Sub: Cyclonic Storm "Midhili" (pronounced as "Midhili") weakened into a Deep Depression over Tripura & adjoining Bangladesh

The Cyclonic Storm **"Midhili"** (pronounced as "Midhili") over Coastal Bangladesh moved north-northeastwards with a speed of 13 kmph during past 6 hours, weakened into a Deep Depression and lay centered at 2330 hours IST of 17th November over Tripura & adjoining Bangladesh near latitude 23.3°N and longitude 91.3°E, about 100 km northeast of Bhola (Bangladesh), 50 km north-northeast of Maijdicourt (Bangladesh), 60 km south-southeast of Agartala and 220 km southwest of Silchar.

It is likely to move north-northeastwards and weaken into a Depression over south Assam & adjoining Mizoram-Tripura during next 06 hours.

Forecast track and intensity are given below:

Warnings:

(i) Rainfall Warning (graphics enclosed):

- Light to moderate rainfall at most places with isolated heavy rainfall is likely over Nagaland, Manipur and east Assam on 18th November.
- Light to moderate rainfall at many places with isolated heavy falls is likely Mizoram & Tripura till 18th November morning.

(ii) Wind warning (graphics enclosed):

- Northeast adjoining Northwest Bay of Bengal and along & off Bangladesh coast: Squally wind speed reaching 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph is prevailing and would decrease gradually becoming 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph by morning of 18th November and would decrease thereafter.
- Strong wind speed reaching 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is likely over Tripura, Mizoram, Manipur and south Assam till 18th November evening.

(iii) Sea Condition:

• Very rough sea condition is prevailing over Northeast adjoining Northwest Bay of Bengal and along & off Bangladesh coast and is likely to become **rough** by morning of 18th November and improve thereafter.

(iv) Fishermen Warning:

Fishermen are advised not to venture into

 Northeast adjoining Northwest Bay of Bengal and along & off Bangladesh during next 12 hours.


(v) Damage Expected & Action Suggested for Nagaland and east Assam during next 12 hours:

- Damage to thatched huts and loose/unsecured structures..
- Minor damage to power and communication lines due to breaking of branches.
- Minor damage to Kutcha Roads.
- Some damage to paddy crops, banana, papaya & drumstick trees and orchards.
- Inundation in low lying areas.

The system is under continuous surveillance and the next message will be issued at 0830 hours IST of today the 18th November, 2023.




