SCATTERED LOW AND MEDIUM CLOUDS WITH EMBEDDED INTENSE TO VERY INTENSE CONVECTION LAY OVER SOUTHEAST BAY OF BENGAL ADJOINING EQUATORIAL INDIAN OCEAN & ANDAMAN SEA. SCATTERED LOW AND MEDIUM CLOUDS WITH EMBEDDED WEAK TO MODERATE CONVECTION LAY OVER SOUTHWEST BAY OF BENGAL.

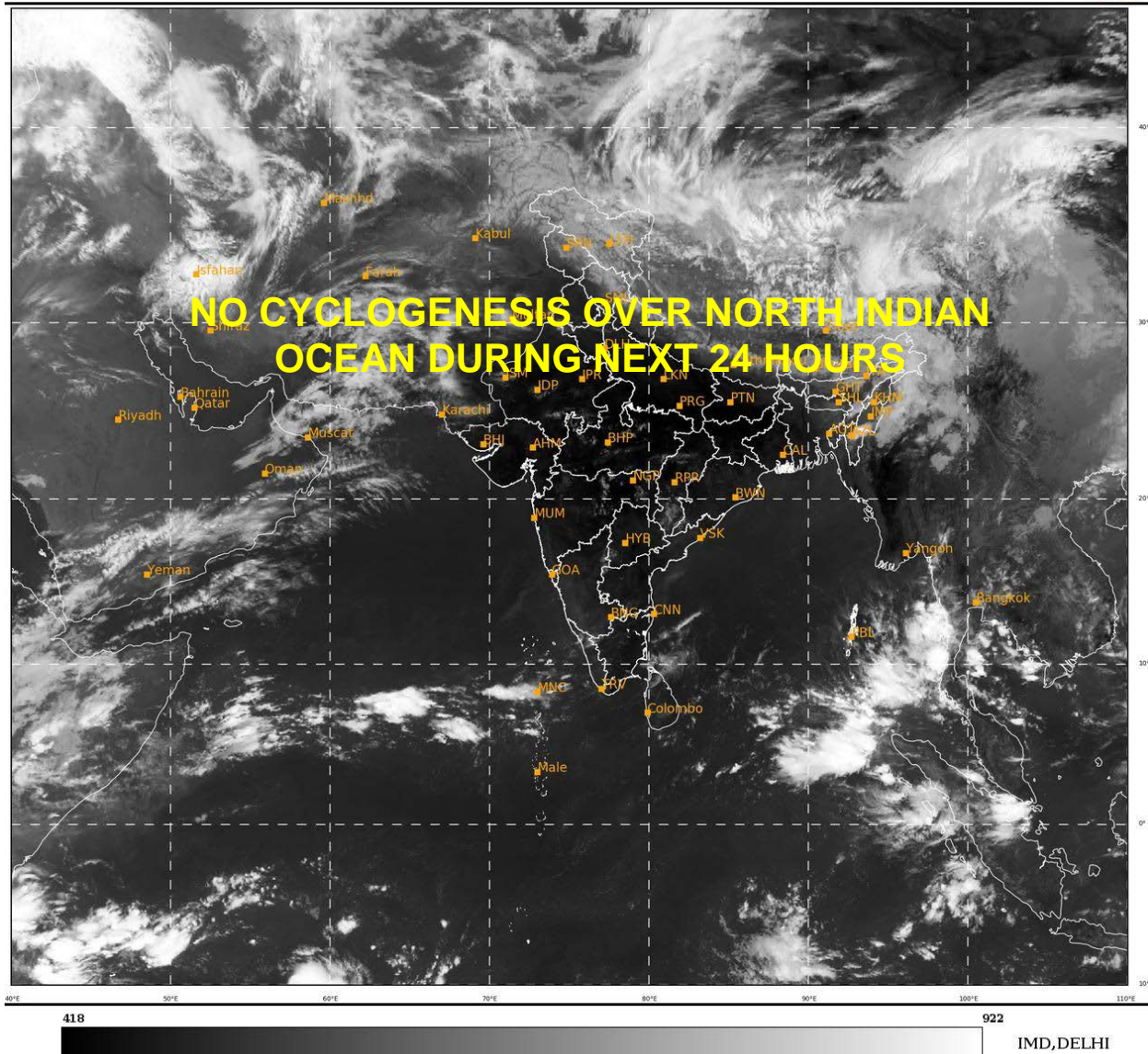
**ARABIAN SEA:**

SCATTERED LOW AND MEDIUM CLOUDS WITH EMBEDDED INTENSE TO VERY INTENSE CONVECTION LAY OVER SOUTH ARABIAN SEA (SOUTH OF LATITUDE 10.0N) AND MODERATE TO INTENSE CONVECTION LAY OVER NORTHWEST & WESTCENTRAL ARABIAN SEA.
