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Subject: Deep Depression has crossed the coast and lay over northcoastal Andhra Pradesh

The Deep Depression over north Andhra Pradesh coast, moved slowly west-northwestwards with a speed of 03 kmph during past 06 hours and crossed the coast closed to southwest of Kalingapatnam during 2300 Hrs IST of 23rd and 0100 Hrs IST of today, the 24th September 2026, as a Deep Depression with maximum sustained wind speed of 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph. It then moved West-northwestwards and lay centred at 0530 hrs IST of today, 24th September 2026 over north coastal Andhra Pradesh near latitude 18.3°N and longitude 83.7°E, about 50 km West of Kalingapatnam (Andhra Pradesh), 80 km north-northeast of Visakhapatnam (Andhra Pradesh) and 170 km southwest of Gopalpur (Odisha).

It is very likely to move northwestwards initially maintaining intensity of deep depression for next 12 hrs. Thereafter it is very likely to move north-northwestwards and weaken gradually during subsequent 24 hours.

The system is under continuous surveillance by the Doppler Weather Radar at Vishakhapatnam.

Warnings:

(i) Rainfall Warning:

Odisha: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at a few places with **extremely heavy rainfall** at isolated places over south Odisha and isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall over north Odisha on 24th September. **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 25th & 26th over interior Odisha and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Odisha is likely on 27th September.

Coastal Andhra Pradesh and Yanam: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at a few places and **extremely heavy rainfall** over north Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and isolated heavy rainfall over south coastal Andhra Pradesh on 24th September and **Heavy rainfall** at isolated places over north Coastal Andhra Pradesh is likely on 25th September.

Chhattisgarh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at a few places and **extremely heavy rainfall** at isolated places over south Chhattisgarh and isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall over north Chhattisgarh on 24th September. **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 25th & 26th and isolated **heavy rainfall** on 27th September over Chhattisgarh.

Telangana: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** and **extremely heavy** falls at isolated places over northeast Telangana very likely on 24th and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over east Telangana on 25th & 26th September.

Jharkhand: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 24th and Light to moderate rainfall at most places **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places is very likely on 25th & 26th September.

Gangetic West Bengal: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 24th and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places is very likely on 25th September.

East Madhya Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **heavy rainfall** at isolated places during 24th-27th and **isolated very heavy rainfall** is very likely on 25th & 26th September.

Vidarbha: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **heavy rainfall** at isolated places during 26th to 27th September and **very heavy rainfall** at isolated places is very likely on 24th September.

(ii) Wind warning:

- ❖ Squally wind with speed reaching 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph is prevailing over Westcentral and adjoining Northwest Bay of Bengal & along and off south Odisha-north Andhra Pradesh & Yanam coasts and likely to continue till noon and become 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph in the evening of today, the 24th September. It is likely to become 45-55 kmph gusting to 65kmph from midnight of today, 24th September till morning of 25th September and decrease gradually thereafter.
- ❖ Squally wind with speed reaching 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph is prevailing over coastal districts of north Andhra Pradesh & adjoining east Telangana, south Odisha and south Chhattisgarh and likely to continue till noon and becoming 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph in the evening of today, the 24th September. It is likely to become 45-55 kmph gusting to 65kmph from midnight of today, 24th September till morning of 25th September and decrease gradually thereafter.
- ❖ Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely over the districts of northwest Odisha, north Chhattisgarh and southwest Jharkhand from 24th evening till 25th evening and decrease gradually thereafter.

- ❖ Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely over adjoining areas of North and South Bay of Bengal till evening of today, the 24rd September.
- ❖ Squally wind with speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely along & off West Bengal and south Andhra Pradesh & Yanam coasts till evening of today, the 24rd September.

(iii) Sea condition:

- ❖ Very Rough to rough sea condition is prevailing over westcentral & northwest Bay of Bengal till noon and likely to become rough from evening of today, the 24th September till morning of 25th September and improve gradually thereafter.
- ❖ Very Rough to rough sea condition is prevailing along & off north Andhra Pradesh-Odisha-West Bengal coasts till noon and likely to become rough from evening of today, the 24th September till morning of 25th September and improve gradually thereafter.
- ❖ Rough sea condition is likely over adjoining areas of southwest Bay of Bengal till 24th September evening and gradually improve thereafter.

(iv) Fishermen warnings:

Fishermen are advised not to venture into

- ❖ Westcentral & adjoining northwest & southwest Bay of Bengal and along & off Andhra Pradesh-Odisha-West Bengal coasts till morning of 25th September.

