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Subject: Depression over Westcentral & adjoining Northwest Bay of Bengal

The Depression over Westcentral & adjoining Northwest Bay of Bengal, moved nearly westwards and lay centred at 2330 hrs IST of 21st September, 2026, over the same region near latitude 17.8°N and longitude 87.2°E, about 250 km east-southeast of Gopalpur (Odisha), 270 km southeast of Puri (Odisha), 330 km east-southeast of Kalingapatnam (Andhra Pradesh) and 410 km east of Visakhapatnam (Andhra Pradesh).

It is very likely to move west-northwestwards & intensify into a deep depression over Westcentral & adjoining Northwest Bay of Bengal during next 24 hours. Continuing to move west-northwestwards it is very likely to cross north Andhra Pradesh - South Odisha coasts between Visakhapatnam & Gopalpur as a Deep Depression during night of 23rd to early hours of 24th September 2026.

Warnings:

(i) Rainfall Warning:

Odisha: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** very likely at isolated places on 22nd September. Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at a few places and **extremely heavy rainfall** at isolated places over south Odisha on 23rd & 24th September. **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 25th and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Odisha is likely on 26th September.

Coastal Andhra Pradesh and Yanam: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** very likely at isolated places over Andhra Pradesh & Yanam on 22nd; **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at a few places over Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and **extremely heavy rainfall** over north Andhra Pradesh & Yanam on 23rd & 24th and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam is very likely on 25th September.

Chhattisgarh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 22nd; **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 23rd; **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at a few places with **extremely heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 24th and **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places is very likely on 25th & 26th September.

Telangana: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 22nd and at a few places on 23rd & 24th September and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places is very likely on 25th September.

Jharkhand: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **heavy rainfall** at isolated places during 22nd to 26th and **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places is very likely on 24th September.

Gangetic West Bengal: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **heavy rainfall** at isolated places during 22nd to 25th and **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places is very likely on 24th September.

East Madhya Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 23rd & 24th and **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places is very likely on 25th & 26th September.

Vidarbha: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **heavy rainfall** at isolated places during 23rd to 26th September.

(ii) Wind warning:

- ❖ Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is prevailing over Central Bay of Bengal and adjoining Northwest Bay of Bengal.
- ❖ It is very likely to increase reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph over West Central Bay of Bengal & adjoining Northwest Bay of Bengal from 22nd September morning.
- ❖ Increasing further is likely to become 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph over Westcentral and adjoining Northwest Bay of Bengal from 23rd September to 24th September evening.
- ❖ Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph adjoining areas of North and South Bay of Bengal on 22nd September and becoming 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph on 23rd September.
- ❖ Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph which likely to commence from 22nd morning along and off south Odisha-north Andhra Pradesh & Yanam coasts. It is likely to increase gradually becoming squally wind with speed reaching 55-65 kmph gusting to 65 kmph along and off south Odisha-north Andhra Pradesh & Yanam coasts from early morning of 23rd till evening of 24th September. It is likely to decrease gradually thereafter.
- ❖ Squally wind with speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely along & off West Bengal and south Andhra Pradesh & Yanam coasts from 23rd to 24th September.

(iii) Sea condition:

- ❖ Rough to very rough sea condition likely over Eastcentral Bay of Bengal till 22nd, over westcentral Bay of Bengal during 22nd to 24th September.
- ❖ Rough to very rough sea condition is likely over Northwest Bay of Bengal from 22nd to 24th September.
- ❖ Rough to very rough sea condition is likely over adjoining areas of southwest Bay of Bengal on 23rd and 24th September.
- ❖ Rough to very rough sea condition is likely along & off north Andhra Pradesh-Odisha-West Bengal coasts till evening 24th September.

(iv) Fishermen warnings:

Fishermen are advised not to venture into

- ❖ Eastcentral and adjoining northeast Bay of Bengal till 22nd September.
- ❖ Westcentral & adjoining northwest & southwest Bay of Bengal and along & off Andhra Pradesh-Odisha-West Bengal coasts till 24th September.

(v) Impact Expected and Action Suggested over Northeastern states, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal and Sikkim due to heavy rainfall and squally winds

Impact expected (Coastal districts of north Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and south Odisha for squally wind & heavy rainfall; interior districts of Andhra Pradesh, Odisha, Telangana, Chhattisgarh for heavy rainfall):

- ❖ Breaking of tree branches, uprooting of small trees like banana, papaya, drum sticks.
- ❖ Strong wind and rain may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- ❖ Partial damage to vulnerable structures due to strong winds and rain.
- ❖ Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls, huts and roads due to heavy rain.
- ❖ Loose objects may fly.
- ❖ Onshore and offshore operations may get affected.
- ❖ Small ships, trawlers and boats may be affected.
- ❖ Road and rail traffic may be affected due to heavy rain and squally winds.
- ❖ There could be localised landslides, mudslides, landslips in hilly areas and water logging, inundation and flooding over low lying areas.
- ❖ Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- ❖ Helicopter services may get affected.

