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Subject: Depression over southwest Madhya Pradesh and adjoining East Rajasthan & Gujarat Region weakened into a Well Marked Low Pressure Area over Southeast Rajasthan & neighbourhood

The Depression over southwest Madhya Pradesh and adjoining East Rajasthan & Gujarat Region moved nearly west-northwestwards and weakened into a Well Marked Low Pressure Area over **Southeast Rajasthan & Neighbourhood** at 0530 hrs IST of today, the 01st August, 2026.

It is very likely to move west-northwestwards across South Rajasthan and weaken further into a Low Pressure Area during next 24 hours.

Warnings:

(i) Rainfall Warning:

Gujarat Region: Light to moderate rainfall at most places is very likely with heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places and **extremely heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 1st August and heavy rainfall at isolated places on 2nd August.

Saurashtra & Kutch: Light to moderate rainfall at most places is likely with heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places and **extremely heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 1st August and heavy rainfall at isolated places on 2nd August.

Madhya Maharashtra: Light to moderate rainfall at most places is very likely with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places on 01st and heavy rainfall at isolated places on 02nd & 3rd August.

Konkan & Goa: Light to moderate rainfall at most places is very likely with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 1st August and heavy rainfall at isolated places on 2nd & 3rd August.

East Rajasthan: Light to moderate rainfall at most places is very likely with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 01st and heavy rainfall at isolated places on 2nd August.

West Rajasthan: Light to moderate rainfall at most places is very likely with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 1st & 2nd August.

(ii) Wind Warning:

- ❖ Squally winds with speed reaching 25-35 kmph gusting to 45 kmph is very likely to prevail over southwest Madhya Pradesh and adjoining Madhya Maharashtra during next 12 hours.

(v) Impact Expected and Action Suggested due to heavy rainfall and squally winds

Impact expected:

- ❖ Breaking of tree branches, uprooting of small trees like banana, papaya, drum sticks. Strong wind and rain may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- ❖ Partial damage to vulnerable structures due to strong winds and rain.
- ❖ Minor damage to kutchha houses/walls, huts and roads due to heavy rain.
- ❖ Road and rail traffic may be affected due to heavy rain and squally winds.
- ❖ There could be localised landslides, mudslides, landslips, water logging, inundation and flooding over low lying areas.
- ❖ Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- ❖ Helicopter services may get affected.

Action suggested:

- ❖ People are advised to keep a watch on the weather for worsening conditions and be ready to move to safer places accordingly.
- ❖ Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees, as there could be lightning.
- ❖ In case of expected lightning, unplug electrical/ electronic appliances, immediately, get out of water bodies and keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.
- ❖ Tourism and recreational activities to be regulated.
- ❖ Helicopter services to be regulated.

This the last Bulletin in association with this system however regular Bulletins will continue from the National Weather Forecasting Centre and concerned Meteorological and Regional Centres for Well Marked Low Pressure Area and its remnant.

