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Subject: (A) Depression over Southeast Arabian Sea

(B) Well Marked low pressure area over north Coastal Tamil Nadu & neighborhood

(A) Depression over Southeast Arabian Sea

The Depression over southeast Arabian Sea moved nearly northwards with a speed of 7 kmph during past 6 hours and lay centered at 1730 hrs IST of today, 22nd October 2025, over the same region, near latitude 9.3°N & longitude 67.4°E, about 620 km west-southwest of Aminidivi (Lakshadweep) and 980 km southwest of Panjim (Goa).

It is likely to move initially northwards and thereafter recurve north-northeastwards during next 24 hours.

Warnings:

(i) Rainfall Warning:

Lakshadweep Islands: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with isolated heavy rainfall during 21st to 22nd October.

Kerala: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places during 22nd October and heavy rainfall at isolated places during 23rd-24th October,

Coastal Karnataka: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places is very likely on 22nd October and heavy rainfall at isolated places on 23rd & 24th October.

(ii) Wind warning:

Squally wind with speed reaching 45-55 gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail over Southeast and adjoining Eastcentral Arabian Sea till 24th October.

Squally weather with wind speed reaching 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is very likely to prevail over Lakshadweep & Comorin Area and along & off Karnataka, Kerala and adjoining South Tamil Nadu coasts till 24th October.

(iii) Sea condition:

Sea Condition is likely to be rough to very rough over Southeast and adjoining Eastcentral Arabian Sea till 24th October.

Sea Condition is likely to be rough over Lakshadweep & Comorin Area and along & off Karnataka, Kerala and adjoining South Tamil Nadu coasts till 24th October.

(iv) Fishermen warnings:

Fishermen are advised not to venture into Southeast & adjoining Eastcentral Arabian Sea, Lakshadweep & Comorin Area and along & off Karnataka, Kerala and adjoining South Tamil Nadu coasts till 24th October.

(v) Impact Expected and Action Suggested due to heavy rain and strong winds (Lakshadweep Islands, Kerala and coastal Karnataka)

Impact expected:

- ❖ Breaking of tree branches. Strong wind and heavy rain may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- ❖ Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls, huts and roads due to strong winds and heavy rain.
- ❖ Road and rail traffic may be affected due to heavy rain.
- ❖ There could be localised flash floods, landslides, mudslides, landslips, water logging, inundation and flooding over low lying areas.
- ❖ Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- ❖ Surface & Helicopter services may be regulated.
- ❖ Small ships & country boats would be affected due to strong wind and heavy rain.

Action suggested:

- ❖ People are advised to keep a watch on the weather for worsening conditions and be ready to move to safer places accordingly.
- ❖ Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees, as there could be lightning.
- ❖ In case of expected lightning, unplug electrical/ electronic appliances, immediately, get out of water bodies and keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.
- ❖ Tourism and recreational activities to be regulated.
- ❖ Surface transport and helicopter services to be regulated.

(B) Well Marked low pressure area over north Coastal Tamil Nadu and neighbourhood

The Well marked low pressure area over southwest Bay of Bengal off Tamil Nadu coast moved nearly northwestwards across north Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & south Andhra Pradesh coasts and lay over the north coastal Tamil Nadu and neighbourhood at 1730 hrs IST of today, the 22nd October 2025.

It is likely to move west-northwestwards across north Tamil Nadu & south Andhra Pradesh and weakened into a low pressure area during next 24 hours.

Warning:

(i) Rainfall Warning:

Tamil Nadu & Puducherry: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy rainfall at isolated places is very likely on 23rd & 24th and heavy to extremely heavy rainfall at isolated places over North Tamil Nadu on today, the 22nd October.

Andhra Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to extremely heavy rainfall at isolated places coastal Andhra Pradesh and Rayalaseema is very likely during 22nd, heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places on 23rd and isolated heavy rainfall 24th & 25th October.

South Interior Karnataka: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places is very likely on 22nd and isolated heavy rainfall on 23rd & 24th October.

Telangana: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy rainfall at isolated places is very likely during 23rd to 25th October.

