DEMS-RSMC TROPICAL CYCLONES NEW DELHI DATED 06.04.2026

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR THE NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL AND THE ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR THE NEXT 168 HOURS ISSUED AT 0600 UTC OF 06.04.2026 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 06.04.2026.

BAY OF BENGAL:

Yesterday's upper-air cyclonic circulation over westcentral Bay of Bengal off south coastal Andhra Pradesh at 1.5 km above mean sea level persisted at 0300 UTC of today, 06th April, 2026.

Scattered to broken, low and medium clouds with embedded intense to very intense convection lay over southwest Bay of Bengal off Tamil Nadu coast, Palk Strait & adjoining Gulf of Mannar, north Sri Lanka and also over south Bay of Bengal south of latitude 7.0°N & adjoining Equatorial Indian Ocean. Scattered low to medium clouds with embedded moderate to intense convection lay over the south Andaman Sea and isolated weak to moderate convection lay over westcentral & northwest Bay of Bengal.
