TROPICAL CYCLONE ADVISORY NO. 12 FOR NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL AND ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR NEXT 120 HOURS ISSUED AT 0630 UTC OF 09.12.2022 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 09.12.2022

SUBJECT: THE CYCLONIC STORM “MANDOUS” PRONOUNCED AS “MAN-DOUS” OVER SOUTHWEST BAY OF BENGAL (CYCLONE WARNING: NORTH TAMILNADU, PUDUCHERRY AND SOUTH ANDHRA PRADESH COASTS)

THE SEVERE CYCLONIC STORM “MANDOUS” PRONOUNCED AS “MAN-DOUS” OVER SOUTHWEST BAY OF BENGAL MOVED WEST-NORTHWESTWARDS WITH A SPEED OF 12 KMPH DURING PAST 06 HOURS, WEAKENED INTO A **CYCLONIC STORM** AND LAY CENTERED AT 0300UTC OF 09TH DECEMBER, 2022 OVER SOUTHWEST BAY OF BENGAL OFF NORTH TAMILNADU AND PUDUCHERRY COASTS NEAR LATITUDE 11.1°N AND LONGITUDE 81.5°E, ABOUT 280 KM NORTH OF TRINCOMALEE (43418), 230 KM NORTHEAST OF JAFFNA (43404), 180 KM EAST-NORTHEAST OF KARAİKAL(43346) AND ABOUT 260 KM SOUTH-SOUTHEAST OF CHENNAI(43279). THE CYCLONE IS BEING MONITORED BY DOPPLER WEATHER RADARS OF KARAİKAL AND CHENNAI.

IT IS VERY LIKELY TO MOVE NEARLY NORTHWESTWARDS AND CROSS NORTH TAMILNADU, PUDUCHERRY AND ADJOINING SOUTH ANDHRA PRADESH COASTS BETWEEN PUDUCHERRY AND SRIHARIKOTA AROUND MAMALLAPURAM (MAHABALIPURAM) AS A CYCLONIC STORM WITH A MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WIND SPEED OF 65-75 KMPH GUSTING TO 85 KMPH DURING 1800 TO 2100 UTC OF 09TH DECEMBER

PROBABILITY OF CYCLOGENESIS (FORMATION OF DEPRESSION): NIL: 0%, LOW: 1-33%, , MODERATE: 34-66% AND HIGH: 67-100%
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AS PER INSAT 3D IMAGERY, CURRENT INTENSITY IS T3.0 AND SHOWS CURVED BAND PATTERN. THE CONVECTION ASSOCIATED WITH THE SYSTEM HAS DECREASED DURING LAST 06 HRS. THE ASSOCIATED BROKEN LOW/MEDIUM CLOUDS WITH EMBEDDED INTENSE TO VERY INTENSE CONVECTION LIES OVER SOUTH WEST BAY OF BENGAL BETWEEN AREA LAT 7.0 DEG N TO 13.0 DEG N LONG 79.0 DEG E TO 83.5 DEG E OVER TAMILNADU, GULF OF MANNAR, PALK STRAIT AND SRI LANKA. MINIMUM CLOUD TOP TEMPERATURE (CTT) IS MINUS 93 DEG CEL.

THE MAXIMUM SUSTAINED SURFACE WIND SPEED IS 45 KNOTS GUSTING TO 55 KNOTS. THE ESTIMATED CENTRAL PRESSURE IS ABOUT 994 HPA. SEA CONDITION IS HIGH OVER SOUTHWEST BAY OF BENGAL AND ROUGH TO VERY ROUGH OVER ADJOINING AREAS OF WEST CENTRAL BAY OF BENGAL AND GULF OF MANNAR.

REMARKS:

THE MADDEN JULIAN OSCILLATION (MJO) INDEX CURRENTLY LIES IN PHASE 3 AND WILL REMAIN THERE TILL 9TH DECEMBER. SEA SURFACE TEMPERATURE (SST) IS AROUND 27°C- 28°C OVER SOUTHWEST AND CENTRAL BOB AND ALONG AND OFF NORTH TAMILNADU AND ADJOINING ANDHRA PRADESH COASTS. ALSO THE OCEAN HEAT CONTENT (OHC) IS 50-80 KJ/CM² OVER SOUTHWEST BOB AND LESS THAN 50 KJ/CM² OVER WESTCENTRAL BOB. THERE IS WARM AIR ADVECTION TO THE SYSTEM FROM THE SOUTHERN SECTOR WITH REDUCING TREND.