(ii) Wind warning:

Squally wind with speed reaching 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is likely to prevail over southwest Bay of Bengal & adjoining areas central Bay of Bengal and along & off Tamil Nadu - south Andhra Pradesh coasts till 23rd October evening.

(iii) Sea conditions:

Sea condition is likely to be rough over southwest Bay of Bengal & adjoining areas of central Bay of Bengal and along & off Tamil Nadu - south Andhra Pradesh coasts till 23rd October evening.

(iv) Fishermen Warning:

Fishermen are advised not to venture into Southwest and adjoining central Bay of Bengal till 23rd October evening.

(v) Impact Expected and Action Suggested due to heavy rain and strong winds (Tamil Nadu, Puducherry and Andhra Pradesh)

Impact expected:

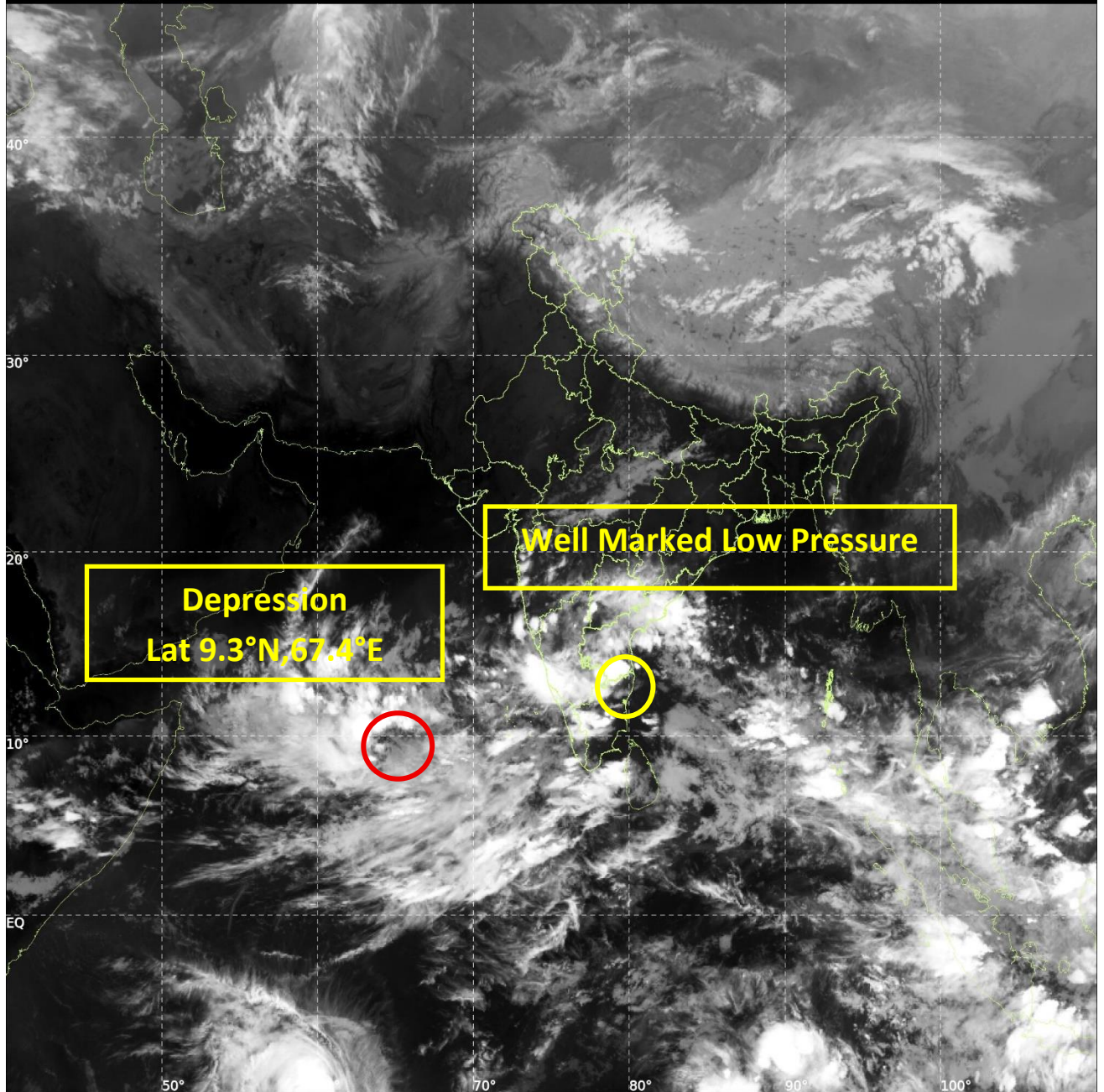

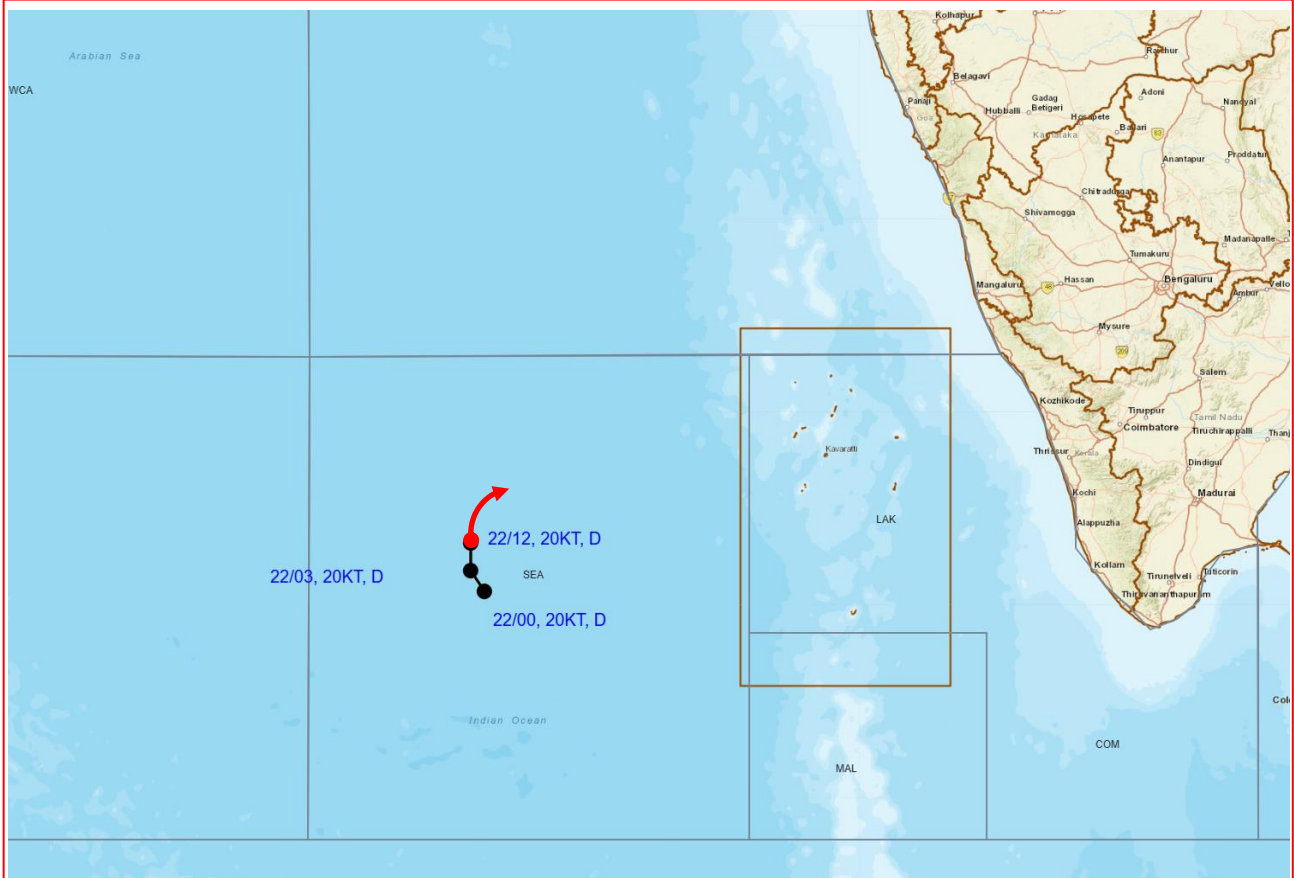

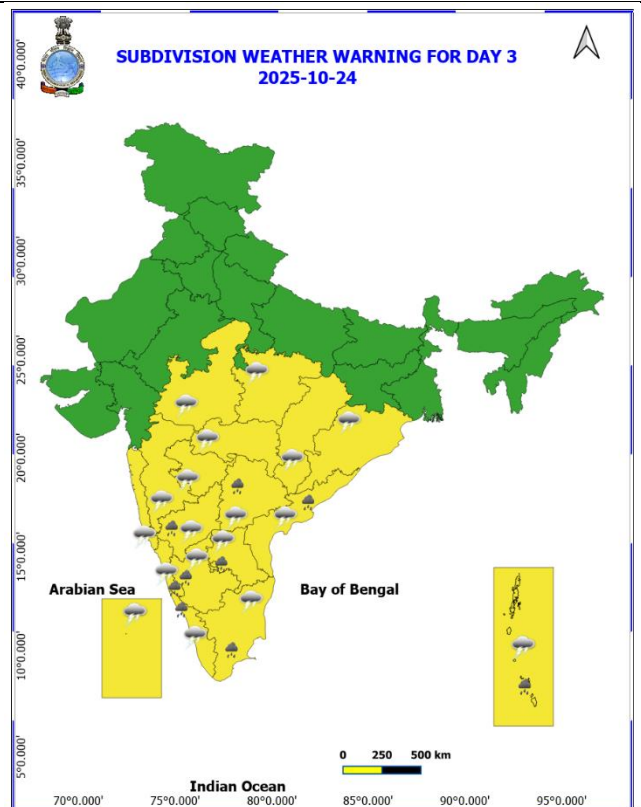
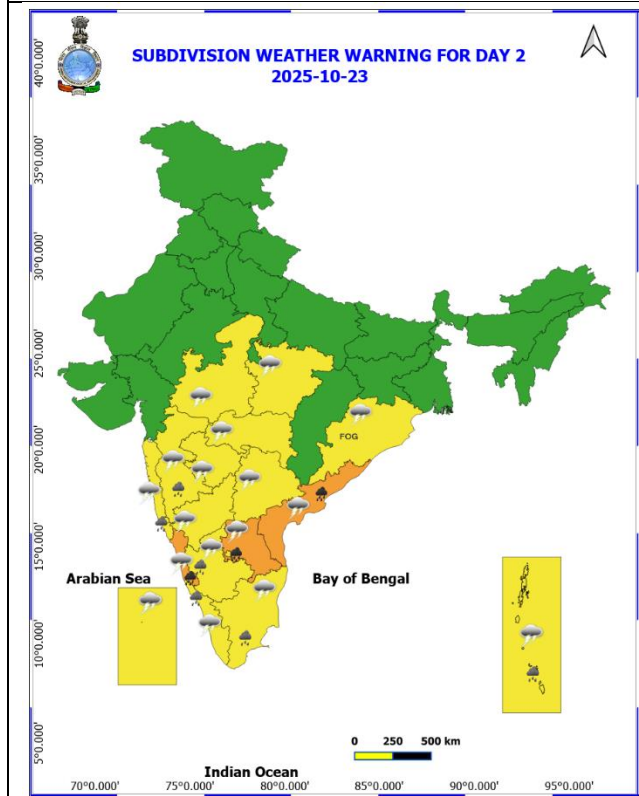

