Sub: Well Marked Low Pressure Area over central parts of south Bay of Bengal.

The Low Pressure Area over southeast Bay of Bengal lay as a Well Marked Low Pressure Area over southeast and adjoining southwest Bay of Bengal at 0530 hrs IST of today the 10th November. It lay over central parts of south Bay of Bengal at 0830 hrs IST. It is likely to concentrate into a Depression over Southwest Bay of Bengal during next 12 hours, move west-northwestwards and reach near north Tamilnadu coast by the early morning of 11th November, 2021. Thereafter, it is likely to continue to move west-northwestwards and cross north Tamil Nadu & adjoining south Andhra Pradesh coast between Karaikal & Sriharikota around Cuddalore by the evening of 11th November 2021.

Warnings:

(i) Rainfall (warning graphics enclosed)

10th Nov.: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places & extremely heavy falls at isolated places** very likely over north coastal Tamil Nadu, north interior Tamil Nadu and south coastal Andhra Pradesh and heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places over Rayalaseema.

11th Nov.: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places & extremely heavy falls at isolated places very likely over north coastal Tamil Nadu, north interior Tamil Nadu, south coastal Andhra Pradesh and Rayalaseema.

(ii) Wind warning

 Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph likely to prevail over southwest & adjoining westcentral Bay of Bengal and along & off Tamil Nadu & south Andhra Pradesh coasts during 10th – 11th November.

(iii) Sea condition

 Sea condition will be rough to very rough over southwest & adjoining west-central Bay of Bengal and along & off Tamil Nadu & south Andhra Pradesh coasts during 10th – 11th November.

(iv) Fishermen Warning

• Fishermen are advised not to venture into southwest & adjoining west-central Bay of Bengal and along & off Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & south Andhra Pradesh coasts during $10^{th} - 11^{th}$ November (Graphics enclosed).

(v) EXPECTED IMPACT & ACTION SUGGESTED

A. Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, inundation and water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- > Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- > Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides
- > Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC)

B. Action Suggested

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- > Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- > Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.