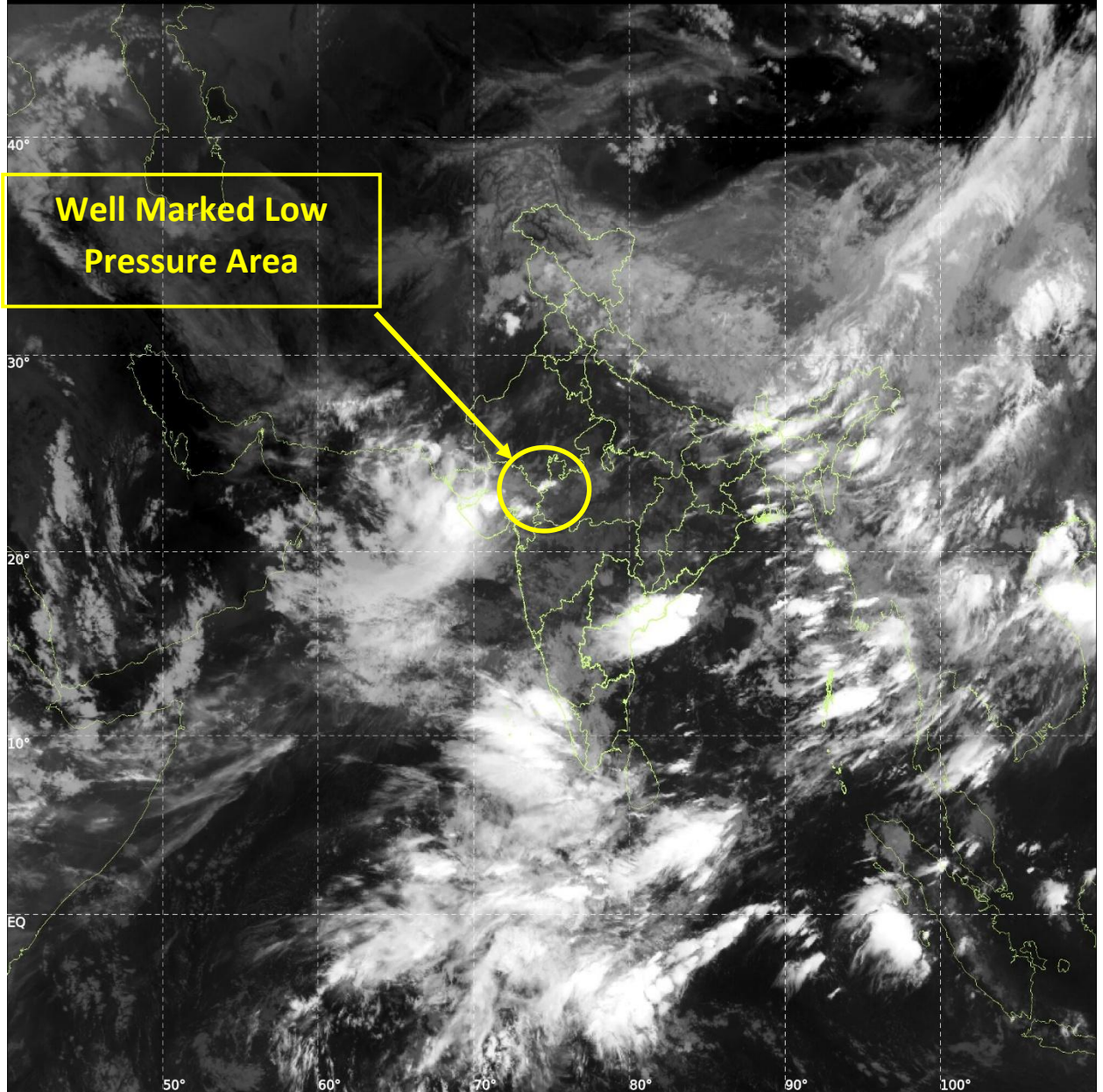

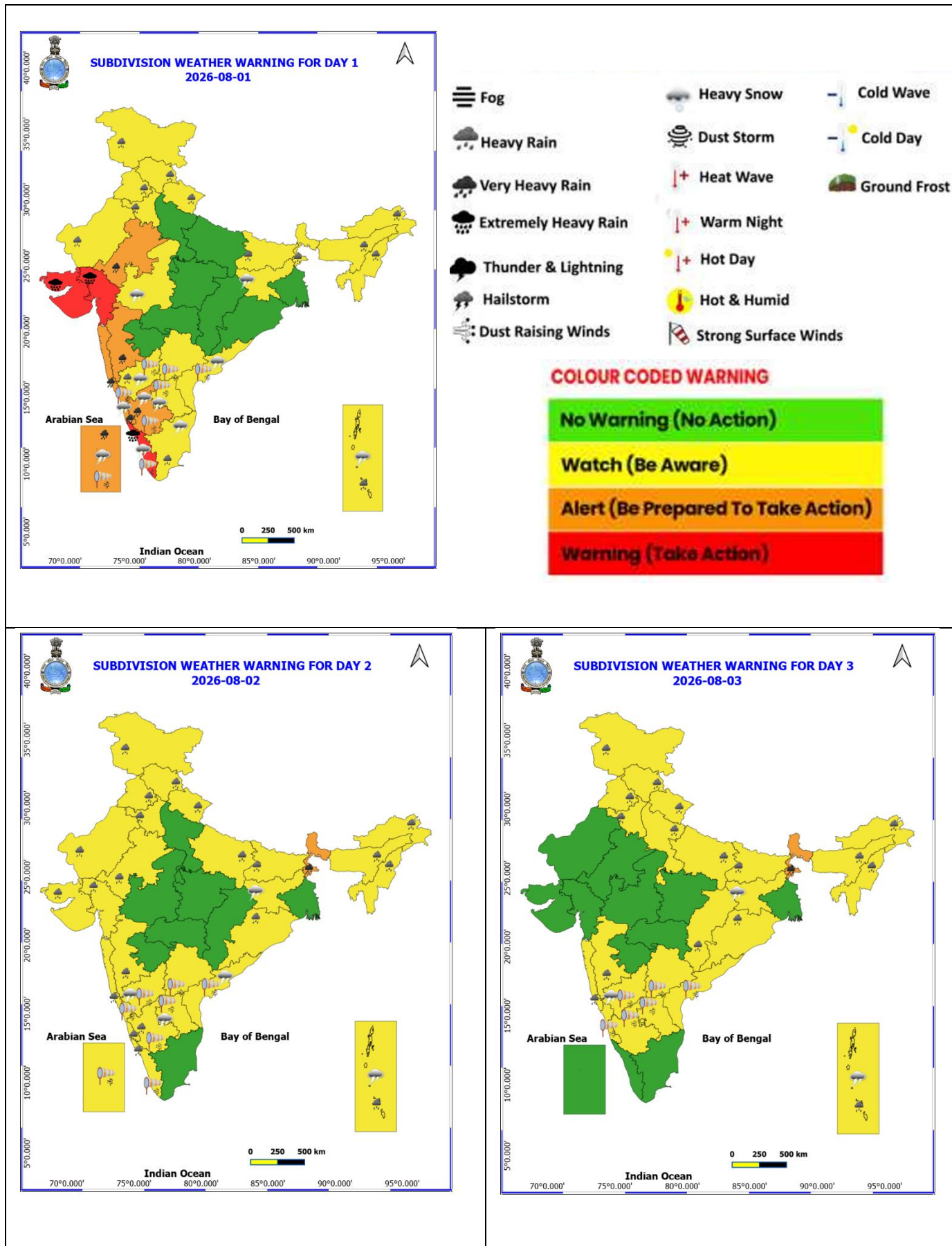