Action suggested:

- ❖ People are advised to keep a watch on the weather for worsening conditions and be ready to move to safer places accordingly. People may stay in safe places especially on 23rd & 24th September.
- ❖ Surface transport may be regulated.
- ❖ Fishing operation may be suspended till 24th September.
- ❖ Tourism and recreational activities to be regulated.
- ❖ Onshore and offshore activities to be judiciously regulated.
- ❖ Helicopter services to be regulated.
- ❖ Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees, as there could be lightning.
- ❖ In case of expected lightning, unplug electrical/ electronic appliances, immediately, get out of water bodies and keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.

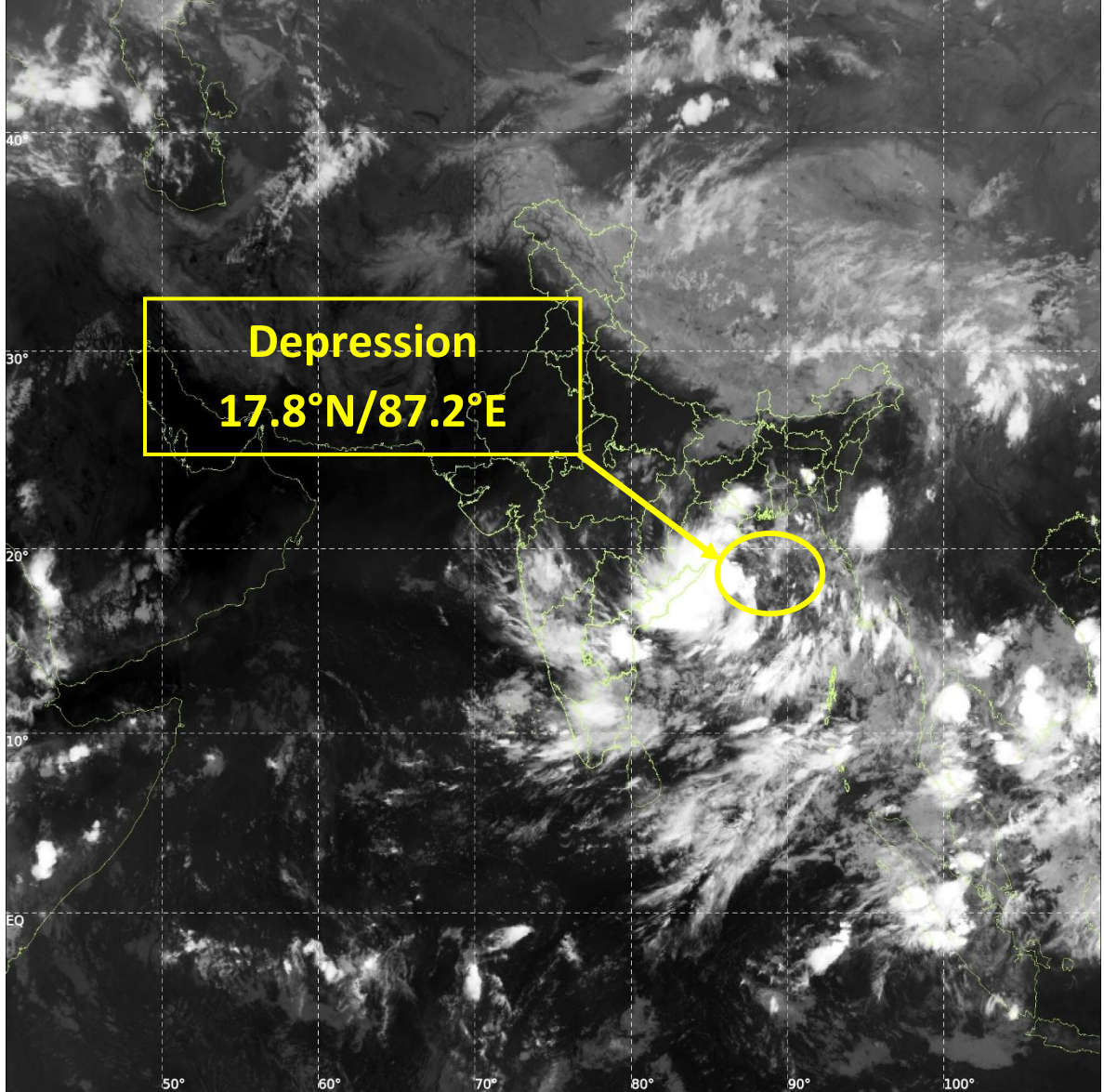

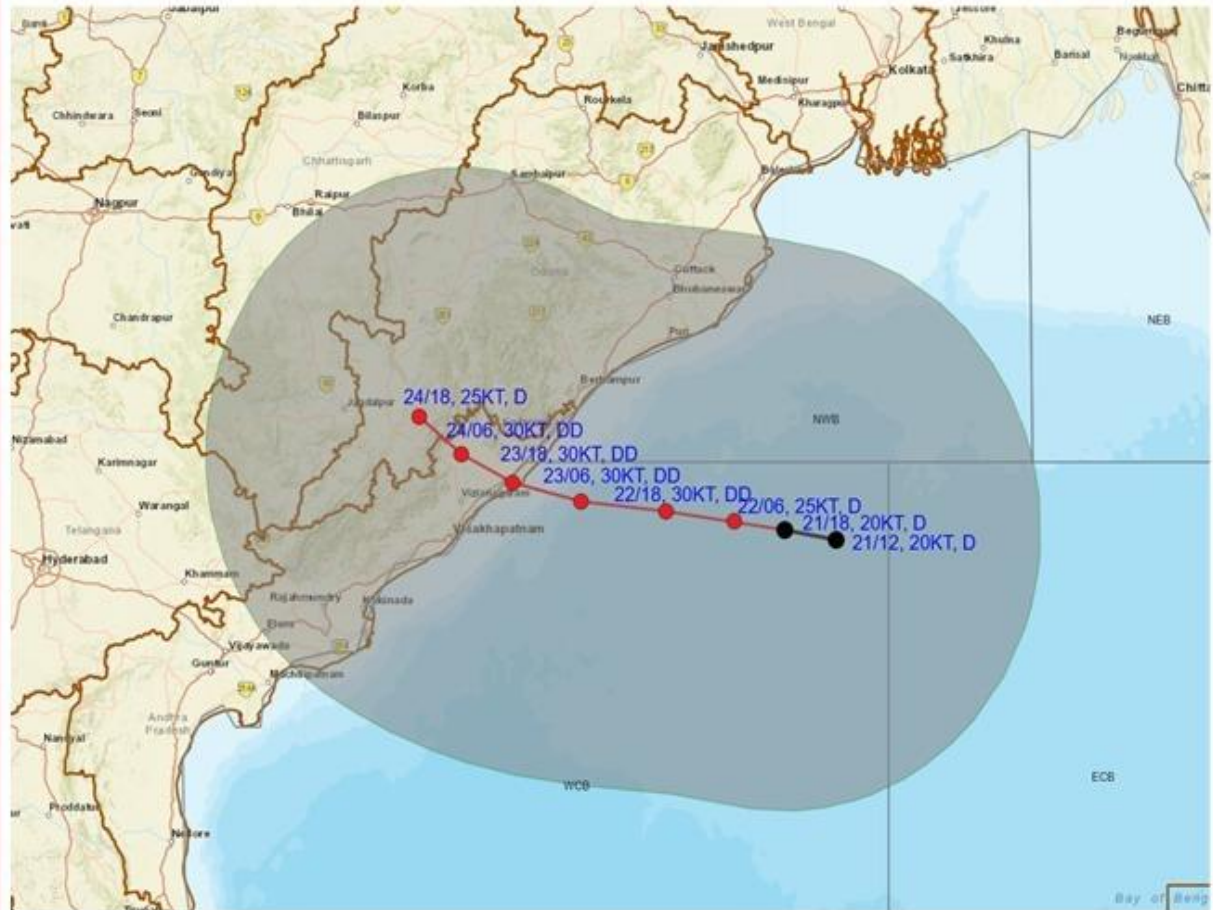

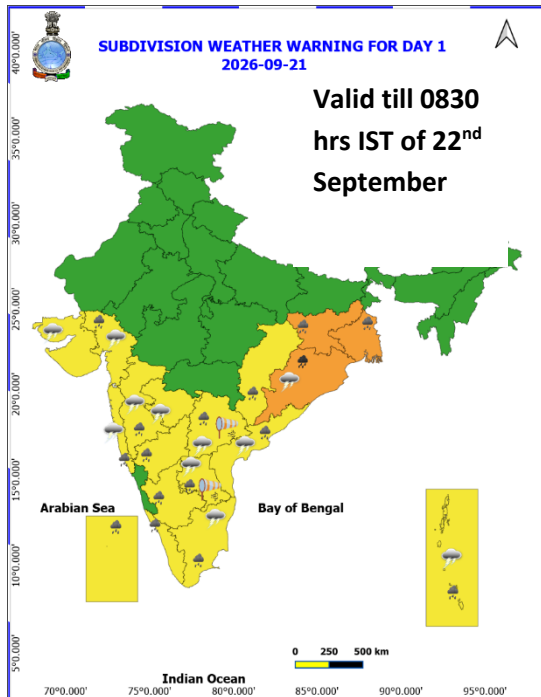

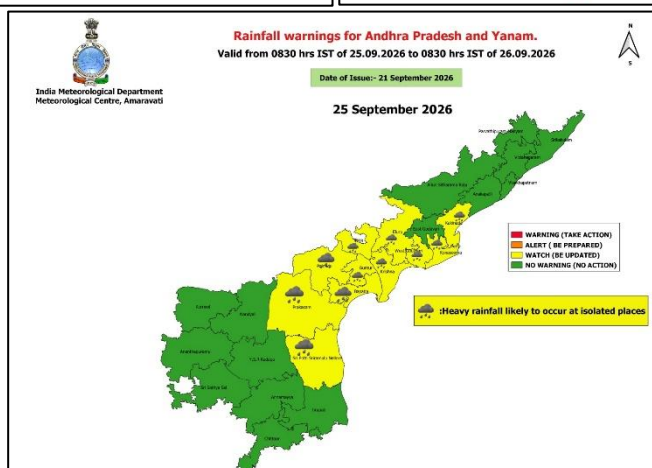
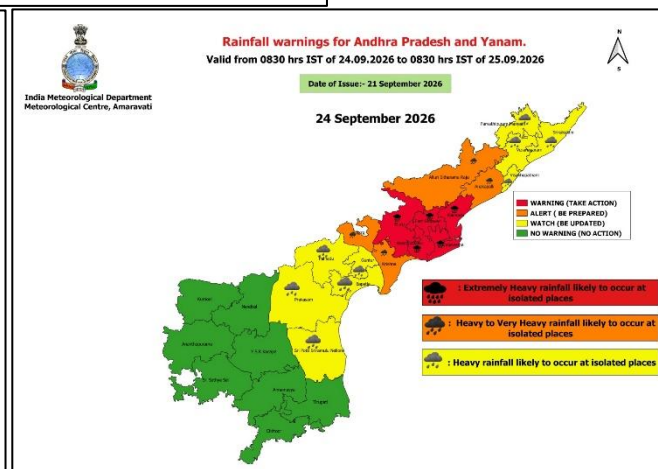
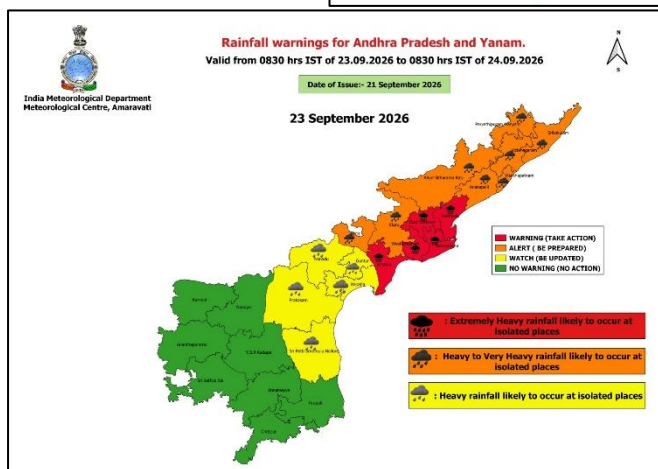
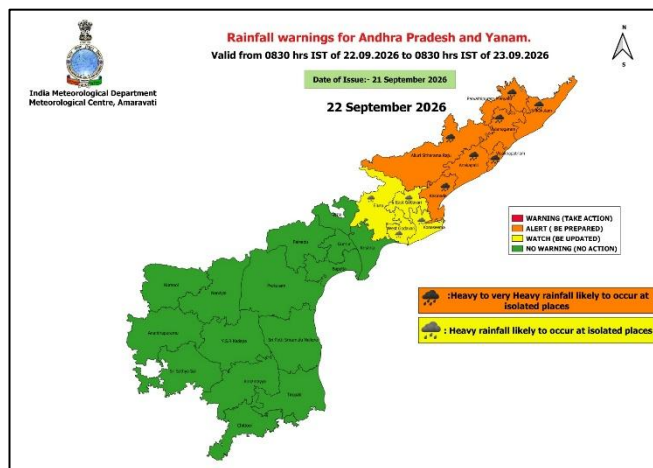