(v) Impact expected (Coastal districts of north Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and south Odisha for squally wind & heavy rainfall; interior districts of Andhra Pradesh, Odisha, Telangana, Chhattisgarh, Vidarbha and East Madhya Pradesh for heavy rainfall):

- ❖ Breaking of tree branches, uprooting of small trees like banana, papaya, drum sticks.
- ❖ Loose objects may fly.
- ❖ Strong wind and rain may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- ❖ Partial damage to vulnerable structures due to strong winds and rain.
- ❖ Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls, huts and roads due to heavy rain.
- ❖ Onshore and offshore operations may get affected.
- ❖ Small ships, trawlers and boats may be affected.
- ❖ Road and rail traffic may be affected due to heavy rain and squally winds.
- ❖ There could be localised landslides, mudslides, landslips in hilly areas and water logging, inundation and flooding over low-lying areas.
- ❖ Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- ❖ Helicopter services may get affected.

Action suggested:

- ❖ People are advised to keep a watch on the weather for worsening conditions and be ready to move to safer places accordingly. People may stay in safe places especially during 23rd to 24th September.
- ❖ Fishing operation may be suspended till 24th September.
- ❖ Surface transport may be regulated.
- ❖ Tourism and recreational activities to be regulated.
- ❖ Onshore and offshore activities to be judiciously regulated.
- ❖ Helicopter services to be regulated.
- ❖ Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees, as there could be lightning.
- ❖ In case of expected lightning, unplug electrical/ electronic appliances, immediately, get out of water bodies and keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.

