TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL AND ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR NEXT 120 HOURS ISSUED AT 0600 UTC OF 11.04.2022 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 11.04.2022.

BAY OF BENGAL:

YESTERDAY'S CYCLONIC CIRCULATION OVER SOUTHWEST BAY OF BENGAL AND ADJOINING AREAS OF NORTH SRI LANKA & TAMIL NADU NOW LIES OVER COASTAL TAMILNADU AND NEIGHBOURHOOD AND EXTENDS UPTO MID-TROPOSPHERIC LEVELS.

SCATTERED LOW AND MEDIUM CLOUDS WITH EMBEDDED MODERATE TO INTENSE CONVECTION LAY OVER SOUTHWEST BAY OF BENGAL PALK STRAIT, GULF OF MANNAR & SRILANKA.