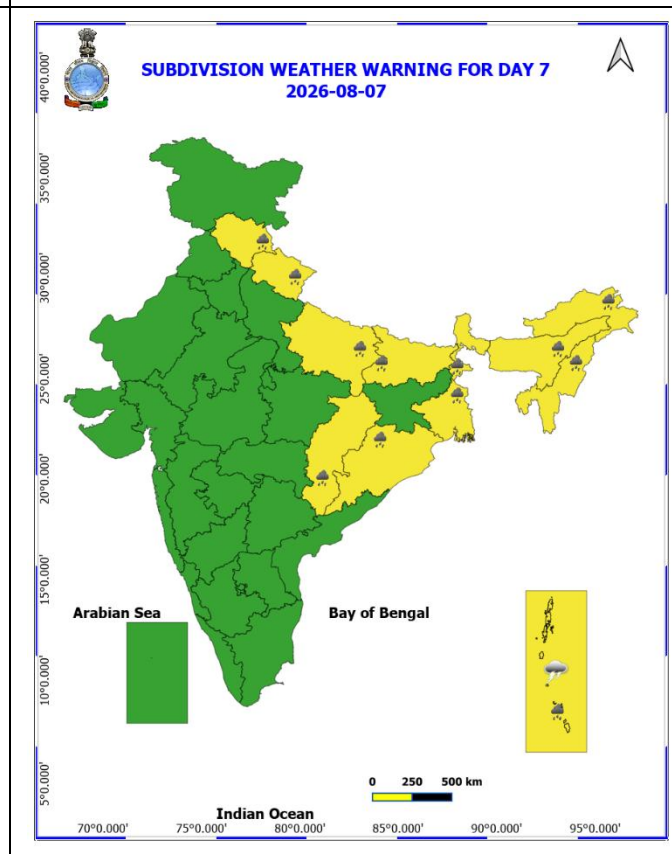

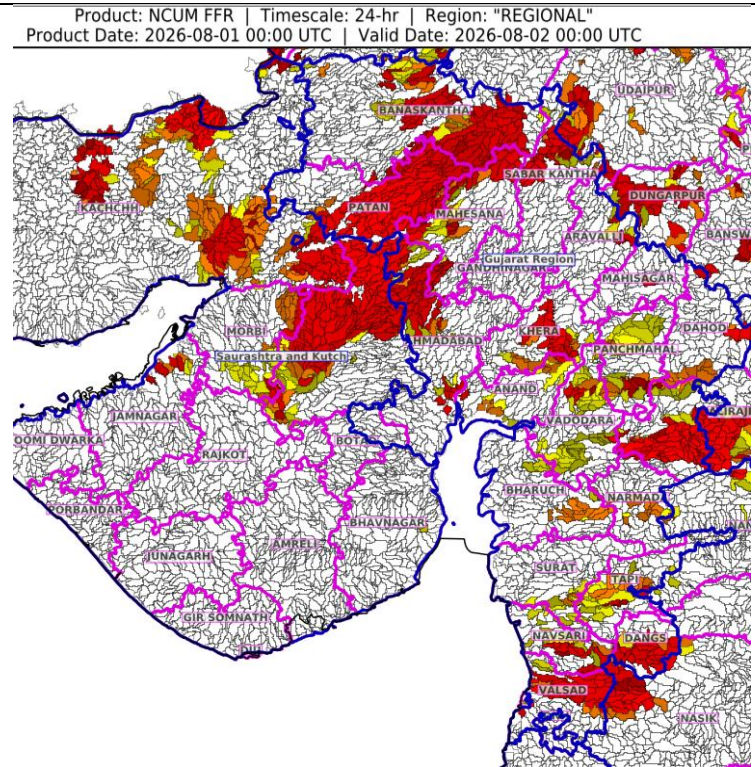
