DEMS-RSMC TROPICAL CYCLONES NEW DELHI DATED 08.07.2026

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR THE NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL AND THE ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR THE NEXT 168 HOURS ISSUED AT 0600 UTC OF 08.07.2026 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 08.07.2026.

BAY OF BENGAL:

Yesterday's Well-Marked Low Pressure area over east Madhya Pradesh and neighbourhood lay over Northwest Madhya Pradesh & adjoining Southwest Uttar Pradesh at 0300 UTC of today, the 8th July 2026. The associated cyclonic circulation extends upto 9.6 km above mean sea level tilting southwards with height. It is very likely to move north-northwestwards for some time and recurve northeastwards thereafter.

Scattered to broken low to medium clouds with embedded intense to very intense convection lay over north and east-central Bay of Bengal, Arakan Coast, and Gulf of Martaban. Scattered low to medium clouds with embedded moderate to intense convection lay over remaining parts of Bay of Bengal and north Andaman Sea.

ARABIAN SEA:

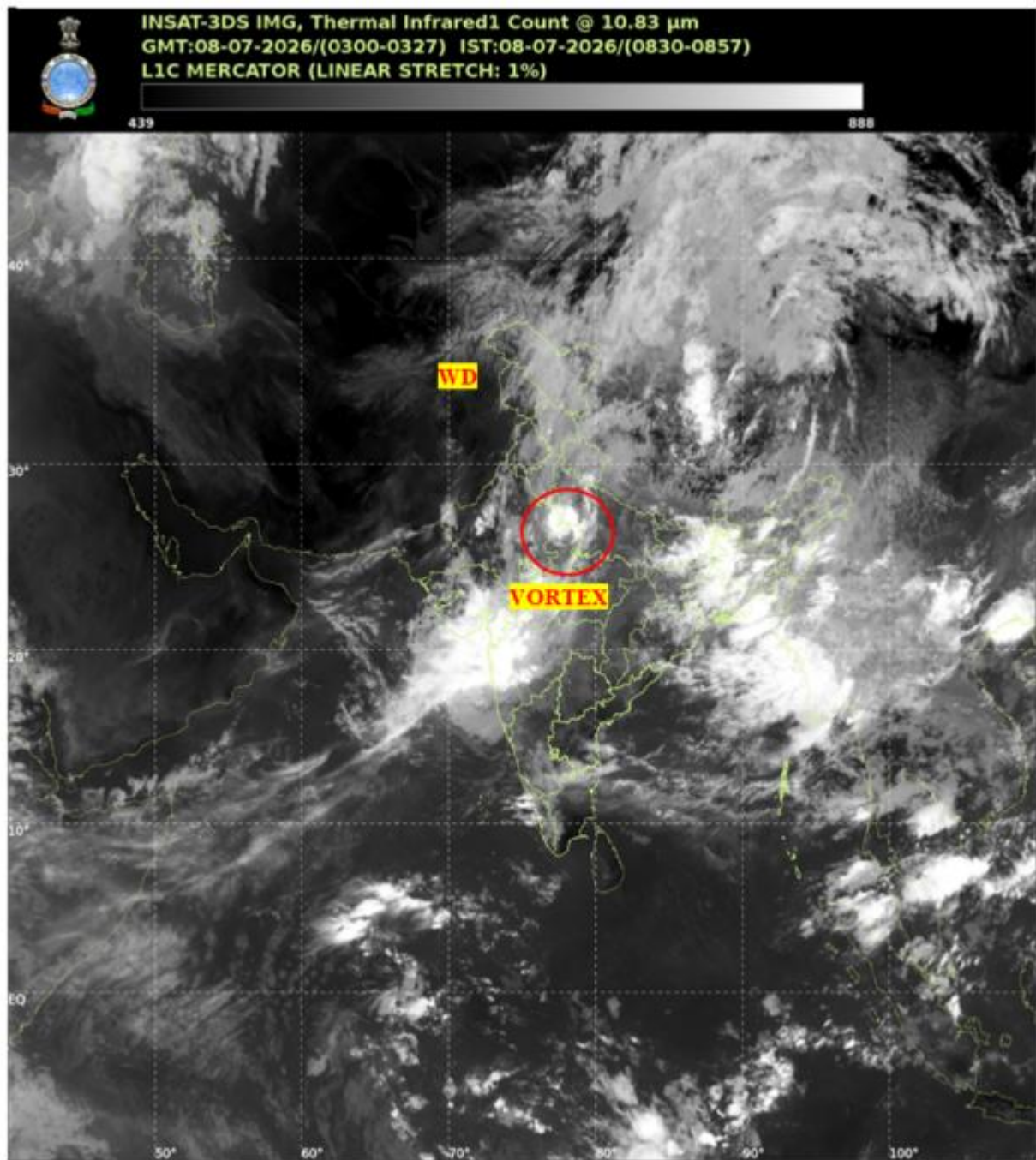
Scattered to broken low to medium clouds with embedded intense to very intense convection lay over northeast and east-central Arabian Sea and Gulf of Cambay. Scattered low to medium clouds with embedded isolated moderate to intense convection lay over remaining parts of Arabian Sea, Lakshadweep Islands area, and Gulf of Kutch.