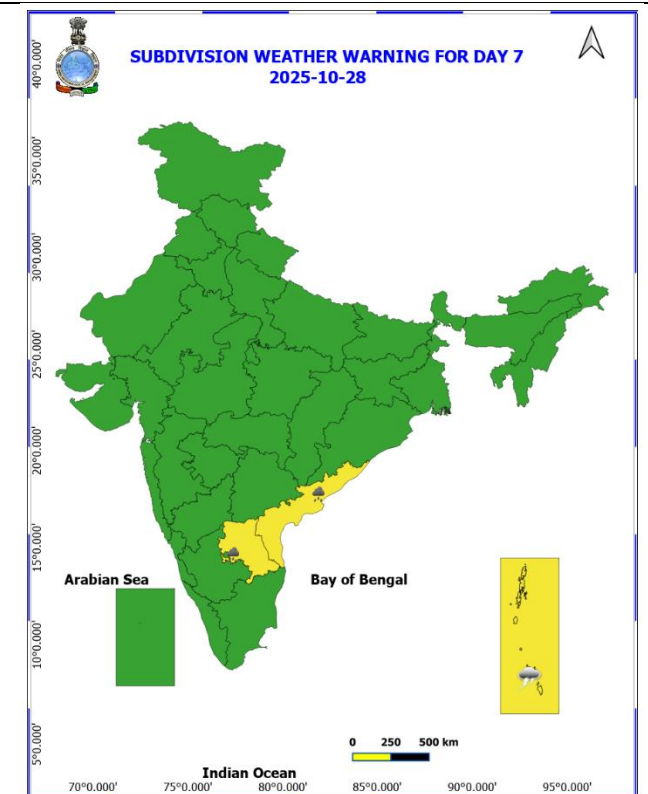

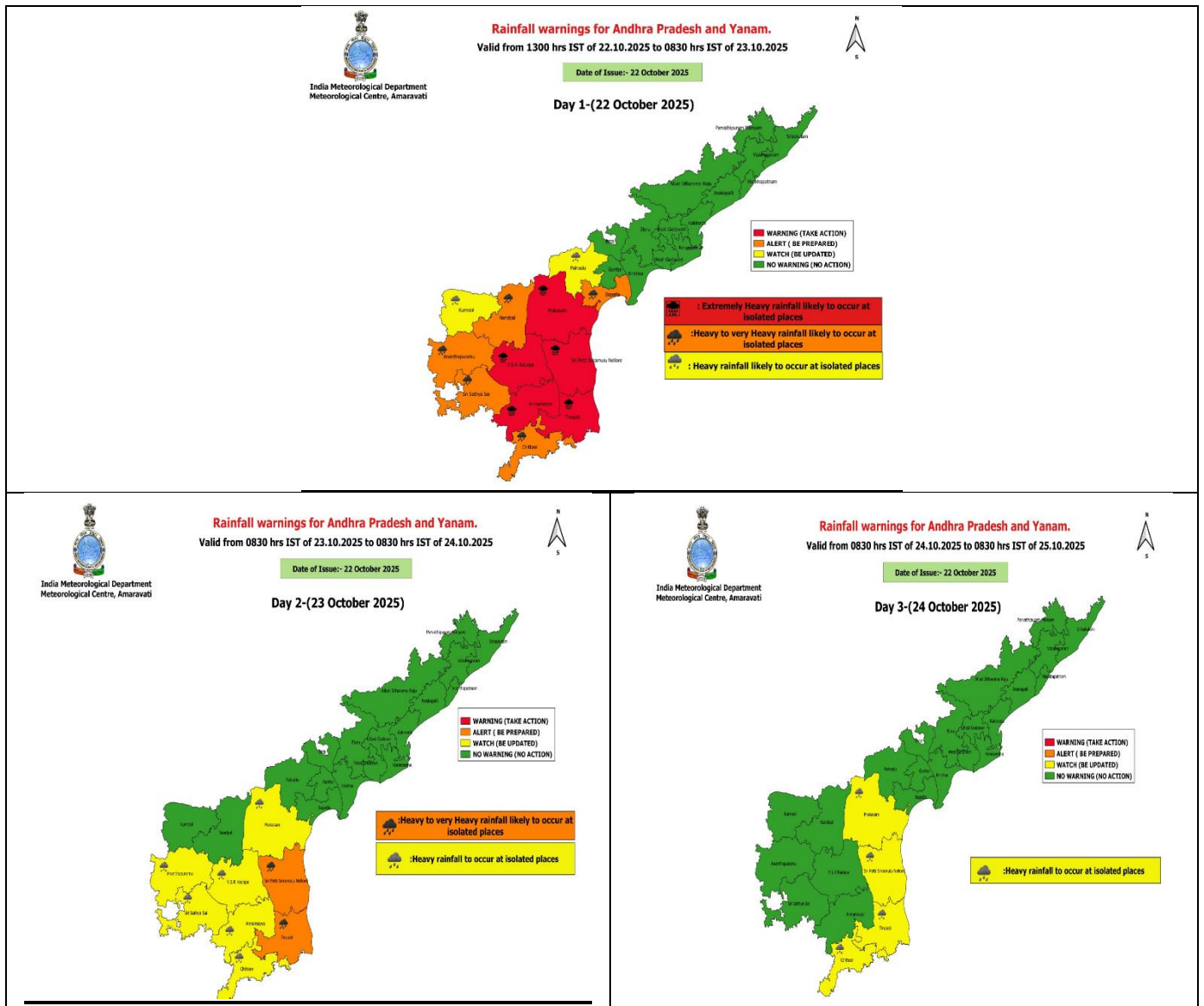




