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Subject: Depression over westcentral Vidarbha and adjoining south Madhya Pradesh

The Depression over east Vidarbha and adjoining westcentral Chhattisgarh moved nearly west-northwestwards with a speed of 15 kmph during past 6 hours, and lay centred at 0830 hrs IST of today, the 31st July 2026, over westcentral Vidarbha and adjoining south Madhya Pradesh near latitude 21.1°N and longitude 78.2°E, 50 km east-northeast of Amravati (Maharashtra), 60 km northwest of Wardha (Maharashtra), 90 km south-southeast of Betul (Madhya Pradesh), 210 km east-southeast of Khandwa (Madhya Pradesh) and 280 km east-southeast of Khargone (Madhya Pradesh).

It is very likely to move west-northwestwards across Vidarbha, south Madhya Pradesh & adjoining Madhya Maharashtra and weaken into a well marked low pressure area during next 24 hours.

Warnings:

(i) Rainfall Warning:

Gujarat Region: Light to moderate rainfall at most places is very likely with heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places and **exceptionally heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 31st July and extremely heavy rainfall at isolated places on 1st August and heavy rainfall at isolated places on 2nd August.

Saurashtra & Kutch: Light to moderate rainfall at most places is likely with heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places and **extremely heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 31st July & 1st August and heavy rainfall at isolated places on 2nd August.

Madhya Maharashtra: Light to moderate rainfall at most places is very likely with heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places and **extremely heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 31st July; very heavy rainfall at isolated places on 01st and heavy rainfall at isolated places on 02nd & 3rd August.

Konkan & Goa: Light to moderate rainfall at most places is very likely with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 31st July & 1st August and heavy rainfall at isolated places on 2nd & 3rd August.

Vidarbha: Light to moderate rainfall at most places is very likely with **heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 31st July.

East Rajasthan: Light to moderate rainfall at most places is very likely with heavy rainfall at isolated places on 31st July; **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 01st and heavy rainfall at isolated places on 2nd August.

West Rajasthan: Light to moderate rainfall at most places is very likely with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 1st & 2nd August.

West Madhya Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places is very likely with **heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 31st July.

Marathwada: Light to moderate rainfall at most places is very likely with **heavy** rainfall at isolated places is very likely on 31st July.

(ii) Wind Warning:

- ❖ Squally winds with speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is very likely to prevail over Vidarbha & south Madhya Pradesh during next 24 hours.

(v) Impact Expected and Action Suggested due to heavy rainfall and squally winds

Impact expected:

- ❖ Breaking of tree branches, uprooting of small trees like banana, papaya, drum sticks. Strong wind and rain may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- ❖ Partial damage to vulnerable structures due to strong winds and rain.
- ❖ Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls, huts and roads due to heavy rain.
- ❖ Road and rail traffic may be affected due to heavy rain and squally winds.
- ❖ There could be localised landslides, mudslides, landslips, water logging, inundation and flooding over low lying areas.
- ❖ Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- ❖ Helicopter services may get affected.

Action suggested:

- ❖ People are advised to keep a watch on the weather for worsening conditions and be ready to move to safer places accordingly.
- ❖ Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees, as there could be lightning.
- ❖ In case of expected lightning, unplug electrical/ electronic appliances, immediately, get out of water bodies and keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.
- ❖ Tourism and recreational activities to be regulated.
- ❖ Helicopter services to be regulated.

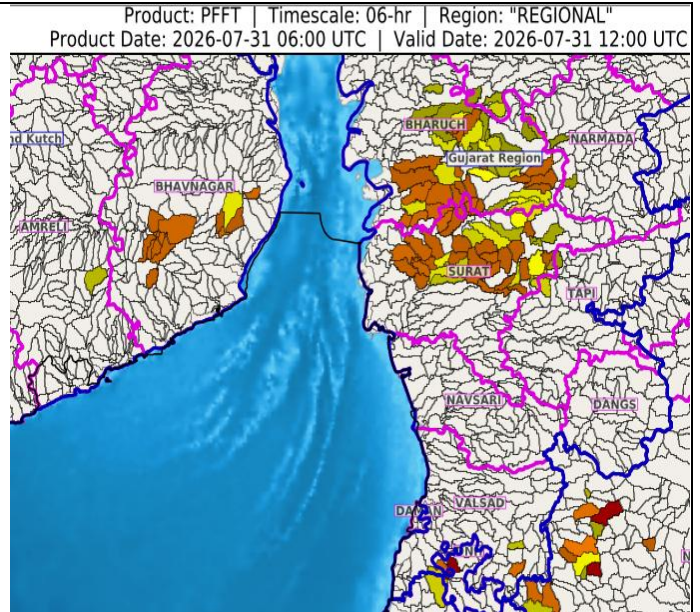
Persistent Flash Flood Threat (PFFT) till 1730 IST of 31-07-2026 :