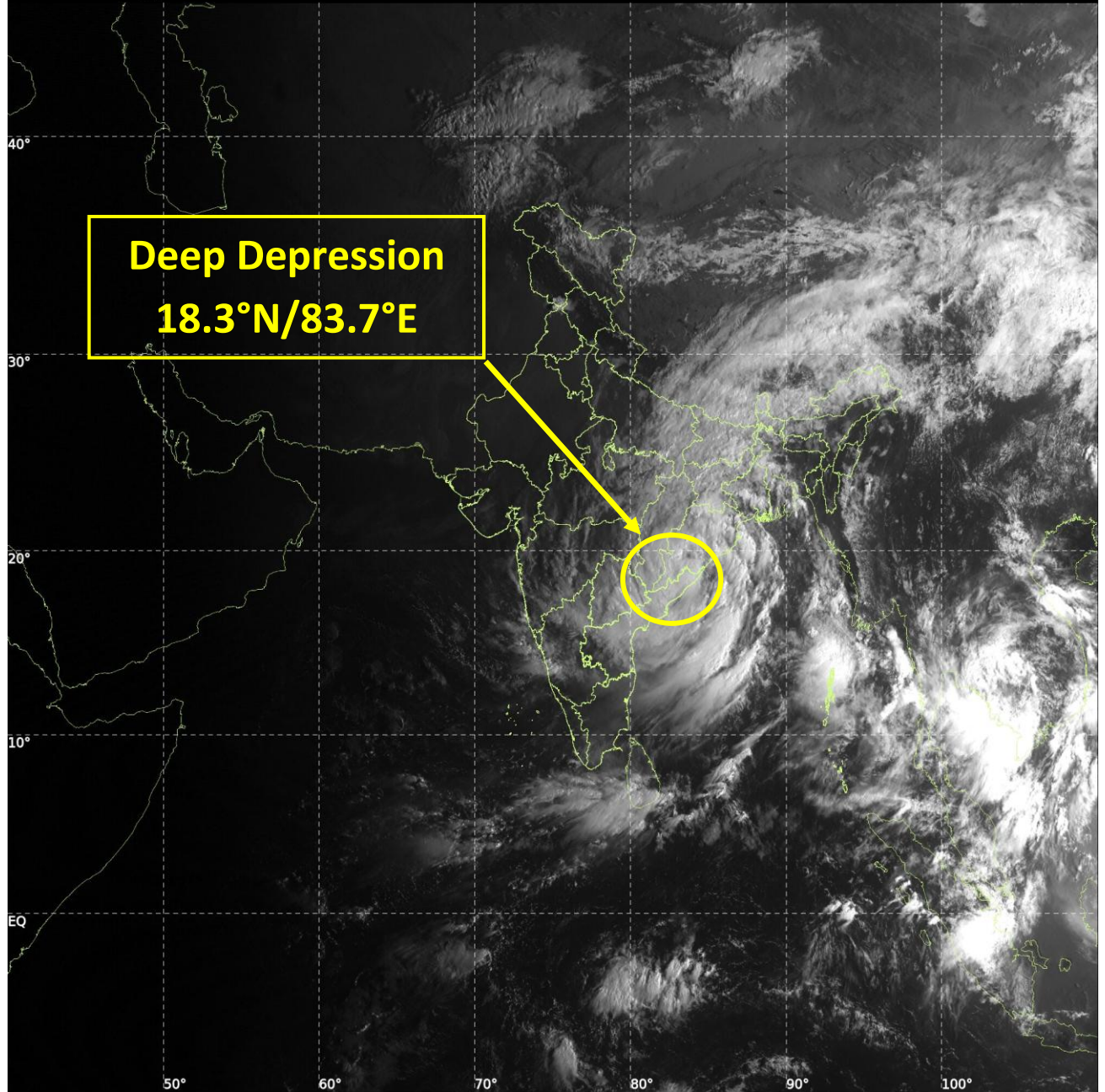
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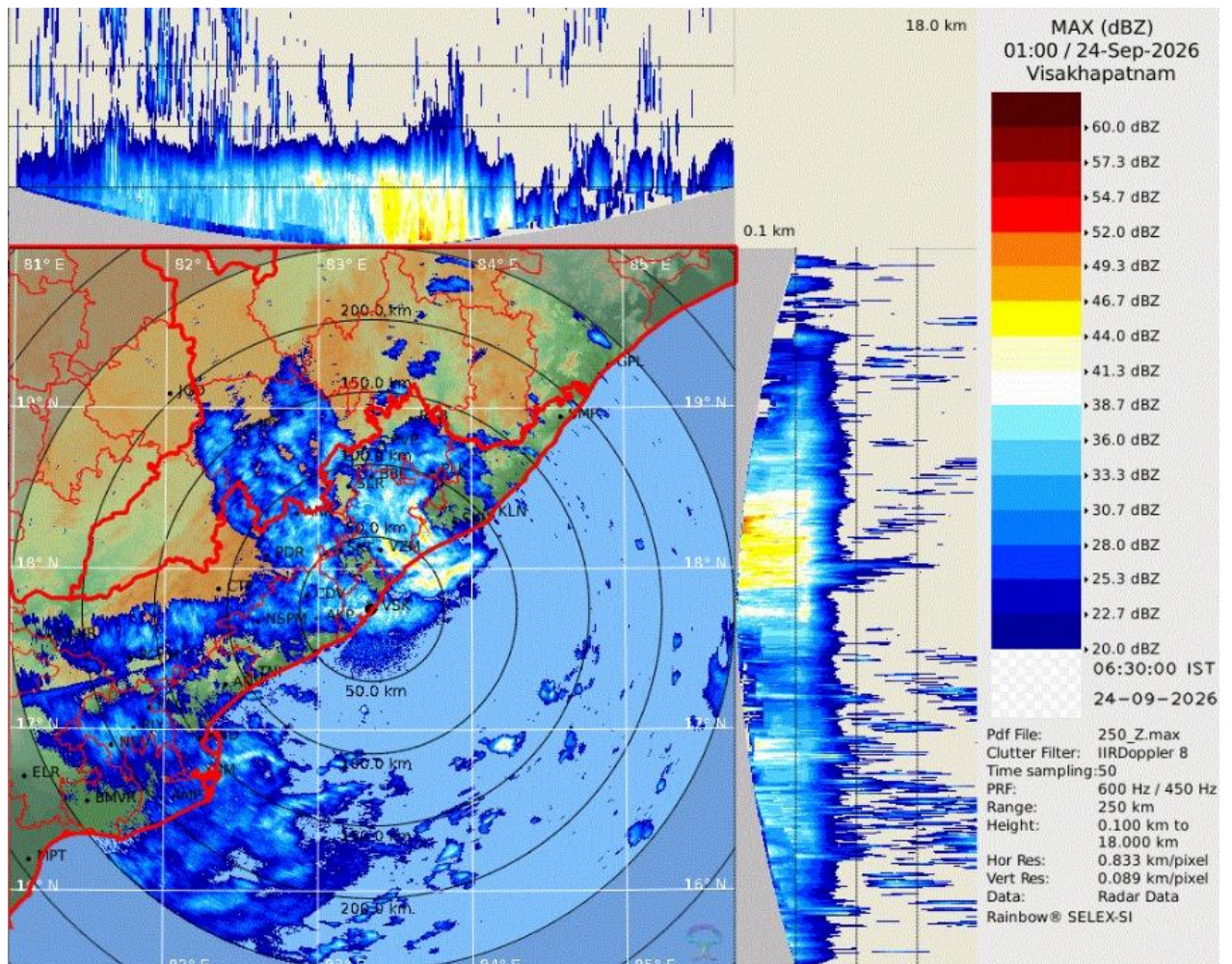