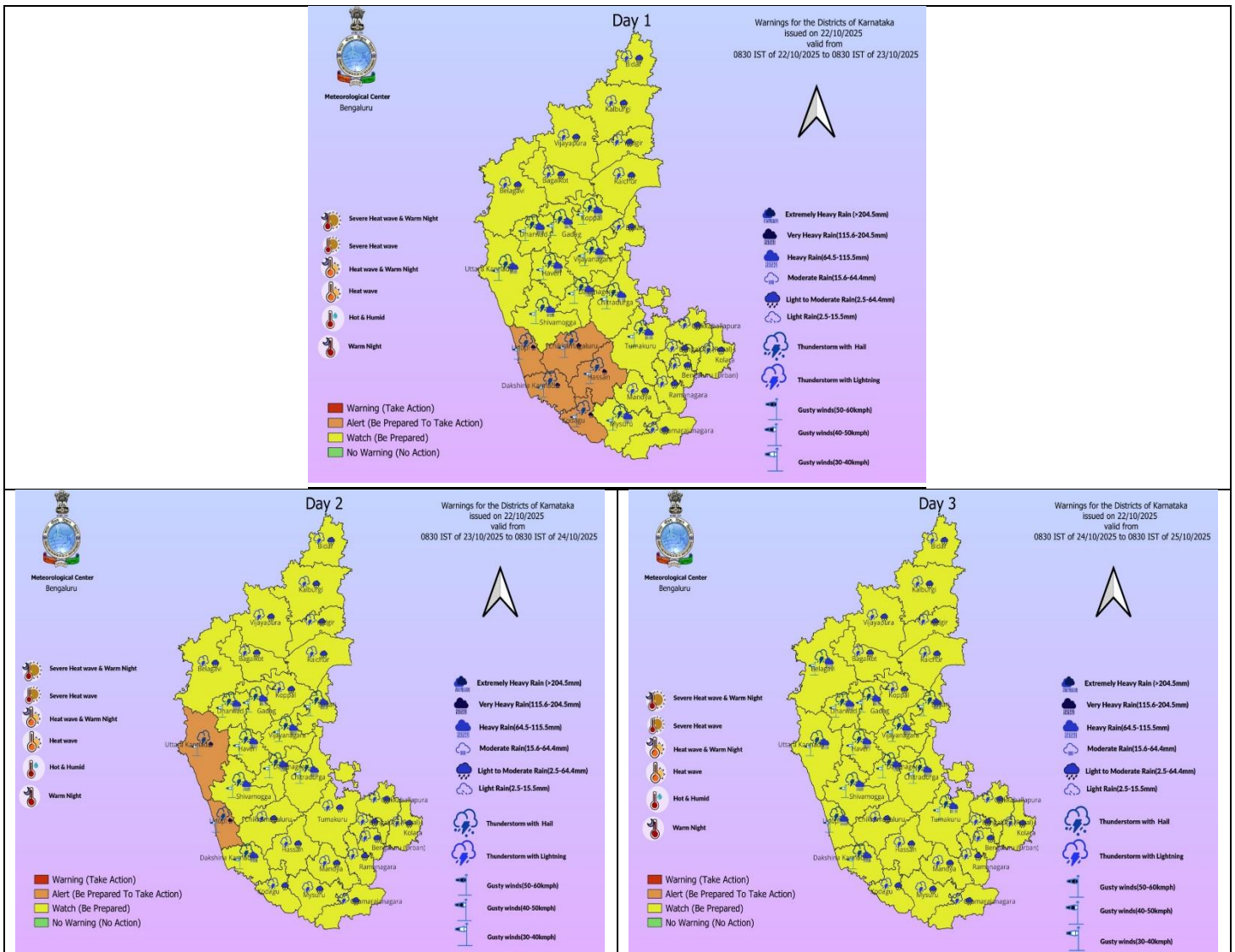
District-wise Weather Warning of Tamil Nadu, Puducherr & Karaikal



