BAY OF BENGAL:

SCATTERED LOW AND MEDIUM CLOUDS WITH EMBEDDED INTENSE TO VERY INTENSE CONVECTION LAY OVER SOUTHEAST BAY OF BENGAL AND MODERATE TO INTENSE CONVECTION LAY OVER SOUTHWEST BAY OF BENGAL & SOUTH ANDAMAN SEA.

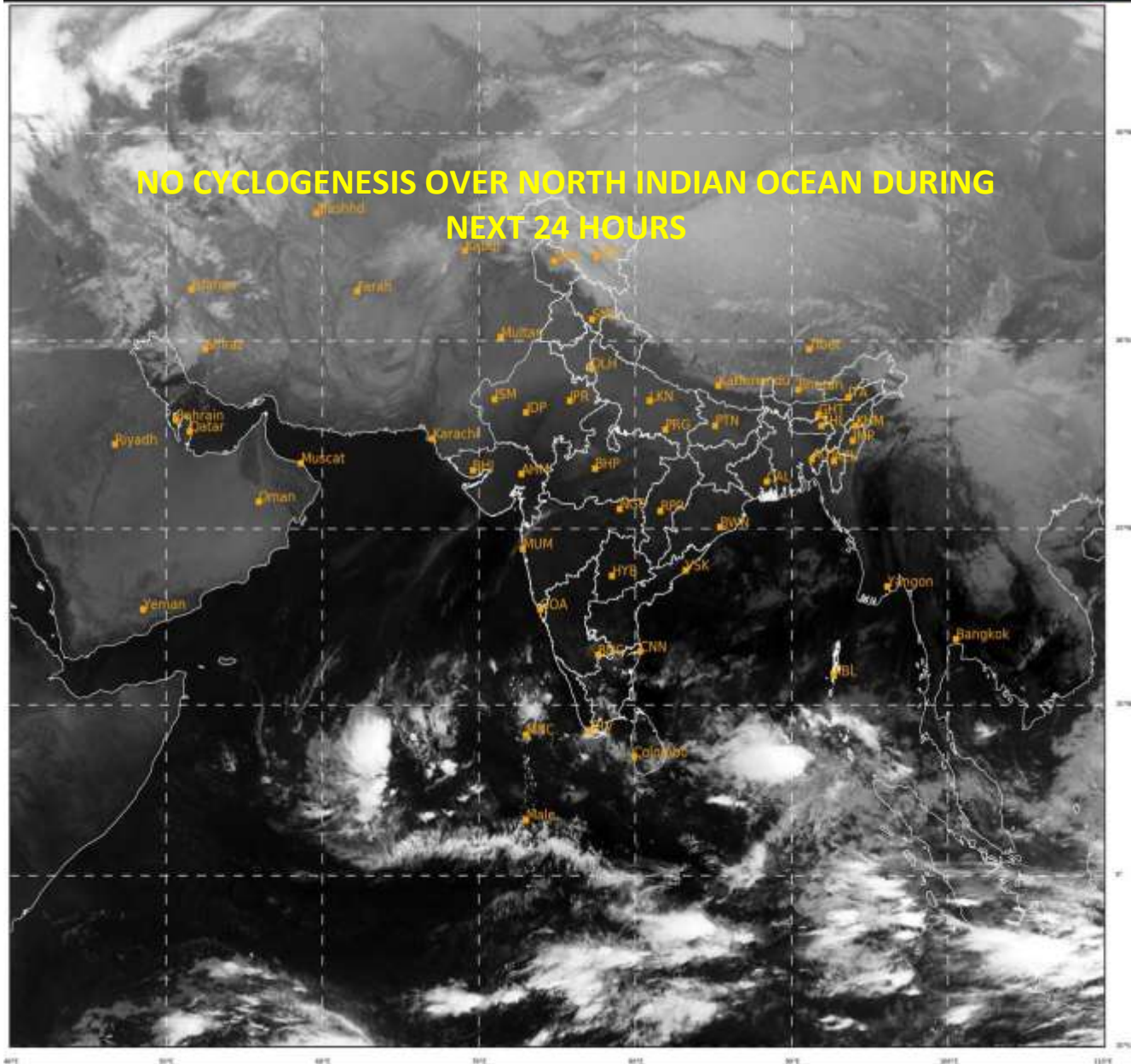