AT 0300 UTC OF 9TH DEC, CHENNAI(43279) REPORTED MEAN SEA LEVEL PRESSURE OF 1005.9 HPA AND WIND DIRECTION/SPEED AS 340°/15 KNOTS, PUDUCHERRY(43331) REPORTED MEAN SEA LEVEL PRESSURE OF 1004.4 HPA AND WIND DIRECTION/SPEED AS 340°/8.0 KNOTS, NAGAPPTINAM(43347) REPORTED MEAN SEA LEVEL PRESSURE OF 1003.6 HPA AND WIND DIRECTION/SPEED AS 290°/10 KNOTS, KARAIKAL(43346) REPORTED MEAN SEA LEVEL PRESSURE OF 1003.6 HPA AND WIND DIRECTION/SPEED AS 340°/10 KT KNOTS AND CUDDALORE(43329) REPORTED MEAN SEA LEVEL PRESSURE OF 1003.8 HPA AND WIND DIRECTION/SPEED AS 340°/10 KNOTS. THERE HAS BEEN A PRESSURE FALL IN LAST 24 HOURS(P24) OF -4.0 HPA TO -6.0 HPA IN THESE STATIONS OVER NORTH TAMIL NADU COAST WITH PRESSURE DEPARTURE FROM NORMAL OF -8.0 TO -10.0. THE HIGHEST PRESSURE FALL IS -6.1 HPA AND PRESSURE DEPARTURE FORM NORMAL IS -10.4 HPA AT CUDDALORE(43329).


LOW LEVEL VORTICITY IS $300 \times 10^{-6} \text{ S}^{-1}$ AROUND THE SYSTEM CENTER WITH PEAK TO THE SOUTH OF THE SYSTEM CENTER. LOW LEVEL CONVERGENCE IS $20 \times 10^{-5} \text{ S}^{-1}$ TO THE NORTH OF SYSTEM CENTER AND UPPER LEVEL DIVERGENCE HAS REDUCED AND IS $5 \times 10^{-5} \text{ S}^{-1}$ TO THE NORTH OF THE SYSTEM CENTER.

WIND SHEAR IS MODERATE TO HIGH (20-25 KNOTS) OVER & AROUND THE SYSTEM CENTER AND DECREASING ALONG THE PREDICTED TRACK. THE UPPER TROPOSPHERIC RIDGE RUNS ROUGHLY ALONG 17.0°N OVER THE BOB. THE SYSTEM LIES IN THE SOUTHERMOST PERIPHERY OF THE STEERING RIDGE IN ASSOCIATION WITH THE ANTI CYCLONIC CIRCULATION TO THE NORTHEAST OF MYANMAR. THE SYSTEM IS UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF RIDGE LINE AND IT IS LIKELY TO BE STEERED TOWARDS NORTHWEST TILL 0000 UTC OF 10TH DECEMBER. THEREAFTER, IT IS LIKELY TO BE STEERED WEST-NORTHWESTWARDS. PRESENTLY, THE SYSTEM IS UNDER THE INFLUNCE OF COLD AND DRY AIR INTRUSION FROM SOUTH PENINSULAR INDIA, THE SYSTEM WOULD SHOW SLIGHT WEAKENING TREND WHILE MOVING TOWARDS COAST.

IN VIEW OF ALL THE ABOVE, THE SYSTEM IS VERY LIKELY TO MOVE NEARLY NORTHWESTWARDS AND CROSS NORTH TAMILNADU, PUDUCHERRY AND ADJOINING SOUTH ANDHRA PRADESH COASTS BETWEEN PUDUCHERRY AND SRIHARIKOTA AROUND MAMALLAPURAM (MAHABALIPURAM) AS A CYCLONIC STORM WITH A MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WIND SPEED OF 65-75 KMPH GUSTING TO 85 KMPH DURING 1800 TO 2100 UTC OF 09TH DECEMBER