District-wise Weather Warning of Andhra Pradesh and Yanam

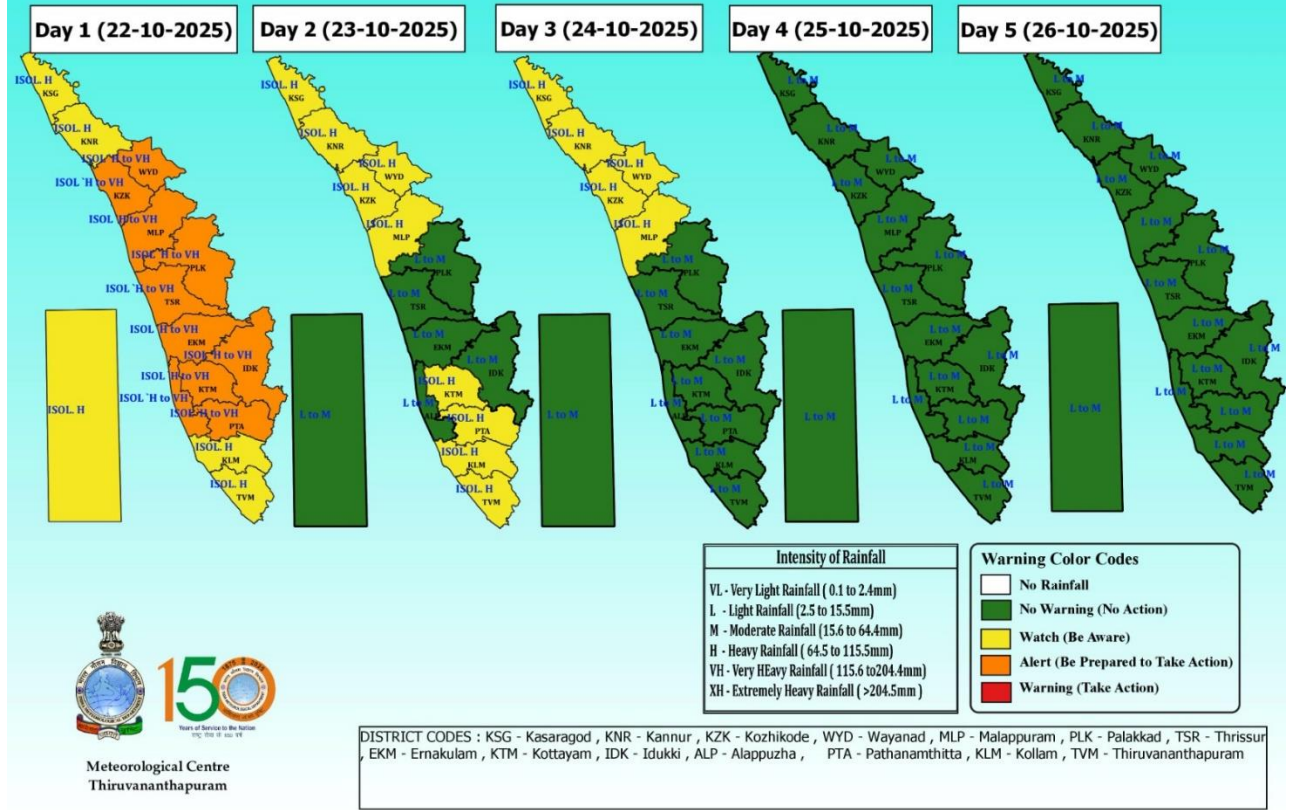


District-wise Weather Warning of Karnataka

District Rainfall Forecast Issued