DEMS-RSMC TROPICAL CYCLONES NEW DELHI DATED 07.11.2025

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR THE NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL AND THE ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR THE NEXT 168 HOURS ISSUED AT 0600 UTC OF 07.11.2025 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 07.11.2025.

BAY OF BENGAL:

Yesterday's upper air cyclonic circulation over eastcentral and adjoining northeast Bay of Bengal between 1.5 & 3.1 km above mean sea level persisted at 0300 UTC of today, the 07th November 2025.

As per INSAT 3DS at 0300 UTC, scattered to broken low and medium clouds with embedded moderate to intense convection lay over northeast & eastcentral and south Bay of Bengal and Andaman Sea. Scattered low and medium clouds with embedded isolated weak to moderate convection lay over northwest & westcentral Bay of Bengal.
