

- Make arrangements to drain out excess water from the standing crop fields and fruit orchards.
- Harvest the matured crops and keep it in safe place.
- Provide mechanical support to horticultural crops and staking to vegetable crops.

Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal: Tiruvannamalai 15, Yercaud 7, Tiruppattur, Dharmapuri, Cuddalore 3 each, Vellore, Parangipettai, Salem 2 each;

Kerala & Mahe: Ranni_Chethackal (Pathanamthitta), Seethathode (Pathanamthitta), Laha (Pathanamthitta) 7 each, Kunnamthanam (Pathanamthitta) 5; Kottayam, Konni (Pathanamthitta), Thycattussery (Alappuzha) 3 each, Kumarakom_Afmu (Kottayam) 2;











MAXIMUM REFLECTIVITY IMAGERY FROM DOPPLER WEATER RADAR, KARIKAL





- As the lead period increases forecast accuracy decreases.




Persistent Flash Flood Threat (PFFT) till 2330 IST of 01-12-2024 :