on 22-10-2025 at 1300 IST



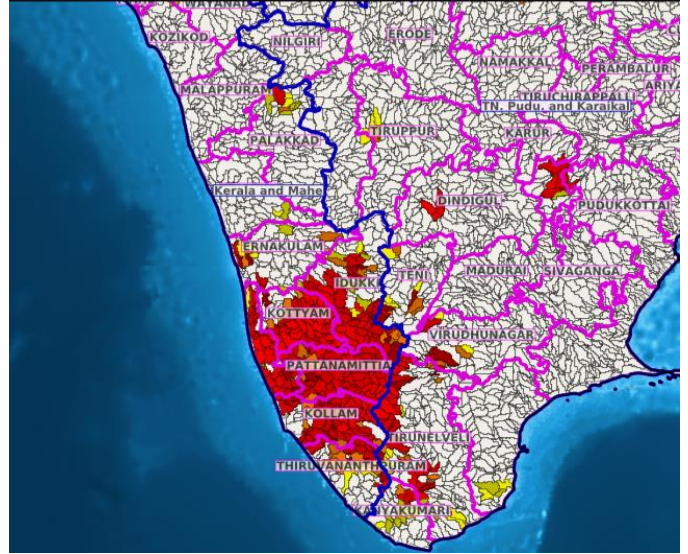
Flash Flood Guidance

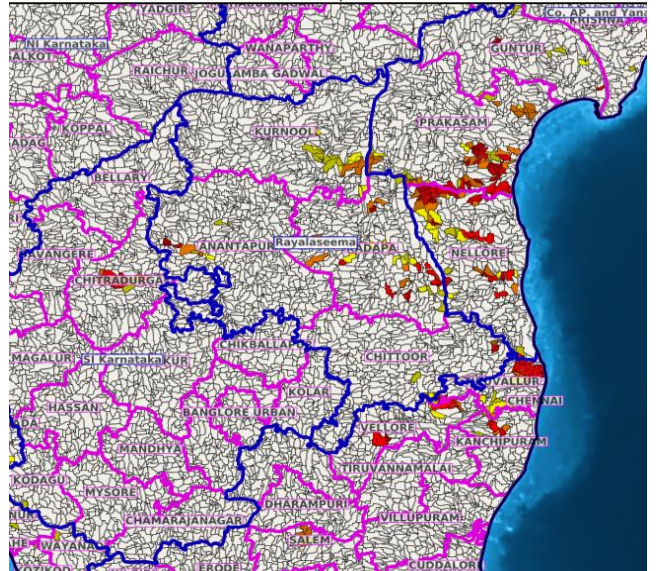

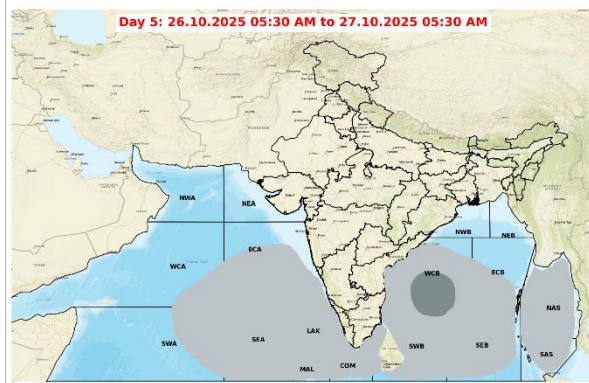