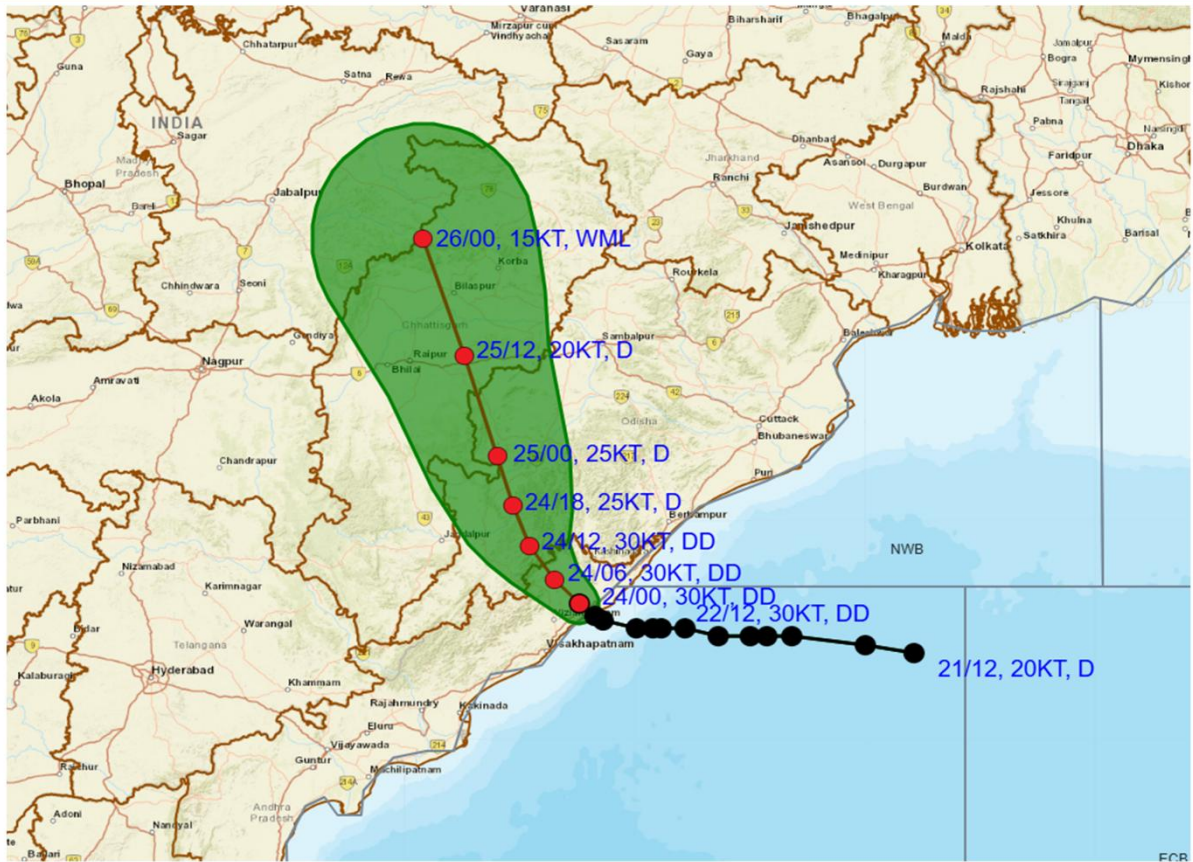

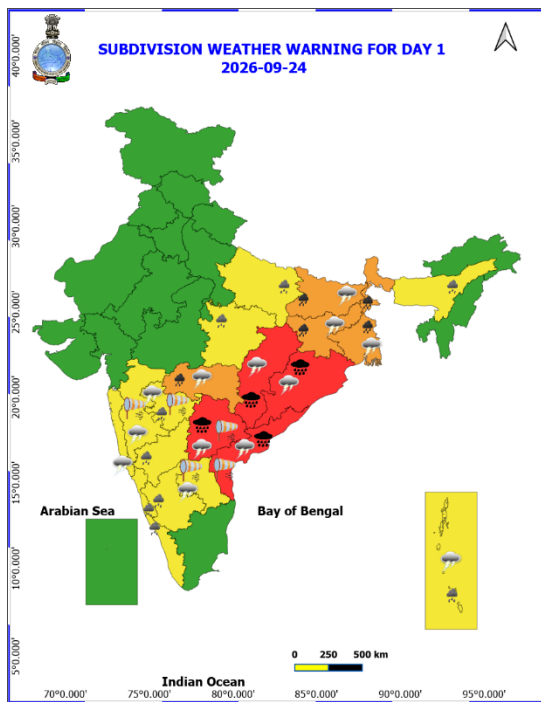

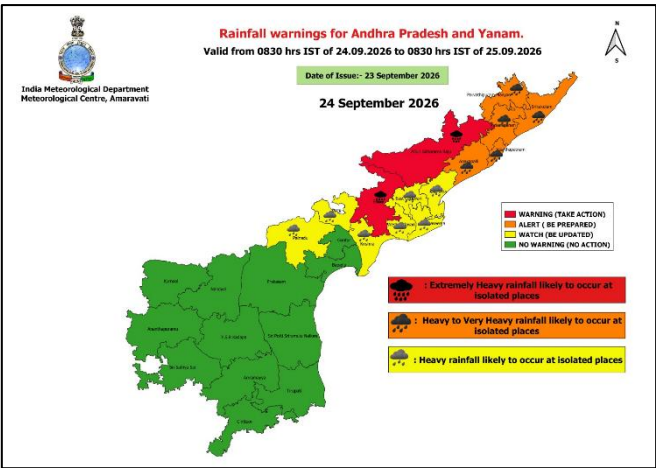




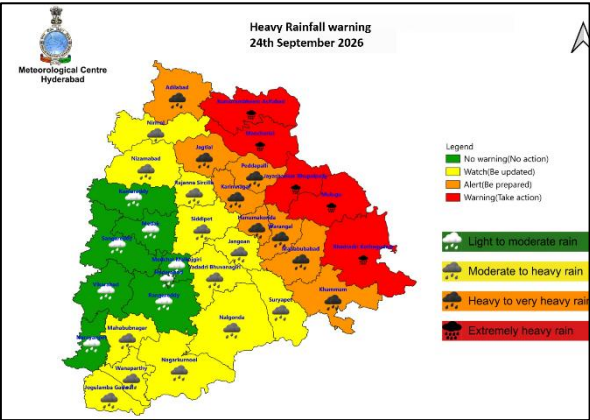
