DEMS-RSMC TROPICAL CYCLONES NEW DELHI DATED 08.08.2026

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR THE NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL AND THE ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR THE NEXT 168 HOURS ISSUED AT 0600 UTC OF 08.08.2026 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 08.08.2026.

BAY OF BENGAL:

Under the influence of the upper air Cyclonic circulation over South West Bengal & adjoining North Odisha, a Low Pressure Area formed over the same region at 0300 UTC of today, 08th August, 2026. The associated cyclonic circulation extends upto 7.6 km above mean sea level tilting southwestwards with height.

Scattered to broken low/middle-level clouds with embedded isolated to very isolated convection lay over the Bay, Arakan Coast and Gulf of Martaban. Scattered to broken low/middle-level clouds with embedded moderate to intense convection lay over the Andaman Sea and Tenasserim Coast.

ARABIAN SEA:

Scattered to broken low/middle-level clouds with embedded isolated to very isolated convection lay over the Southeast Arabian Sea, Comorin and adjoining areas, with scattered to broken low/middle-level clouds and embedded isolated to weak moderate convection lay over the northern Arabian Sea, Gulf of Kutch, Gulf of Cambay and central Arabian Sea.

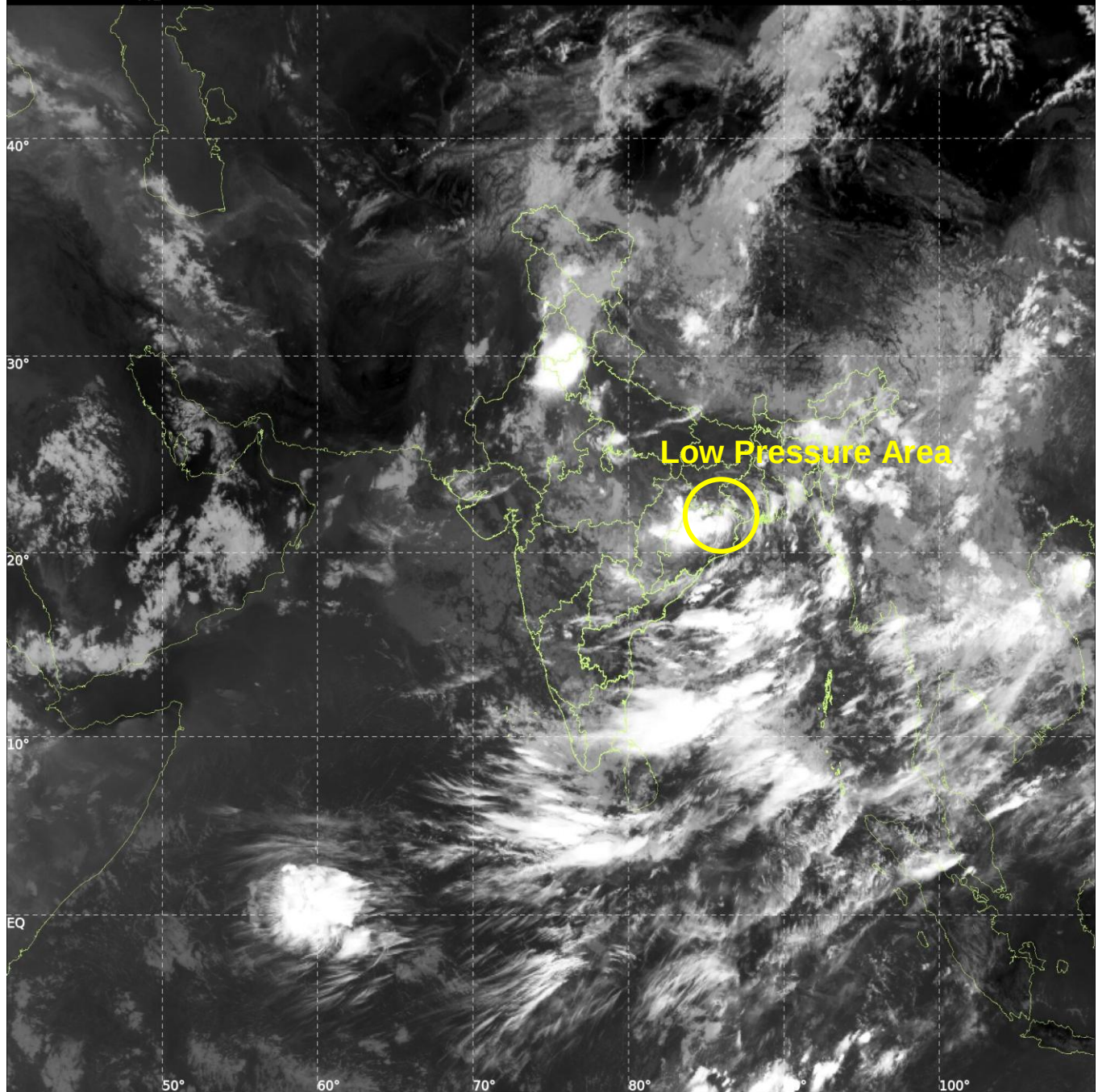
