**BAY OF BENGAL:**

Scattered low to medium clouds with embedded moderate to intense convection lay over the extreme southeast Bay of Bengal.

**ARABIAN SEA:**

A fresh upper air cyclonic circulation formed over Lakshadweep & neighbourhood at 0.9 km above mean sea level at 1200 UTC of yesterday, 24th March, 2026. It became less marked at 0300 UTC of today, 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2026.

Scattered low to medium clouds with embedded isolated moderate to intense convection lay over the north Arabian Sea and Gulf of Kutch. Isolated weak to moderate convection lay over the westcentral and southwest Arabian Sea.

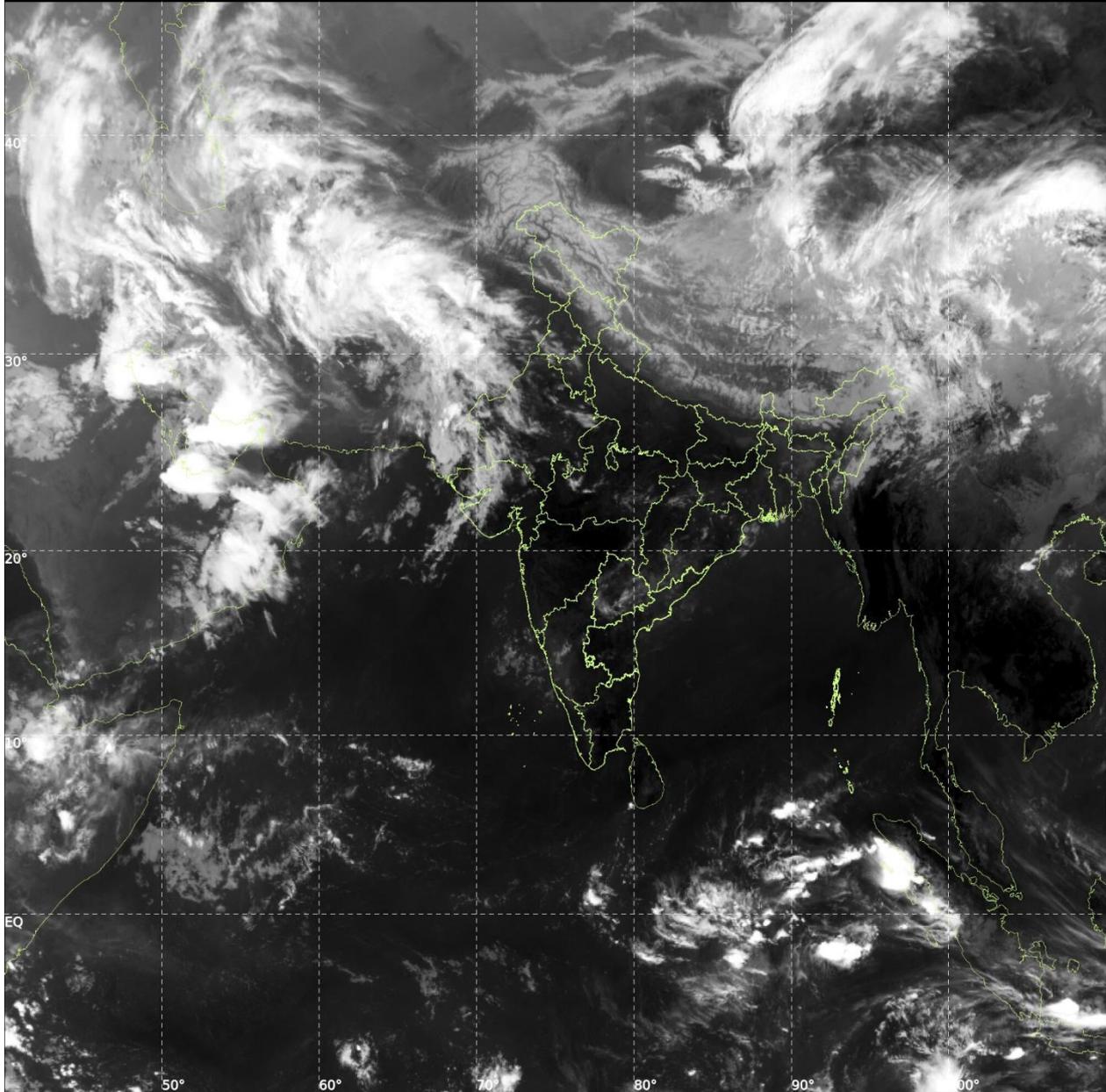