District-wise Rainfall Warning for the State of Odisha

District-wise Rainfall Warning for the State of Telangana



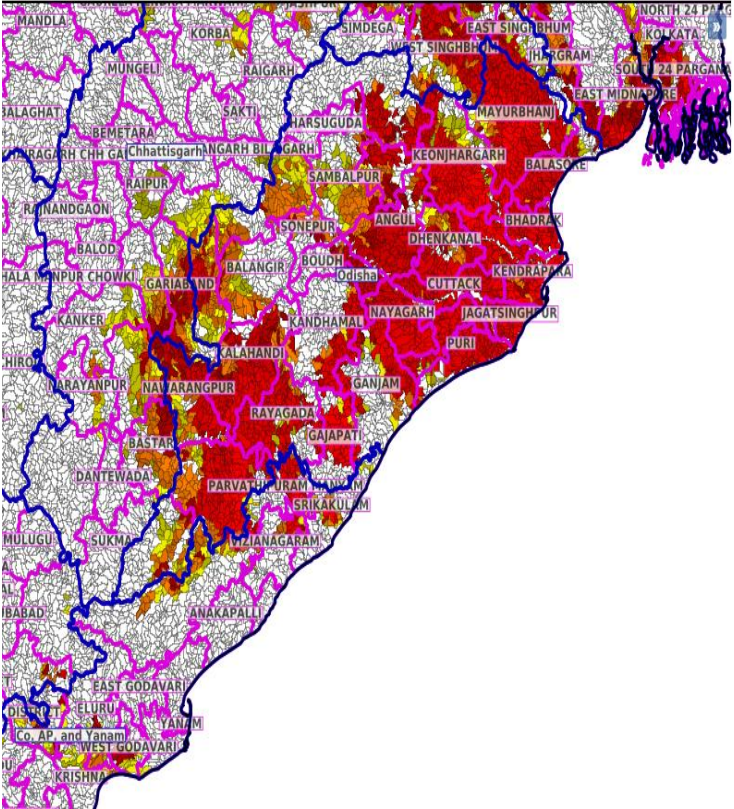
