DEMS-RSMC TROPICAL CYCLONES NEW DELHI DATED 21.07.2021

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL AND ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR NEXT 120 HOURS ISSUED AT 0600 UTC OF 21.07.2021 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 21.07.2021.

BAY OF BENGAL:

A LOW PRESSURE AREA IS VERY LIKELY TO FORM OVER NORTHWEST BAY OF BENGAL AND NEIGHBOURHOOD DURING NEXT 48 HOURS.

SCATTERED LOW AND MEDIUM CLOUDS WITH EMBEDDED INTENSE TO VERY INTENSE CONVECTION LAY OVER CENTRAL BAY OF BENGAL, ANDAMAN SEA AND GULF OF MARTABAN. SCATTERED LOW AND MEDIUM CLOUDS WITH ISOLATED MODERATE TO INTENSE CONVECTION LAY OVER THE REST OF BAY OF BENGAL AND ARAKAN COAST.

ARABIAN SEA:

SCATTERED LOW AND MEDIUM CLOUDS WITH EMBEDDED MODERATE TO INTENSE CONVECTION LAY OVER EASTCENTRAL AND ADJOINING SOUTHEAST ARABIAN SEA OFF MAHARASTRA-KARNATAKA-KERALA COAST. SCATTERED LOW AND MEDIUM CLOUDS WITH EMBEDDED ISOLATED WEAK TO MODERATE CONVECTION LAY OVER THE REST OF ARABIAN SEA.