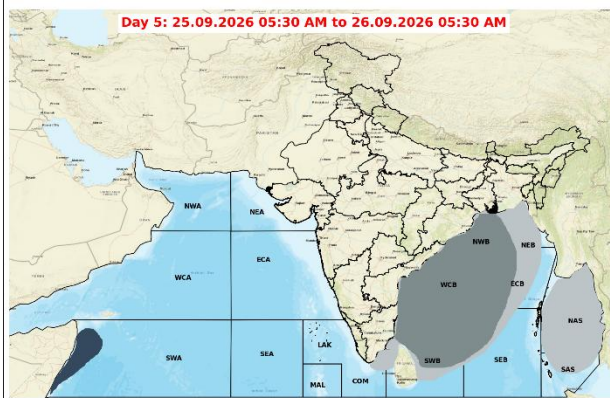
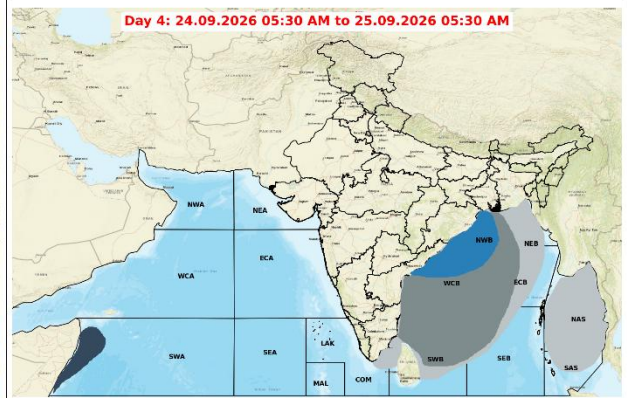
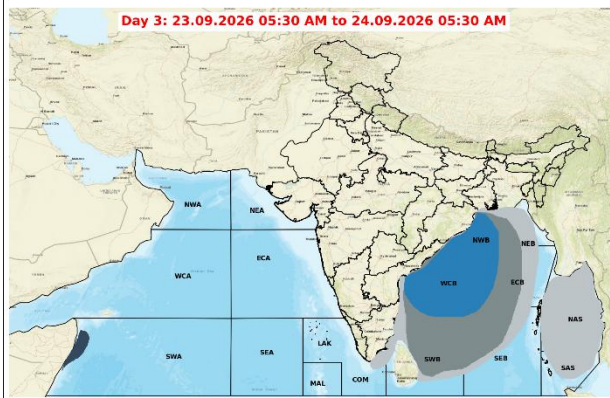
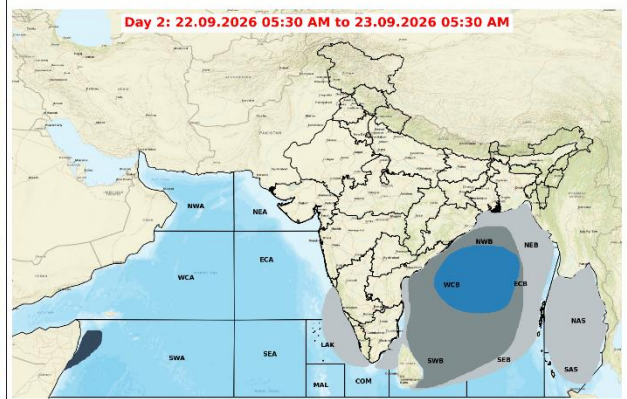
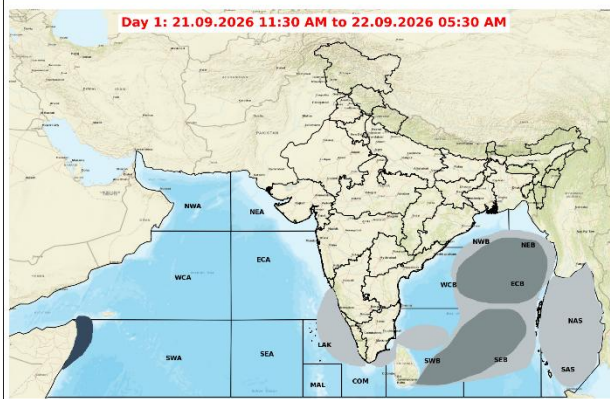
District-wise Rainfall Warning for the State of Odisha