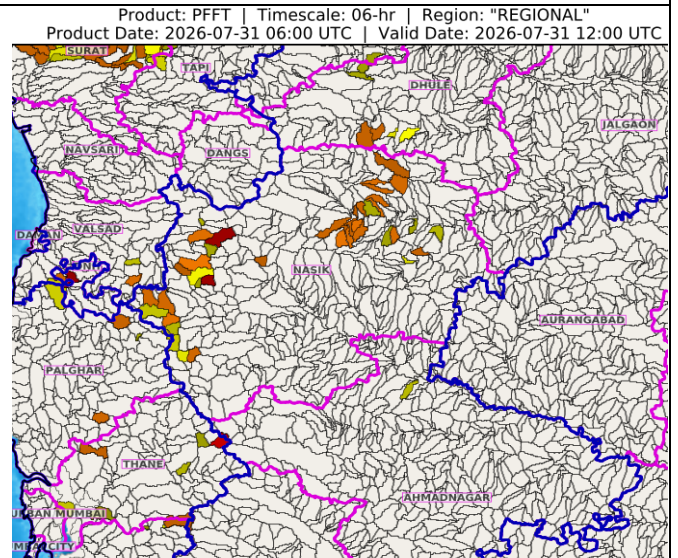

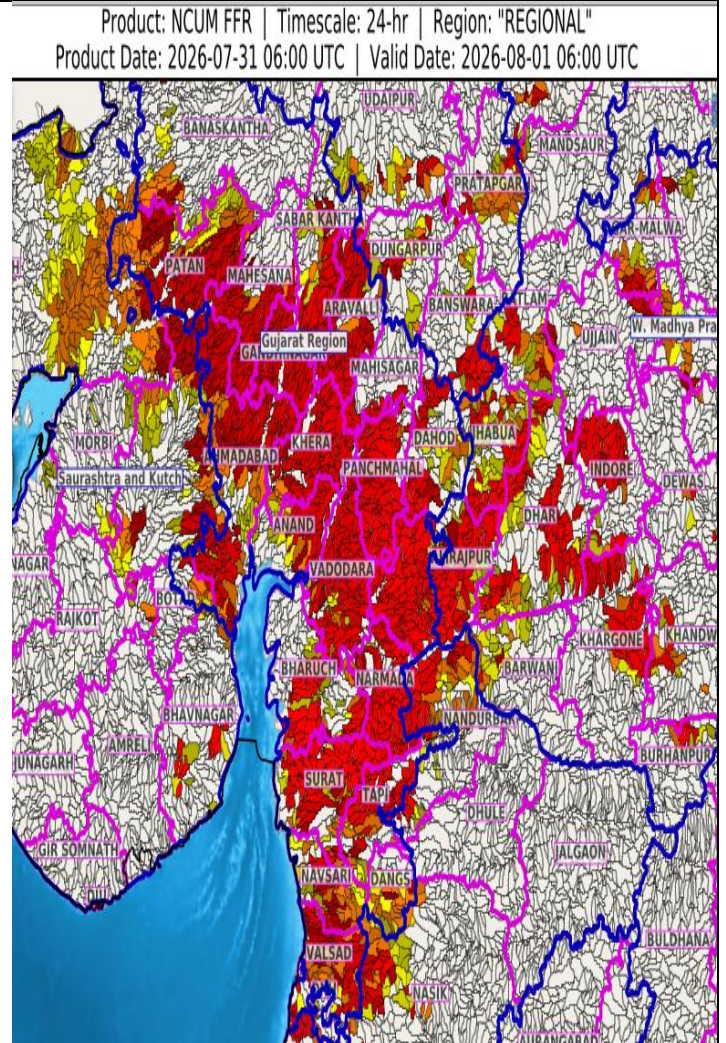

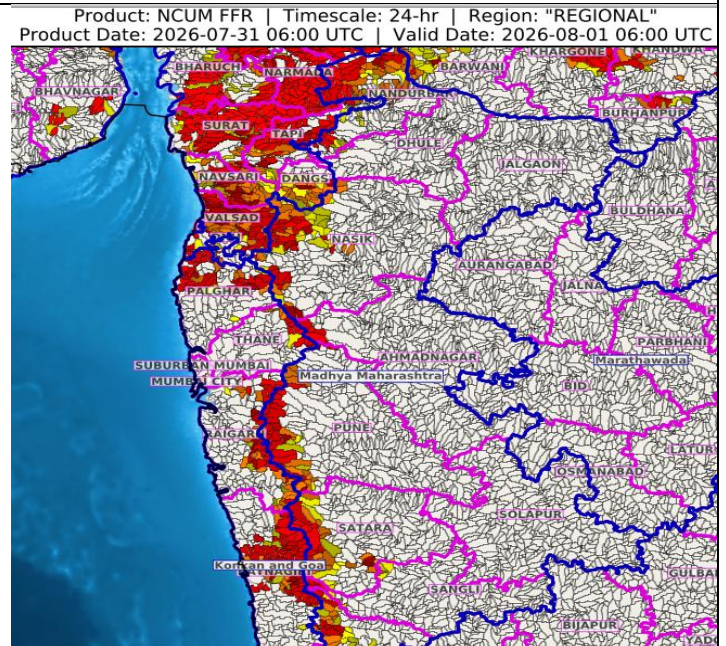
