DEMS-RSMC TROPICAL CYCLONES NEW DELHI DATED 03.08.2026

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR THE NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL AND THE ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR THE NEXT 168 HOURS ISSUED AT 0600 UTC OF 03.08.2026 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 03.08.2026.

BAY OF BENGAL:

Yesterday's Low Pressure area over Southwest Rajasthan & neighbourhood had become less marked at 0000 UTC of today 03rd August, 2026. However, the associated cyclonic circulation lay over central parts of Rajasthan between 1.5 & 4.5 km above mean sea level tilting southwestwards with height.

Scattered low to medium clouds with embedded intense to very intense convection lay over south Bay of Bengal, westcentral Bay of Bengal and moderate to intense convection lay over rest of the Bay of Bengal, Andaman sea and Gulf of Martaban.

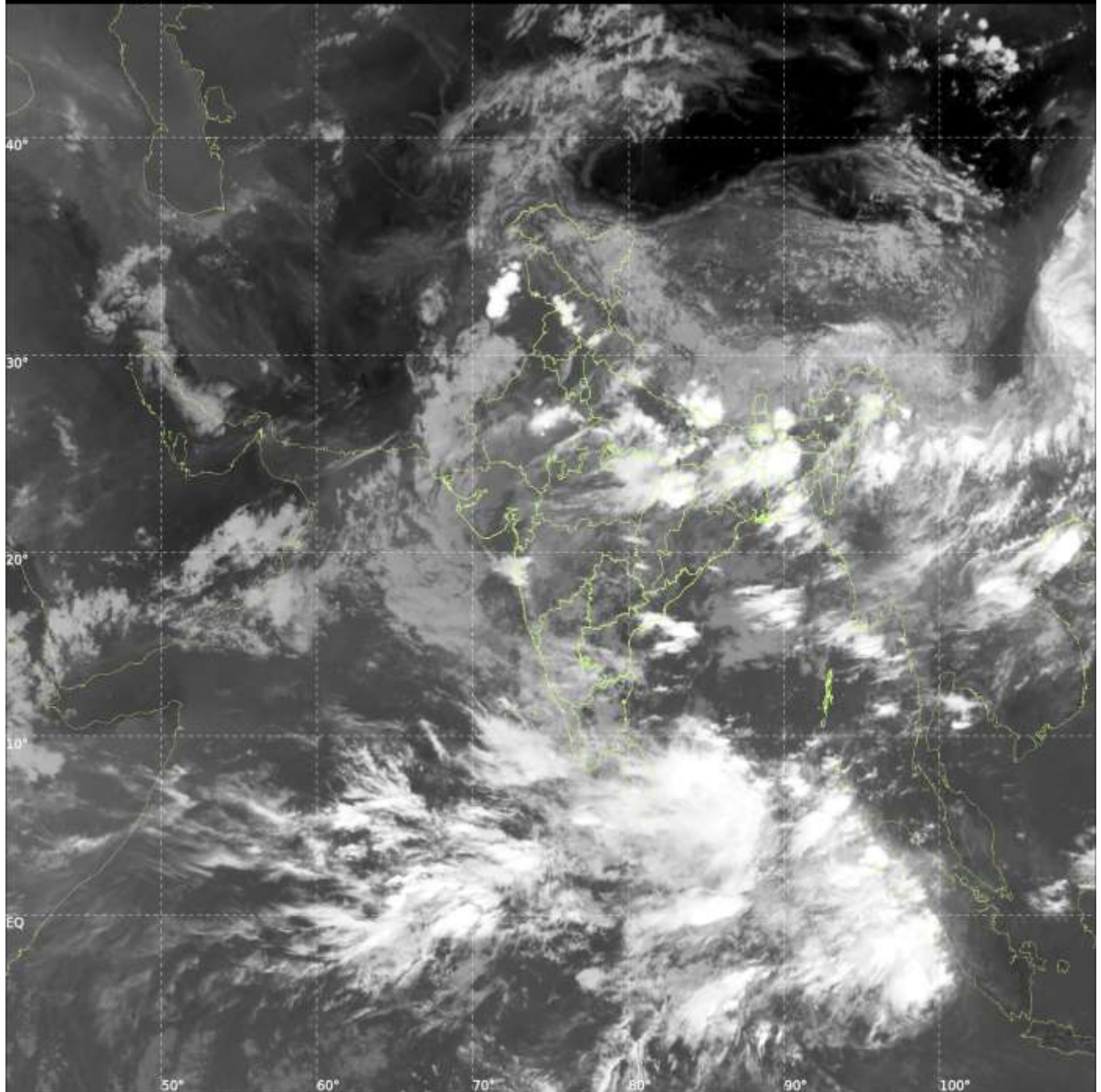
