DEMS-RSMC TROPICAL CYCLONES NEW DELHI DATED 08.09.2026

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR THE NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL AND THE ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR THE NEXT 168 HOURS ISSUED AT 0600 UTC OF 08.09.2026 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 08.09.2026.

BAY OF BENGAL:

Yesterday's Low Pressure area over central parts of Uttar Pradesh became less marked at 0300 UTC of today, 08th September, 2026. However, the associated cyclonic circulation now lies over East Uttar Pradesh & adjoining Bihar and extends upto 3.1 km above mean sea level.

A fresh upper air cyclonic circulation lay over Westcentral Bay of Bengal & adjoining Coastal Andhra Pradesh at 7.6 km above mean sea level at 0300 UTC of today's, 08th September, 2026. A Low Pressure Area is likely to form over westcentral-Northwest Bay of Bengal & adjoining north Andhra Pradesh- south Odisha coasts around 11th September.

As per INSAT 3D(S), low-level circulation (LLC) persisted over central Uttar Pradesh and neighbourhood. Scattered to broken low to medium clouds with embedded moderate to intense convection over East Uttar Pradesh and northwest Bihar, with minimum cloud top temperatures (CTT) ranging from -40°C to -70°C .

Scattered to broken low to medium clouds with embedded intense to very intense convection over the north and east Bay of Bengal. Scattered low to medium clouds with embedded moderate to intense convection over the Andaman Sea, while isolated weak to moderate convection over the rest of the Bay of Bengal.

Scattered low to medium clouds with embedded isolated weak to moderate convection over the Gulf of Cambay, Lakshadweep Islands area, Maldives, and the Comorin area.

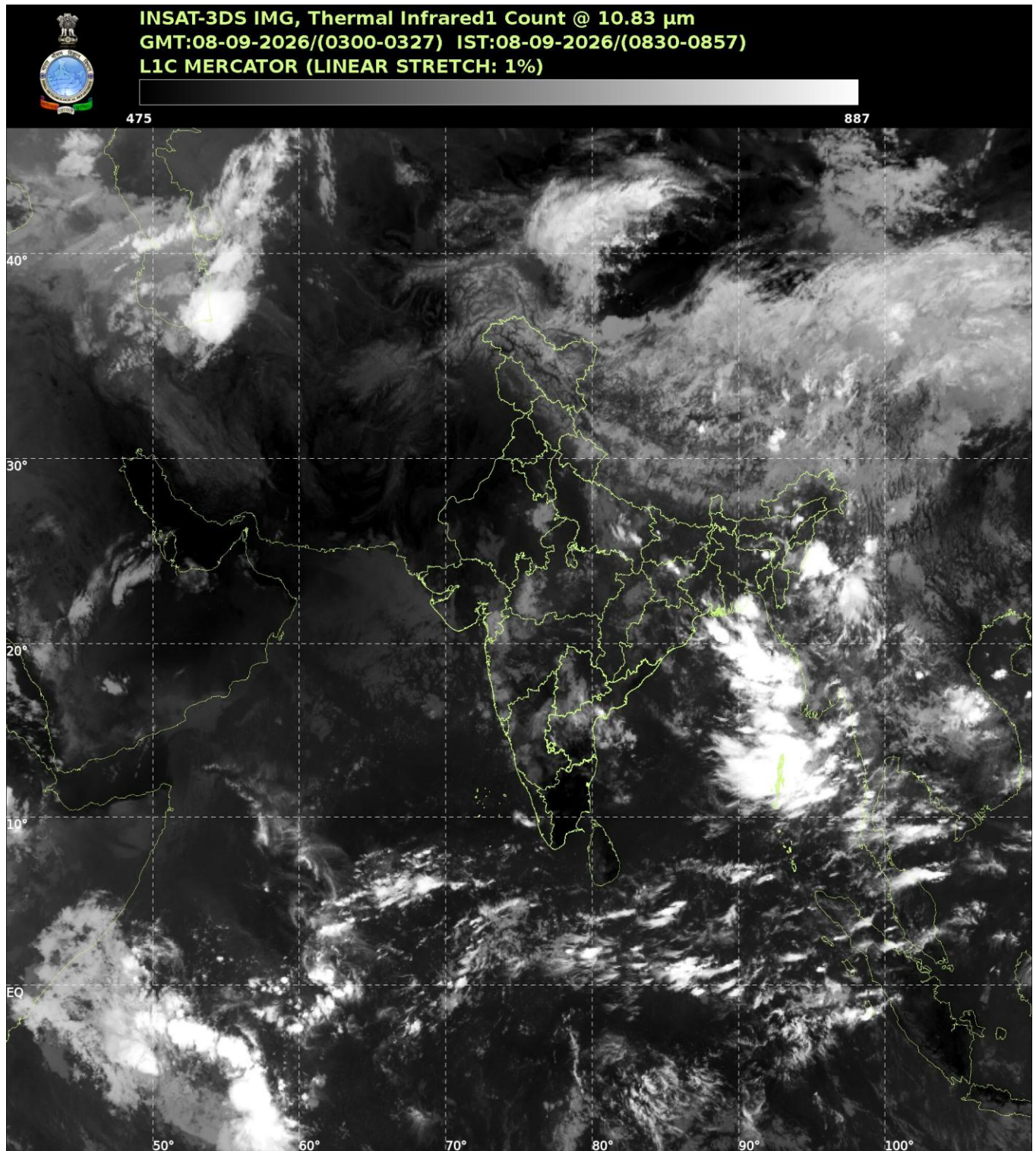
