TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR THE NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL AND THE ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR THE NEXT 168 HOURS ISSUED AT 0600 UTC OF 29.03.2025 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 29.03.2025.

BAY OF BENGAL:

An upper air cyclonic circulation lay over Andaman Sea & neighbourhood between 1.5 to 5.8 km above mean sea level at 0300 UTC of today, the 29th March, 2025

Scattered low and medium clouds with embedded weak to moderate convection lay over northeast Bay of Bengal, eastcentral adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal & Andaman Sea.
